Pilgrimage to Zebulon uncovers family's roots

Mary Fisher Finch Monson of Charlotte and first cousin Ruth Anne Fisher Veazey of Hendersonville paid a visit to Zebulon May 22 and stopped at Zebulon United Methodist Church which was pastored from 1917-1921 by their grandfather, George Washington Fisher. Stained glass windows in the chancel area of the church memorialize George W. and Ida Love Fisher.

Another memorial stained glass window honors J.D. Finch and Sallie B. Finch, Mrs. Monson's paternal grandparents who

joined Zebulon Methodist in 1912. Her ancestors, both the Finches and the Fishers who served in many towns in the Methodist ministry, are buried in Zebulon Town Cemetery. Mrs. Fisher came to Zebulon to live with her daughter, Alma Love Fisher (Mrs. Waylon) Finch, after the sudden death of her husband in 1926. Fisher was serving the second year of his appointment to the Garner charge when he died suddenly.

Mrs. Monson grew up on Horton Street in Zebulon, the daughter

of Waylon and Alma Fisher Finch. Mrs. Veazey, the daughter of the Rev. Edgar B. Fisher, visited her Aunt Alma and her cousin, Mrs. Monson, during their youth.

I remember when "Miss Alma" visited me for the first time when we moved to Zebulon in 1959. When she learned her niece married my second cousin, Dr. Alexander Holloway Veazey Jr., she treated me like a member of her family.

G.W. Fisher's granddaughters said they were touched to see the restored and refinished pulpit from the original Zebulon Methodist Church where he delivered four years of sermons. Mrs. Veazey believes her father, Edgar, also preached behind that pulpit as a visiting minister.

Many older members of this church will remember that Miss Alma always mentioned that her father preached from this pulpit when it was used for programs in the old fellowship hall. The granddaughters found the first entry made by their ancestor in 1917 in the oldest membership roll book.

Mrs. Monson said she was thrilled to see the original communion set, polished and on display in the historical case in the vestibule of the church. When a new communion set was obtained many years ago, the original went home with Miss

Descendants of John Veazey

Genealogist and secretary of the Little River Historical Society, Ann Veazey Davis of Zebulon, organized a family reunion on June 12 for over 150 descendants of the first John Veazey who settled in America in Cecil County, Maryland. The original log cabin, believed to have been built by him around 1690, is still intact and has been incorporated into two later additions that are presently the home of William and Elizabeth Ward, and has been known through the years as Cherry Grove.

Located on "Veazey's Neck" on the shores of the Bohemia and Elk

rivers, Cherry Grove stayed in the Veazey family from the late 17th century to the early 20th century, when the son of Gov. Thomas Ward Veazey died. The Wards were only the second family to "pay money for that land," Mrs. Davis said.

It was during a visit with the Wards in January 1992 that the invitation was extended to all the descendants of the first John Veazey to return to their "roots" for a family reunion, Mrs. Davis said. The past 18 months have seen mailings, planning, printing, phone calls, and more and more Veaseys/Veazeys coming to the fore.

Family members saw the hand-hewn beams, original plank flooring and original brick fireplace that were put in place by John Veazey (1645-1700). The second addition to the house was built prior to 1791 and is known as the "Federal" addition. The house with this addition was described in a legal document bearing that

date, Mrs. Davis said. Thomas Ward Veazey, the governor of Maryland from 1836 to 1839, two of his three wives, several of his children and in-laws are buried in the family cemetery in the front yard of Cherry Grove.

Family members also had an opportunity to tour and eat lunch at St. Stephen's Episcopal Church (organized 1692) where the Veazeys were prominent in the vestry and where many records of births, marriages and deaths were recorded, said Mrs. Davis. They planned to stop by Essex Lodge, another Veazey ancestral home in the area; Mount Harmon, where Dr. John T. Veazey lived for a time in the 1800s; and Old Bohemia-St. Francis Xavier Shrine where Kitty Knight is buried and the site of the forerunner of Georgetown University. They were to have dinner at the Chesapeake City United Methodist Church for a farewell program by Mike Dixon, president of the Cecil County Historical Society.

Three of John Veazey's grandsons, Edward, James and Thomas, migrated to Granville County circa 1759 and settled the "Veazey Ridge." Edward Veazey died in Granville County around 1770 and left a will naming his children. He is the progenitor of most, if not all, of the Veazeys living in the Durham/Granville County area today.

