Few early deed records survive for Wake County. When combined with the cessation of land grants from 1763-1778, we find a dearth of early Wake County land records. One interesting set of records that do survive (though not in their entirety) are Civil Action Papers (CAPs) Concerning Land. These are a subset of the CAPs series at the North Carolina State Archives in Raleigh. These are extant court papers where there was an issue concerning land. The originals can be found in C.R.099.325.93 (1773-1793). The surviving paperwork up to the year 1800 will eventually be abstracted and included in Wake Treasures.

You will note that the timing of many of these is in 1778. This would have been the first time that one could file for a land grant in about fifteen years. During those years, many moved to Wake County, made improvements on land, bought and sold land, and yet no land grants were issued. So, as soon as the land grant process was re-instituted by the State of NC, there were a lot of land grant entries made, and this caused a lot of caveats² to also be filed.

I am completely at a loss to add anything to the presumed marriage of Frances Delk(e) to Michael Upchurch ca 1652, Surry Co. VA. 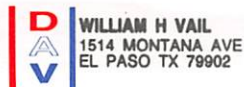
Dear Mr Upchurch,


I have reviewed the material three times and I regret to say I was unable to find any clues that would help me solve the problem that has eluded me for so long, the parentage of Joseph DELK who married Edith Rowland, Wake Co. NC, 1789. I don't think there is any doubt that he is related to one of the descendants of Roger Delk of Surry Co VA but as you mentioned in your letter, vital records for that period of time are scarce or non existent. There was much movement of DELKS between Virginia and North Carolina, as well as many others that you are familiar with, and possibly that contributes to the scarcity of data. I kind of feel like Columbus in his voyage of 1492, I'm dealing with many unknowns but I know I'll find the answer if I continue the search.


Much of the DELK data you sent will no doubt assist Randolph Delk, here in El Paso, in his endeavor. I'll see that he receives all of it soon. I thank you for him.

As I told Cleo recently the DELK line is my wife's line, not mine. I'm sorry if I misled you in that regard. After being married for 42 years we tend to think as one. 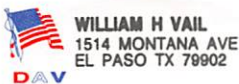

Δ+Δ a need to establish the line from Roger to Joseph.

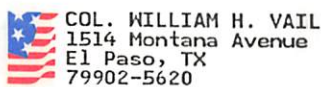
- I have worked on the DELK line for about a year. I have a good
- bit of data on the Virginia DELKS from about 1624 to 1725. I

My line then migrates to NC but it gets fuzzy at this point
trying to clarify family lines. I have citations from several
land transactions but no clear indications of family connections.

This is in response to your letter of 9 JUL 70 regarding your Belk (?) interests. Leo, who suggested you write me as a dear friend (through correspondence) and a cousin. I have not researched the Belk (?) Family and have no reason that I know of to do so except that I am very interested in documenting the circumstances regarding the presumed marriage of Frances Belk and Michael Uphurchs, I in about 1650 in Surry Co, VA. A copy of my three page profile on Frances Belk is enclosed. The research on the Surry Co, VA material was done by Belle Lenter West in the era 1950-1970 and published in her book "Uphurchs Family of England, Virginia and North Carolina" in 1972. I can reproduce the "Belk" part of this book and send it to you if you do not have it. The fact is that we have no firm proof that Frances had the last name Belk. The circumstantial evidence is fair. We do know that the Uphurchs & Belk families lived in close proximity in Surry Co VA ca 1650.

I have profiles on 17 other Belk's family members I can send if you so desire. I also have profiles on 18 family members I can send if needed. A quick scan of these did not reveal information that would appear critical to you but one never knows.

I was born and raised in Wake Co, NC. My Upshur's ancestors arrived on the Wake/Franklin border about 1755

Do you have access to "The Heritage of Wake Co, NC" 1983? I find no Belk's listings but there are 8 Rowland Family histories - most of recent Rowlands but some going back into the 1500's. No Edith Rowland.

The Johnston Co, NC Heritage Book (1985) also has no Belk's listings. There are three Rowland Family Histories

I am not sure we can help each other but it is always nice to have contacts on specific lines. Feel free to share anything with Randolph Belk of whom you write. I will be happy to share anything that I have with you or Randolph. I have always wanted to know more of my roots in Surry Co, VA and will appreciate anything you or Randolph can share.

I was interested to see your name and your siblings' names on one sheet where you show that your father is Nathan Upchurch.

I'm afraid there is little I can use from your papers in my own Upchurch search. I consulted all your wonderful websites, conferences, etc., and unfortunately my computer can't seem to get the sound, but only the picture.

I'll look up again the long text on Nathan Upchurch; but a quick look at it did not ring a bell for me, as I did not find any Upchurch ancestors I'm looking for.

