I was referred to you by Mr. M. J. Upchurch of Mc Donough, Ga. I am seeking information about my Great-Grandmother, Amy Ann Upchurch Wasler. She was born in Jan. 8, 1846 + died Jan. 17, 19... She married John Wasler of Lawrence Co Alabama 4-15-1868. I have no record of their marriage license. I have a copy of Civil War Widow's Pension + she states she married in Lawrence Co, Ala.

Her parents were Richard Upchurch + Ellen Beasley. They married in Henry Co. Ga. 8-9-1836.

Amy Ann + John Wasler moved to Douglas, Ill. soon after they married. My Grandmother Margaret Lize Wasler Bailey was born in Douglas, Ill. 9-2-1881. They moved to Hill Co., Texas in 1882-1883. They were tenant farmers + moved frequently. John Wasler fought in the Civil War 19th Ala. Infantry. He was attached to the Army of Northern Virginia + fought at every major battle including Gettysburg.

Amy Ann + John Wasler are buried in Piles Valley Cemetery which is located near Itasca, Texas in Hill Co. I would appreciate any info you might have pertaining to this line of the Upchurch family.

John Washer  
1822 - 1903

In memory of John Washer, an old soldier of the Civil War, who died at Itasca, Texas, 22 November 1903. The subject of this notice was born 15 January 1822 in Smith County, Tennessee, making him 81 years, 10 months, and 7 days old.

QTH Δ John Washer was a son of William Washer, who moved with his family to this county in the pioneer days, and helped to blaze the way to the prosperity that is now smiling on our country.

When the drum beat to arms in 1861, John enlisted and went with the first company from Lawrence County, Alabama to Virginia. It formed a part of the 9th Alabama Infantry, and was known as the Color Company, or Co. C. of that regiment. He continued with the above Company to the close of the war, and took an active part in nearly all the big battles of that sanguinary period. He was ever true to his convictions, and battled earnestly for the success of what he believed to be right. His deportment in camp, on the battle field and in the hospital helped to make history that generations to come will read with admiration and awe. For so long as heroism is respected and emulated by free men will the deeds of courage and endurance of the Confederate Soldiers live in song and story.

At the close of the war, in shattered health and penniless, he returned home to work to help build up the waste places of our dearly but dessorated southland. He leaves behind him a wife and 8 children, 4 boys and 4 girls. I extend to each of them my heartfelt sympathy and pray and hope and trust that when the summons comes for us to go, that we will be ready for and permitted to, enter that rest prepared for the people of God.

No Place Like 'Home

**THE NAME GAME:** Mr. and Mrs. Wolsey P. Bailey have never moved from the house near ITASCA in which they have lived all 70 years of their married life (he's lived there 88 years) . . .

Mr. and Mrs. Wolsey, Philip Bailey, members of well known pioneer families in Hill County, observed their 70th wedding anniversary quietly at their home six miles southeast of Itasca, where they have lived all of their wedded lives, on Sunday.

Mr. Bailey, who will be 92 years old this coming November 6, is the son of the late Rufus K. and F. Ann Bailey, both of whom were born in Mississippi and came to Texas, settling near Osceola in Hill County in 1871.

Wolsey Bailey was born near Osceola on Nov. 6, 1878. He is the last surviving member of a family of 10 children—seven boys and three girls.

Mrs. Wolsey Bailey is the former Miss Margaret Susie Wash-

er. She was born near Dongola, Illinois on September 2, 1881, and will be 89 years of age her next birthday.

She moved with her parents, who were engaged in farming, to Texas, settling in the Itasca community near Osceola, when Mrs. Bailey was a small child. Later they moved to the Files Valley and Pluto communities and she attended school at both those communities.

Mrs. Bailey was one of nine children.

Both Mr. and Mrs. Wolsey Bailey's fathers fought in the Civil War and both were Confederate soldiers.

Mrs. Bailey has one sister and two brothers, living: Mrs. Martha Ince of Cleburne, and Joe Washer and M. K. Washer.

Mr. and Mrs. Bailey were married on May 6, 1900 while they were seated in a buggy. Rev. Bill Priddy, a Baptist minister, performed the ceremony. Both Mr. and Mrs. Bailey are long-time members of the First Baptist Church in Itasca. And the Church, incidentally, celebrated its 100th anniversary recently.