After building a mill on the Knap of Reeds Creek in 1781, James Veazey migrated to Georgia circa 1784. Many of his descendants still live in the greater Veazey, Ga., area and attended the reunion in Maryland. The area where Thomas Veazey went is unknown.

It is the belief of Mrs. Davis that many neighbors of the Veazey family on the Delmarva Peninsula migrated into the Piedmont area of North Carolina. Martenet's 1858 map of Cecil County shows "Pearce's Neck" directly south of "Veazey's Neck."

The original source of family history information for the genealogy of the Veazey and other related families in the Camp Butner area was the series of articles written by Ben Patrick and run in the Durham Sun in 1942, the first of which was headlined, "For the First Time in 300 Years There Are No Veazeys on Veazey Ridge Tonight." It led Mrs. Davis to find cousins in Tennessee and Arkansas who traveled to Maryland to the reunion.

In addition to North Carolina, Maryland, Georgia, Tennessee and Arkansas, other states represented were Mississippi, Alabama, Texas, California, Kentucky, Florida and Virginia. A cousin from Canada was also in attendance.

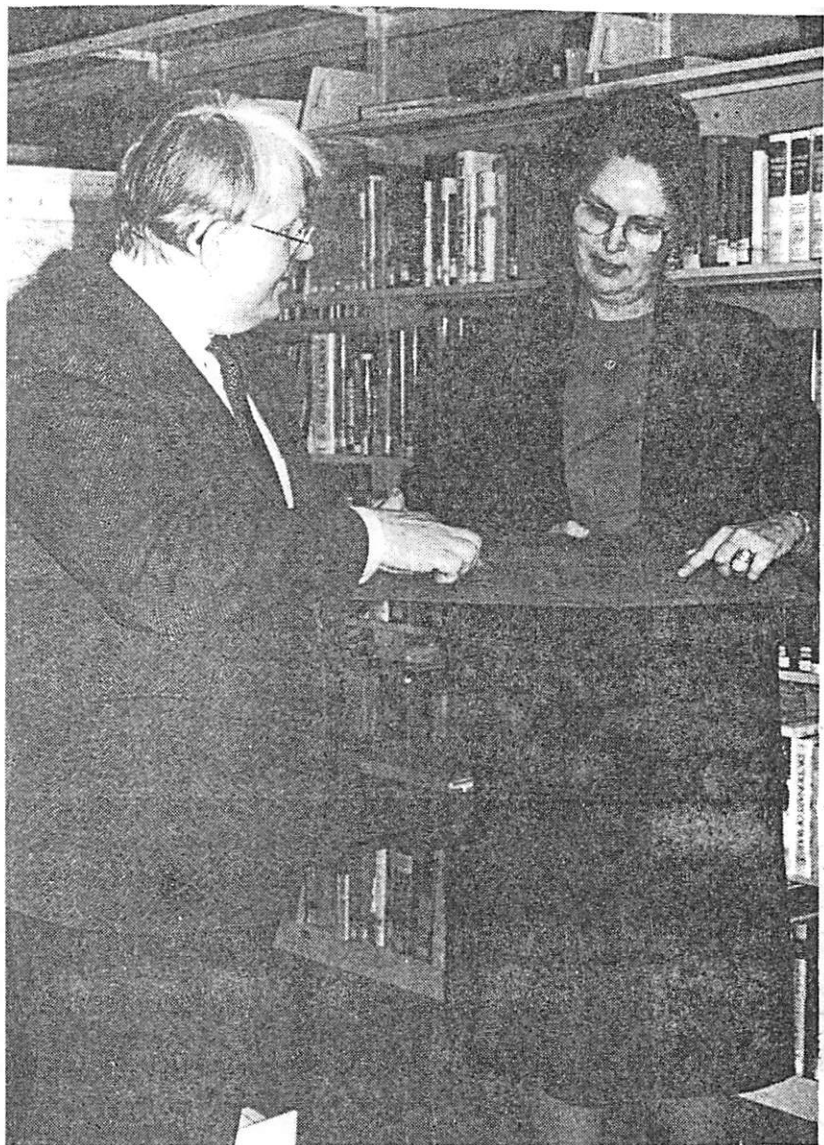

Davis traces family history

Zebulon genealogist Ann V. Davis was the featured speaker at the March 10 meeting of the Little River Historical Society. Dr. Jerry Cross, president of the society, introduced the topic, "What Motivates Us To Know Family History."

Mrs. Davis shared her experiences in tracing her Veazey family background.