I get the impression that you are first and foremost an 'historian' of the Upchurch family and extended family...perhaps more so than a genealogist. No offense meant. Your dedication is remarkable and you do fine work that really helps people find their way in the Upchurch Allied Families.

In my case, as I said before, I prefer the 'essential' family tree, or if you will, the 'meat' of family lineage from one generation to the other without going into detail about history or extended family, etc., since I usually include the whole 'family line' on one page that can be viewed on sight with a glance

① Moses U bca 1822 was the son of Courtney U & the gr of Moses U, Head of Clan.

By AUG 1856 Moses U b 1822 had moved his family to Oktobeha Co, MS. In 1859 he bought land thru on credit from Thomas Carroll but lost it with the land going to A. B. Champion.

By 2 MAY 1871 Moses U was working land on the VALENTINE Plantation when he signed a loan mortgage to James A. Valentine.

Moses owed \$80 for 2 cows & calves ~~and~~ named Lill & Bayge and \$146.10 for pork. The money owed for this stock was to earn 8% interest. Moses would also owe Mr Valentine for a running account for supplies used to make a crop on the land. On 26 APR 1872 the B. J. Rivers & Co loaned Moses U & his son Mark Wesley U \$300. The security was the stock & crops produced on the Valentine farm. On NOV 1872 Moses & Mark gave a promissory note and \$490 to James A. Valentine for 320 acres. The note was for \$4190 at 8% interest to be paid in 5 installments of \$838 each due 30 NOV 1873 - 1877. By 19 DEC 1874 Moses & Mark were having trouble paying for the land. John Thomas U, another son of Moses, joined Moses & Mark in the agreement with James A. Valentine to pay off the land with promissory notes of cotton bales produced at 10% interest.

