There is inadequate proof as to the father of **Willie Upchurch** but various dates and places recorded open up the possibility that he was the son of Benjamin Upchurch, Head of Clan. A Master Outline has been tentatively created on this basis – but XIDs are not yet being assigned. Need more evidence – RPU

B. RPU Speculation

If Mary J Stallings is nee Mary J Upchurch, she could be daughter of **Willie Upchurch** and granddaughter of Benjamin Upchurch – Head of Clan. Thus Sarah Upchurch could be her 1st cousin, possibly the daughter of Alfred A Upchurch, son of James Upchurch, V – Head of Clan.

Note that as of 1900 descendants of Willie Upchurch and Alfred A Upchurch lived in South Mannings Township of Nash Co, NC where Sarah Upchurch is recorded.

It is assumed that Sarah Upchurch never married rather than being single as in husband in deceased, departed, etc.
