Commentary: William Hayward Upchurch SR was born in 1824 in North Carolina and died 1852 in Pickens County, AL. He was the son of Bartley Upchurch and the grandson of Abel Upchurch SR, head of Upchurch clan # 8. Our knowledge of this part of the Upchurch family has been enhanced by the Barham family bible that surfaced.

William Howard U, I [WILLIAM HAYWARD U, SR] b 2 AUG 1824 d 25 JUN 1852 md Rebecca Latham. **WHU I** [WHU, SR] is bur in Bethesda Cem, Benevola Rd, Pickens Co, AL and his stone reads "In memory of **W. H. U** b 2 AUG 1824 d 25 JUN 1852 - Friends behold as you pass by as you are now so once was I as I am now so you must be. Prepare for death and follow me! - We did not find his wife's grave. She is supposed to be bur in Hebron Cem & we did not go there.

I don't have any children listed fro <u>WHU, I</u> [WHU,SR]. I think his wife Rebecca Latham [REUTHA SARAH BARHAM], must have been born in 1826. (1856 doesn't make any sense). I have seen the grave of <u>WHU, I</u> [WHU, SR] in Bethesda Cem., Pickens Co, AL (See (2) for details). He is bur in the same section as Penelope, Bartley, Nathan, Capt Burt, Emma T, John & Melissa & the children they lost. I am accepting the idea that <u>WHU, I</u> [WHU, SR] is bur in Bethesda Cem. There is no sign of his WIF here.

<u>WHU, Sr</u> did not marry Rebecca Latham as proposed in (1) but rather md Reutha Sarah Barham. His son WHU, Jr md Rebecca Love. Thus in (4) above the best interpretation is that the first WHU to which reference is made is <u>WHU, Sr</u>. The second WHU to whom reference is made is WHU, Jr and the female referenced is the wife of WHU, Jr - namely Rebecca Love. - RPU]

- 1860 AL <u>WHU, Sr</u> died earlier not yet able to locate his son WHU, Jr on census in 1860. Jr would have been 7 yrs old.

DR. HOWELL LEWIS m. SARAH BEALL and they went to TX ca.. 1853. "Yes, FAMILY PUZZLERS is one of the best - your comments are most helpful. My question is: What do I do with all the back issues? I would like to give them to the Hopkins Co., TX, Genealogical Society. Hopkins Co., TX was filled with people from GA. DOZIER THORNTON came, as did the ASKEW, BURFORD, MINTER, GAY, LEWIS and one PURCELL [families]."

BARHAM - LIGON - JONES BIBLE

From Mr. William C. Daniel, 3520 Arrington Dr., Mobile, AL 36693 comes a typescript of his grandmother's family Bible. Mr. Daniel said that she thought that the Barhams bought the Bible from the Short family, which could explain the Short entries. There was no Bible or title page left when Mr. Daniel received the family record pages. The Barham, Ligon, and Jones families went to Pickens Co., AL, from Wake Co., NC.

Dear Mr. Upchurch,

I received your letter regarding my grandmother's family Bible which was published in "Family Puzzlers". I will give you what I have on the Upchurch family of Pickens County, AL from the books that I have on Pickens County. I am not an Upchurch descendant but my g-g-grandmother's sister, Reutha Sarah Barham, married William Hayward Upchurch as her first husband. Their only child's birth, W. H. Jr., was recorded in the Barham-Ligon family Bible.

From the information I have, it appears that the head of this clan in Pickens County was J. Bartley Upchurch who, according to his tombstone, was born in Wake County, NC Dec 19, 1800 and died Oct 21, 1879 in Greene County, AL. His wife was Penelope, born April 22, 1802, died Nov 24, 1863. They are buried at Bethesda Presbyterian Church Cemetery in the community of Benevola in Pickens County, AL along with many of their children. Some of their children were (I'm sure there were others):

A. "<u>W. H. U, Sr</u>'s stone has him born 1821, not 1824. I was out there a couple months ago and photographed it. He may have been by a first wife? (Not Penelope?) Don't know"

B. The obit for WHU, Jr [son of <u>WHU, Sr</u>] shows Wm Haywood but Ruth Cotton told me it was HAYWARD - don't know which is right - perhaps Bartley U md 1st a dau of William Hayward or Haywood??

"You were correct that the birth date of <u>WHU, Sr</u> was 1824 and not 1821. This was apparently copied incorrectly for the cemetery book and by me." [Note that picture of stone shows b 2 AUG 1824 d 25 JUN 1852 but the 4 is partly faint and could be read as a 1 - RPU]