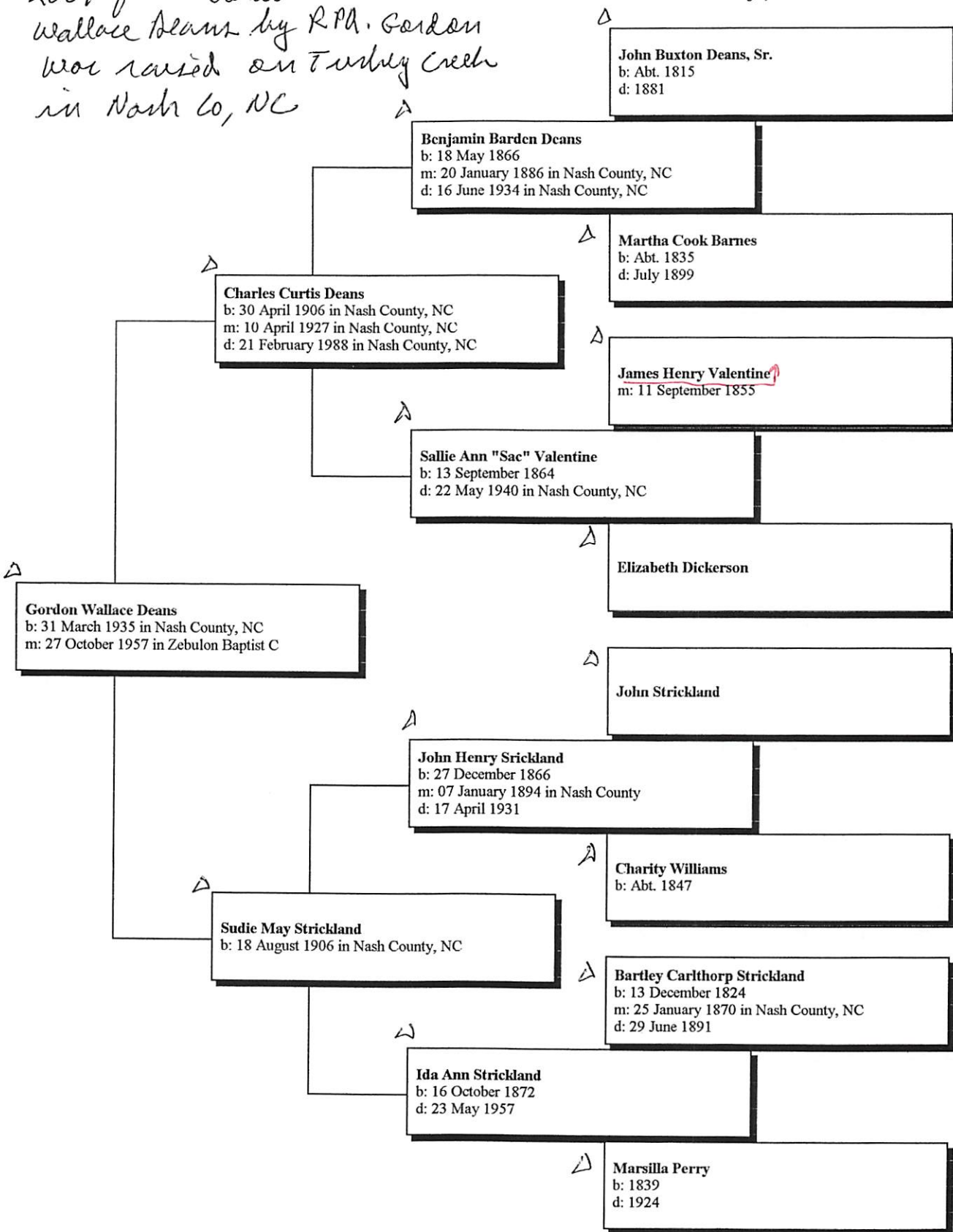

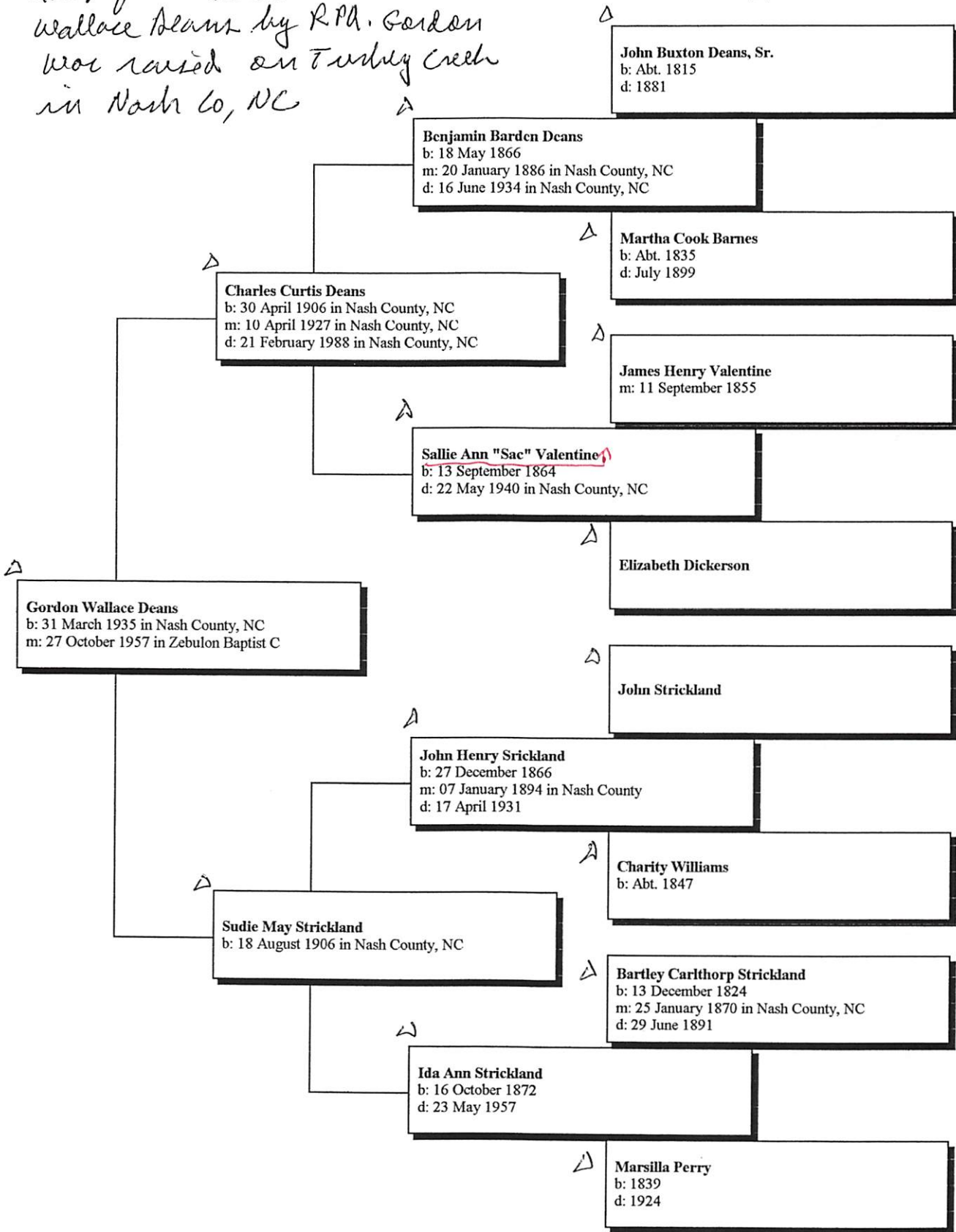