As a boy Mr. Bailey attended school at the old rock building at Rockwall, where later all of his children attended school.

Mr. Bailey has lived in his present home since moving, there when he was three years old 88 years ago. And he and his wife have continued to live in the comfortable old farm home ever since.

And in the years that have come and gone they remember much of the history of this area.

They recalled that about 1920 Mr. Bailey and his father, R. K.

Bailey, donated the rock from a quarry on their land to surface the road from their area to Itasca.

Prisoners from the Hill County jail provided the labor for many public projects in those days, and a prisoners' labor camp was located on the Bailey farm while this work was in progress. Wagons and teams and mule-drawn dirt-moving implements were the tools of that day.

A son, Mack Bailey, lives with his parents and farms the home place—with the help of his father Wolsey Bailey, who at 91 is still actively working.

He slowed down for a short period recently, when he broke his arm, but he is now able to "go again," family members explained, with love and pride in their parents' determination to remain independent and useful at their appointed work.

Mrs. Bailey, of course, still manages her household doing the work herself.

Mr. and Mrs. Bailey are the parents of ten children, six of whom are living today, and include: Mrs. C. A. Gardner of Lancaster; Mrs. Roland Tyler of Ferris; Mrs. Lee Spitzer of Kenosha, Wisconsin; John Bailey of Hillsboro; Mack Bailey of Itasca and D. E. (Nub) Bailey of Graford.

Four of the Bailey sons are deceased: Earl Bailey, Joe Bailey, Oscar Bailey and Wolsey Bailey Jr.

