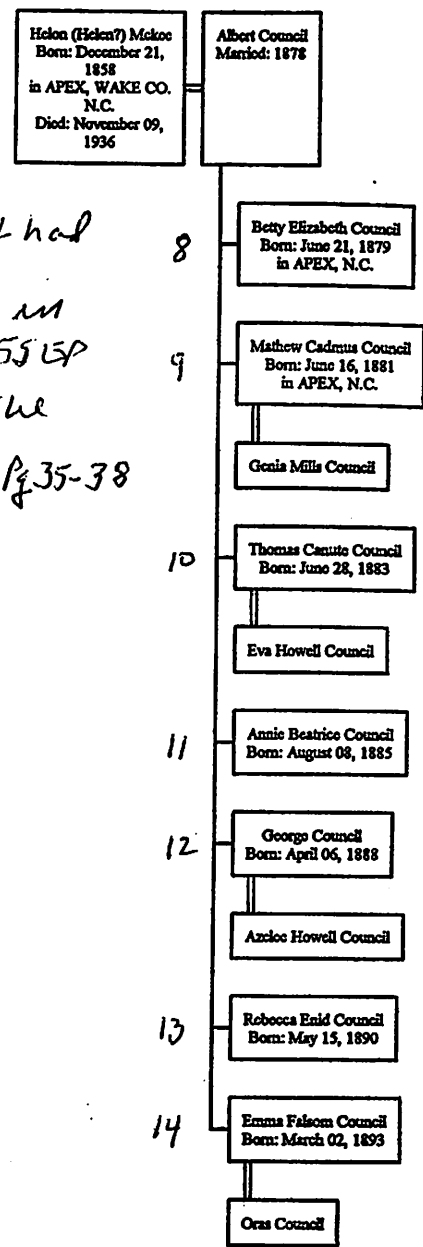

 to the Dry Goods store of [△]W. H. Tucker & [△]R. S. Tucker which
 after the war became famous. They found owner Williams
 W. Tucker lying on the counter taking a break.