She said from her early interest as an 8-year-old listening to family discussions about Veazey ancestors, she has been involved in her own pursuit of these sometimes elusive family members. Letters, wills, deeds and other family documents have taken her to several states as she "stumbled" onto new information.

Her most exciting discovery, she related, was an 1890s manuscript in Cook County, Va., that traced the Veazey family from circa 1670. This led to church records that provided the link needed to connect with her North Carolina family. She noted that at times she tracked down false leads but never stopped in her search.

She shared her collection of family photographs and documents which she has compiled into large notebooks. Mrs. Davis further noted that her computer has been invaluable in preparing her extensive family chart.

Rom Moser, program chairman, expressed appreciation for the insight provided on how to begin a family history. He announced that the speaker for the April 14 meeting will be Elizabeth W. Roberson. Mrs. Roberson is a teacher from Williamston who has written about a Georgia youth involved in the War Between the States. This meeting will be at the Zebulon Public Library at 8 p.m. The public is invited to attend.

I trust you will find reading about these in-laws to your family interesting. I hope you will find many other relatives or in-laws between the pages of this book. I would also recommend your reading Dot Curl's memoirs in Appendix C, Page 461. She really lent some color to life in that area in the 1800's and early 1900's. Having known Dot made it all the more interesting to me.



Good luck in your search.

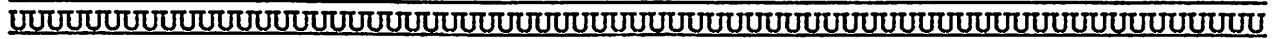

I was born and raised in the Yater Mill / Inwood (Candy) Ramcat area of Wake Co, NC. Enclosed is a copy of our "freedom" document.

Your book The Descendants of John Veasey probably contains information on quite a few residents of the North Central Area of NC. If so, and if it is not too expensive and if it is available I might like to purchase a copy. Could you let me know about the book. I find such books can be quite helpful. All four of my grandparents had their heritage in North Central NC [RAH, UPHURCH, CROSS, EDWARDS].

The first is Aubrey William Upchurch who married Irene Elaine Veasey (my 3rd cousin). Irene was the niece of Annie Veazey Hall who was our next door neighbor in Durham when I was growing up. Being 20 years older than I, she loved to play with me when she visited her aunt. She had a daughter a wee bit younger than me. Several of the other 14 folk in my database married into my Daddy's Veazey/Veasey family. OR my Mother's Critcher Family, etc. (The other note of interest Irene was a neighbor, a couple of houses down the street, from my husband's Mother! They were good buddies in the old days.)

In view of our prior exchanges (which I have to admit I can't remember at the moment) I guess you know that I published "Descendants of John Veazey" in 1995, which sold out in fairly short order. I coordinated 18 "International" Veazey-Veasey Reunions from 1993-2012, which included 2 cruises when no one offered to host a reunion. Let me give you a brief recap of how my Upchurch work has unfolded as a basis for more discussion and possible collaboration.

My first big move was to start the Upchurch Bulletin in 1980. I continued for 37 years publishing the last issue in 2016. In it I linked 62,000+ members of the America Upchurch family. In the early 2000's I realized the UB issues would never hold more than a fraction of my collection. In due course my records including professional, business, and family history were found to be valuable by N. C. State University and the Upchurch Collection was established in Special Collections in the D. H. Hill Library and endowed at \$50,000+. Some of my records are there already including a portion of my family history records and more will be added. However, as noted below, we also now have a Repository in Cary, NC where certain of my family history records will be placed in order to be more accessible to the public and researchers in particular.

In 2005 I finally took up computers and since have used email extensively now being in contact with 900 interested people. This led to a personal website in 2007 www.upchurchstory.com password 2013upchurch#. There all Upchurch Bulletins are posted and search-able along with 35 videos.

In 2012 I began to realize that a family association would be feasible and useful. Several cousins and I created in 2013 Upchurch and Allied Families Association, Inc a not-for-profit entity. In 2016 I contributed \$200,000 to set up an endowment to support the Association long-term. Our website is www.alliedfamilies.com password 2014allied#. There we are enrolling Upchurch and Allied and Associate families who have ancestors tracing back to the 1700's in NC. We are meeting with good success. We have an office in Chesterfield, MO where I live and one in Cary, NC the latter of which will become the national headquarters for our association. We currently have about a dozen volunteers who work out of our Cary Facility. My family history records are gradually being transferred to Cary. For the long-term we plan to have continued expansion of our websites including placing huge amounts of family history records there.