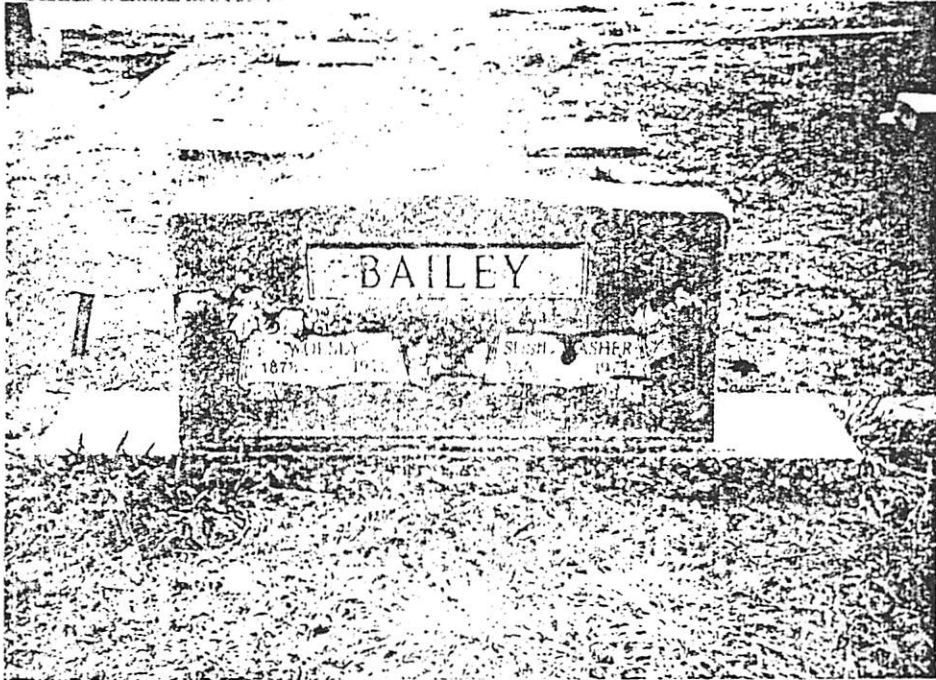

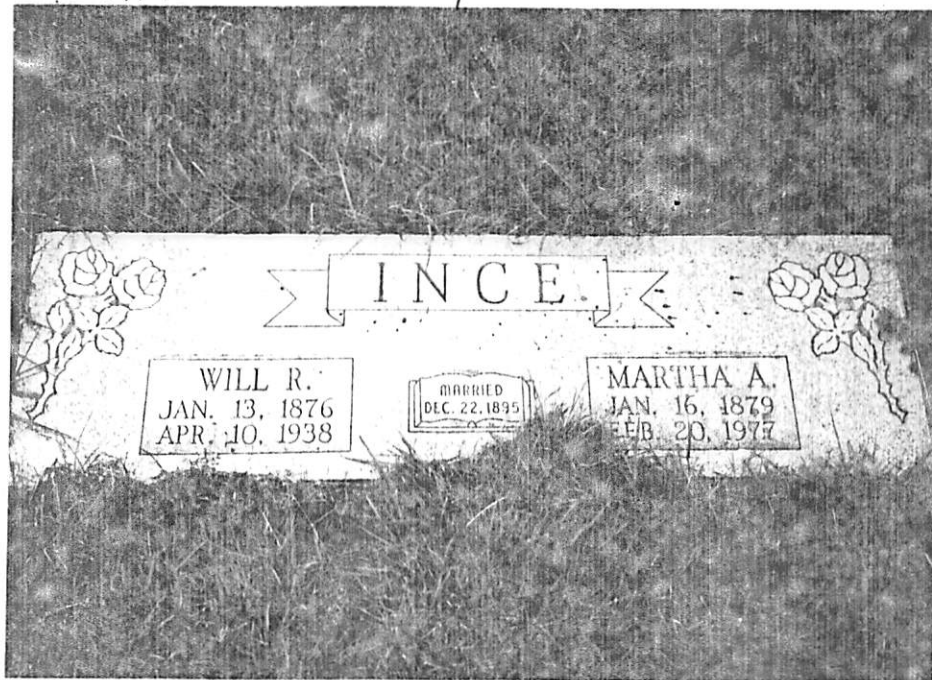

On a World War I draft registration card, Guy NEWBOLD lists his next of kin as "wife and 2 children". The card was dated June 5, 1917. From 1930 Census information, only 1 child born by 1917 is known. Either a child died, or perhaps a female not otherwise known got married by 1930. Unfortunately, Guy NEWBOLD cannot be found on the 1920 Federal Census.

Guy NEWBOLD is found on the 1930 Census in Johnson County Illinois with his wife Myrtle D. and four children. His occupation is "coal miner".

Interestingly, he and his wife are also listed living with his mother, Amanda on the same Census but in Williamson County. Looks like he got counted twice!

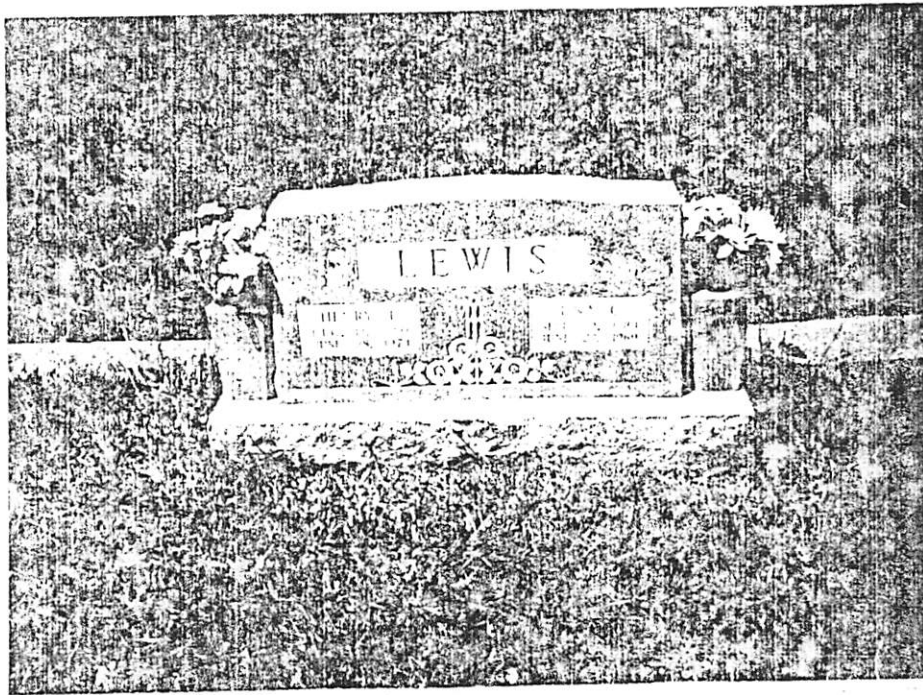

ful cause to obstruct the marriage for which said license is required, then the above obligation to be  
void, otherwise to remain in full force and effect.