The article posits that the first settlers in Wake Co

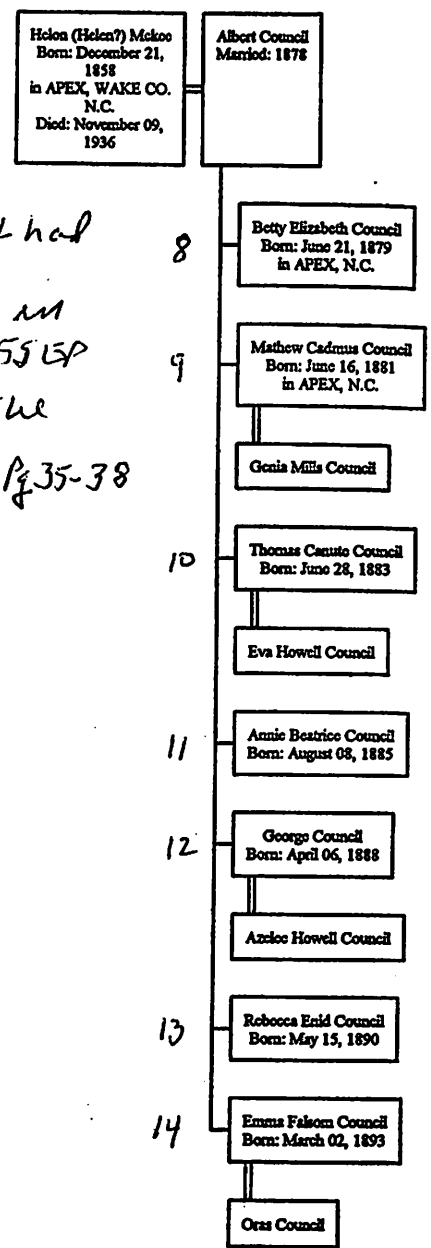

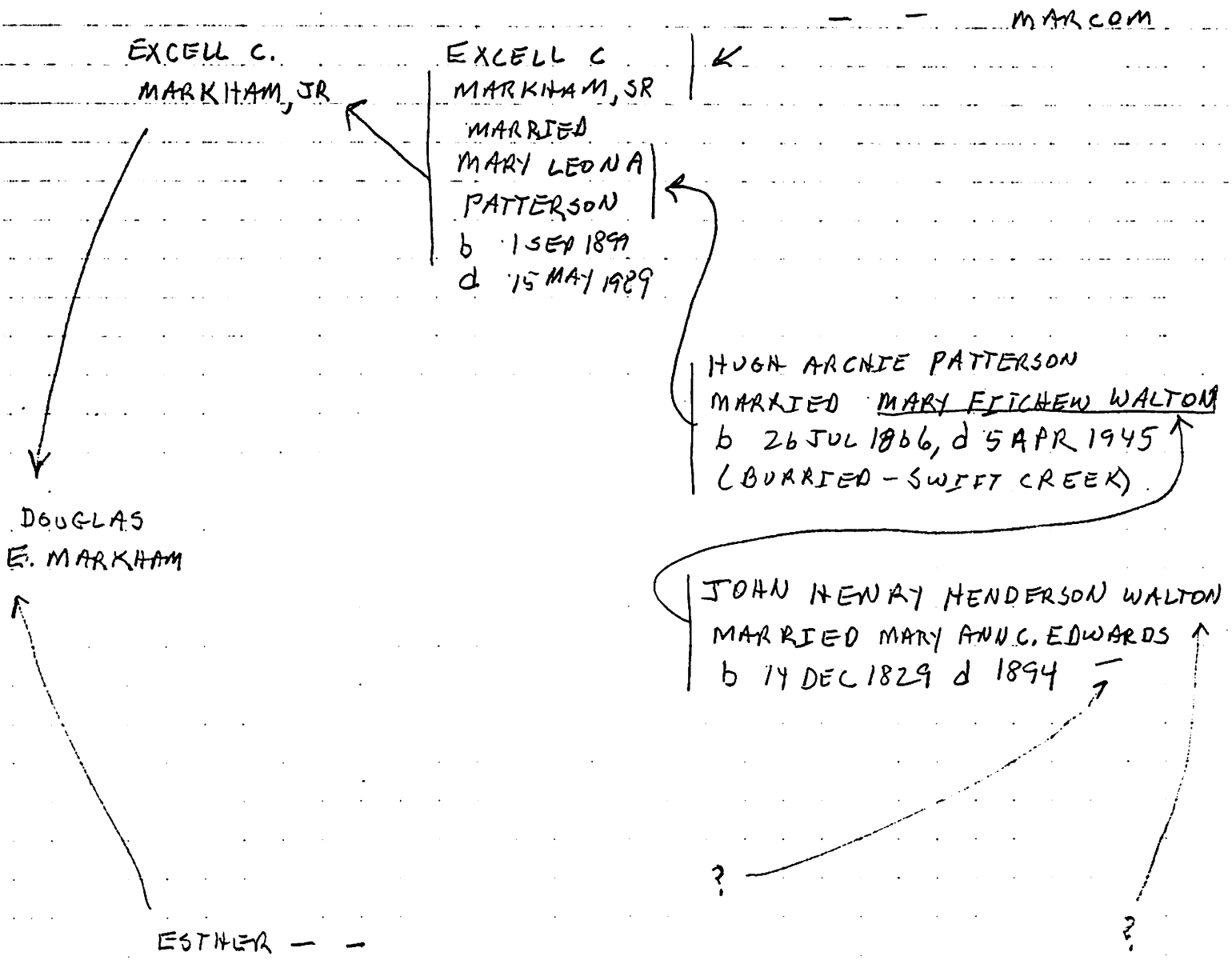
