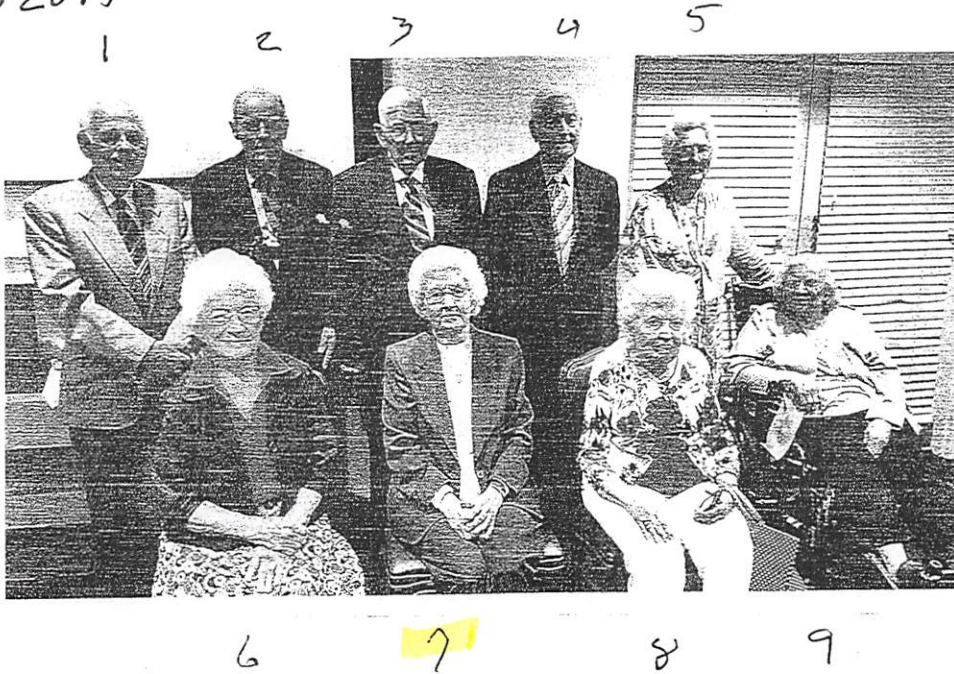

Floyd was expelled from Cary High in 10th grade over a School Bus Incident involving Eva Warner. Also involved *Jack Truelove, R. L. Bennett, *Billy Aubrey, *Floyd + Stanley Aubrey [* = Expelled]. The argument was over saving seats. One of those involved boned Floyd's trunk. Floyd went to Acford, NC to school 1 year - but then back to Cary - but dropped out.

Note: At the Cary High Reunion on 4 MAY 2007 I mentioned the above to Eva Warner. She did not seem to recall it. David Martin overheard the conversation and said he thought Floyd was expelled for fighting with him. Perhaps this was Floyd's second "event" - RPU

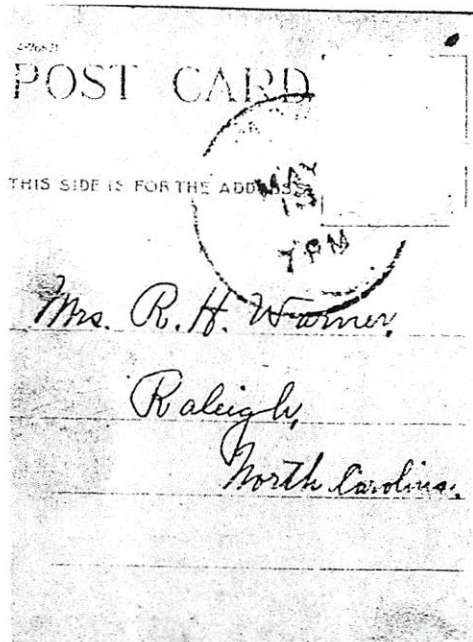

Letter One - Dated 12 APR 1922 Los Angeles, CA - signed Festus - 3 Pages written to Brothers & Sisters

Pa had apparently been visiting Festus in Los Angeles for about three years but not in good health. Walter [Walter Aderson Phillips] [Brother of Festus] was in LA also and took Pa to the train. Festus called wife Nina [Nina Elizabeth Melkisson] from work to ask her to take pictures of Pa before he left. Pa apparently went back to Raleigh, NC where his health deteriorated. So Festus was not surprised when Little Webster [Webster Clay Phillips s/o Festus] took the telegram which announced the death of Pa

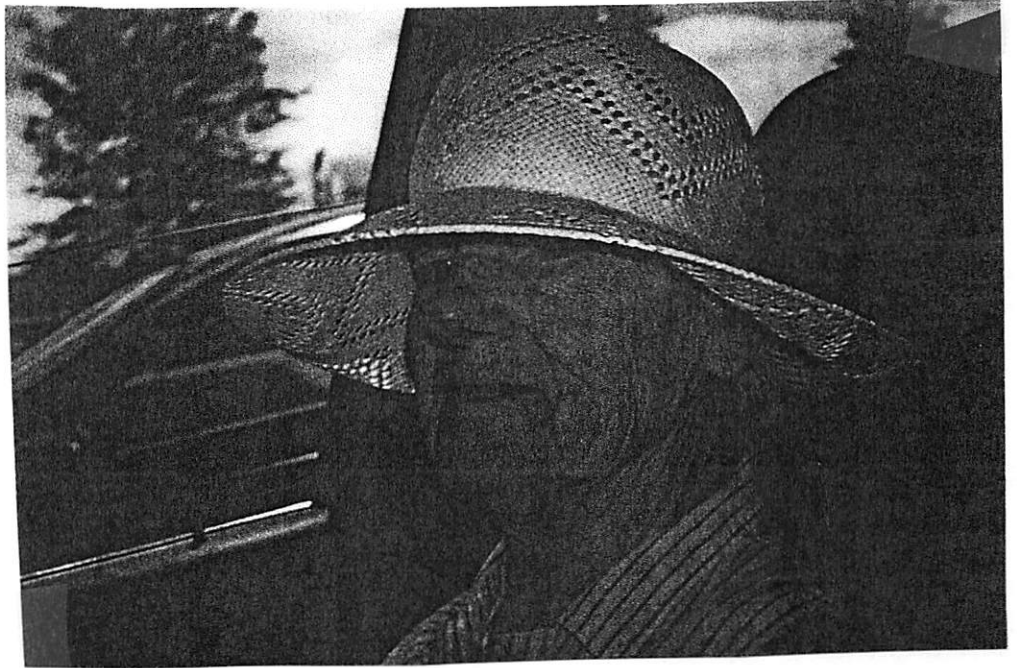

Paid on March 6, 1865.
- △ DIXON, BENJAMIN A., Private
 Enlisted in Wake County on May 15, 1864, for the war. Captured at Strasburg, Virginia, October 19, 1864, and confined at Point Lookout, Maryland, until paroled and exchanged at Boulwäre's Wharf, James River, Virginia, March 30, 1865.

 Resided in Virginia and enlisted in Wake County at age 46, August 29, 1862, for the war. Wounded at Chancellorsville, Virginia, May 3, 1863. Died in hospital at Richmond, Virginia, on May 15, 1863.

 Enlisted in Wake County on September 1, 1862, for the war. Admitted to hospital at Richmond, Virginia, October 31, 1862, with "debility" and furloughed for 30 days on December 31, 1862.
