Lending a hand is part of job for store owner Jimmy Strickland

In a world of cynicism and distrust, Jimmy Strickland still looks for the good in everyone. He still believes people should be given the benefit of the doubt, and he would "bend over backwards" to help a friend.

That's the way friends and family view Strickland, who can be found most days at his store/tire shop on Old U.S. 64 between Pilot and Zebulon.

The sign outside the store reads "Jimmy Strickland Grocery," but it's been quite some time since a loaf of bread or a tankful of gas could be purchased there. Strickland mainly operates a tire shop now, patching old treads and selling new ones.

What can be found usually is a bunch of folks passing the time away chatting

and playing cards. "Sometimes people ask me, 'Jimmy, don't that group of men worry you?' and I tell them, 'No, I enjoy it,'" he said.

Most of those men will agree that Strickland is the kind of guy who deserves a little recognition.

"I've known Jimmy since high school. He's always been an outgoing person, someone who will go the extra mile for you," said buddy Tommy Massey, who owns Wakefield Nursery. Along with tending Massey's landscaping equipment — "and taking good care of it" at that — Strickland has also been a good friend, said Massey.

"He's one of the most honest people I know," Massey said, adding he's sometimes too trusting of others. If people aren't able to pay for Strickland's services, he has faith that he'll get paid lat-

Jesmon "Jab" Tippet, who also spends a little time hanging around Strickland's store, said Strickland is the kind of guy who is "always around if you need something done. He's always been very accommodating. A lot of people like him. He has a good reputation and a good name."

Joe Vinson, who has also known Strickland for many years, agrees that Strickland's reputation around Zebulon is as good as gold. "He's a very fine person."

But the days of finding Strickland around his store may soon be a thing of the past. The times, said his wife, have made small country stores almost obsolete.

A few years ago, legislation was passed that required underground gas storage tanks to meet certain criteria. If

the tanks weren't up to muster, store owners had two options — bring them up to snuff or take them out of the ground and stop selling gas.

Strickland didn't have the money for the improvements and new tanks, so he stopped selling gas. And after running a store for over 20 years, Strickland said he felt like he was put out of business almost overnight.

"If I can find me a job, I may close up," he said. But he knows it will be hard working for someone after being his own boss for so many years. "I've had a good time."

And the men who like to pass the time away playing cards and checkers may have to find a new hangout. "It's something I will miss," said Strickland.

The way they feel about him, they might just follow him to his new job.

Neighbor of the month

"He's sometimes too good for his own good," said Strickland's wife, Sandra. "He's always willing to help people."

In addition to extending credit, Strickland also donates his time to care for a few plots at the Zebulon Cemetery.

Her husband's being named "Neighbor of the Month" is appropriate since he celebrated a 50th birthday last Friday, she said. "This will be a nice birthday present."

June expressed much interest in material I sent to her which mentions NATHANIEL CARTER. She reports:

He first appears on the road orders of Brunswick County, Va in 1736. He is in minor court cases in the court order books with John Vinson as his security. He is in in the Parish Book of St Andrews, Va where he is paid for keeping his mother who is unnamed, 1745 to 1752. (It's possible that she was Frances, widow of Thomas Carter who died about 1748 or before). He receives two patents, one in 1746 and one in 1756. He and Elendor sell these two patent in 1761 to William Renn and they moves to North Carolina. He has land in Granville County which probably became Bute County. (Some notes I have I am including). On Ratcliff's tax list 2 in 1766 in Bute County is Nathaniel Carter and Abraham Carter.

Nathaniel and Nelly Carter buy 120 acres of land from John Nall in Cumberland Count in 1767 which they sell to Drury Smith in 1779 and move on to Chatham County. Samuel Northington, a relative of mine, is a witness to this deed. Nathaniel dies in Chatham County in 1782. He leaves a wife unnamed, a son Vinson and two daughters Molly and Lusey. I would like to think he is father to Abraham Carter of Cumberland County but I can't prove that.

I would be interested in the Medlin material. One of Mark Williams daughters, Arabella Caroline Williams married a W.Q. Rayl in 1865, who was probably from outside of Raleigh. She was back in the City in 1871 when she testified on Mark's claim for property seized in 1865.
