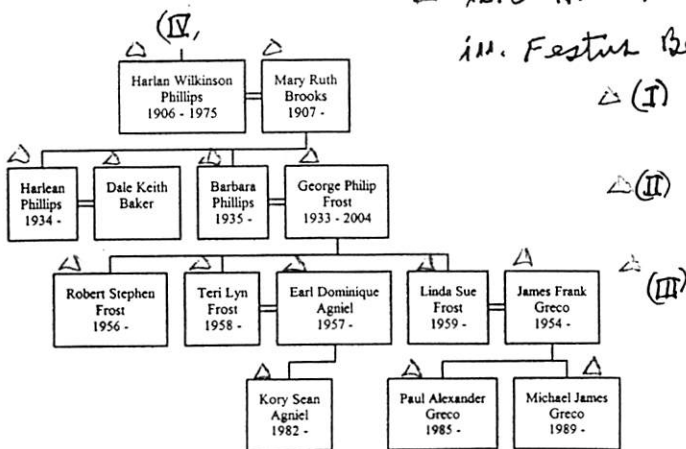
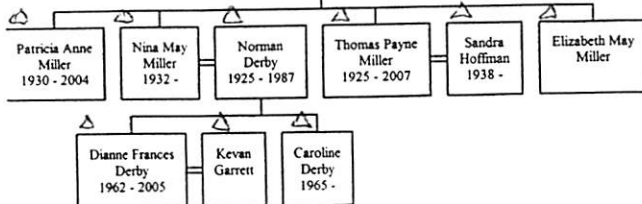

Dear Mr. Weathers:

On January 14, 1982 I visited The Very Reverend Charles Upchurch Harris, Jr. at his home in Carefree, Arizona relative to my keen interest in the history of the Upchurch family, much of which is centered in Wake Co., NC. Charles encouraged me to write to you saying that you and his father (my third cousin) were friends and that you recall Raleigh when it was a town of only 17,000 people. I have some specific questions for you but for now will welcome anything you can offer about how the Upchurches and their relatives were involved in the life of North Carolina. First let me give you some bits of information.

Your friend Charles Upchurch Harris, Sr. was the son of Florence Caroline (Upchurch) Harris who was the daughter of William Clinton Upchurch. Florence had a sister Roxanna Margaret Upchurch who married William Henry Dodd, one of the Mayors of Raleigh. Another sister Eleanor Marks Upchurch married her cousin William George Upchurch, a prominent merchant in Raleigh who died of cancer in 1895. My grandfather Bartley Jefferson Upchurch was a farmer in the Ramkatt area of Wake County (near Yates Mill Pond and Inwood Baptist Church). He was a first cousin of William Clinton Upchurch who was a merchant in Raleigh. These Upchurches came from the Apex area. Do you recall any of the individuals mentioned above?

I would welcome any comments or recollections you might have about any of the Upchurches or their relatives. My interest is serious as I publish a quarterly called UPCHURCH BULLETIN which is now in its third year.

Detained in Captain Samuel B. Water's Company, Provost Guard, Raleigh, March 10, 1864. Absent on detail through December, 1864. Admitted to hospital at Richmond, Virginia, March 1, 1865.

△ ★ UPCHURCH, DALLAS H., Private

Transferred from Company H, 31st Regiment N.C. Troops on March 10, 1862. Discharged on August 5, 1862, by reason of disability.

△ UPCHURCH, JAMES W., Sergeant

Resided in Wake County where he enlisted at age 22, July 16, 1861, for the war. Mustered in as Sergeant. Present or accounted for until captured at Spotsylvania Court House, Virginia, May 12, 1864. Confined at Point Lookout, Maryland, until transferred to Elmira, New York, August 6, 1864. Paroled at Elmira and sent to James River, Virginia, for exchange on February 20, 1865. Admitted to hospital at Richmond, Virginia, February 27, 1865, and furloughed for 30 days on March 7, 1865.

△ WALKER, JESSE J., Private

Resided in Ashe County and enlisted in Wake County at age 28, July 15, 1862, for the war. Present or accounted for until sent home sick May-June, 1863. Reported as absent sick until September 6, 1863, when he was reported as absent without leave. Reported as absent without leave on company muster rolls through December, 1864. Roll of Honor states that he "went home on sick furlough and deserted to the enemy about March 1, 1864." Federal Provost Marshal records indicate that he "came into Federal lines Plymouth, North Carolina" and took the Oath of Allegiance at Fort Monroe, Virginia, March 14, 1864.

△ WALL, JAMES, Private

Resided in Wake County where he listed at age 30, July 18, 1861, for the war. Present or accounted for until wounded in action at Payne's Farm, Virginia, November 27, 1863. Died in hospital at Richmond, Virginia, December 10, 1863, of gunshot wound.

△ WALT, GEORGE F., Private

Paroled at Greensboro on May 22, 1865.

△ WATKINS, CLINTON, Private

Resided in Wake County where he enlisted at age 23, July 18, 1861, for the war. Wounded in action at Sharpsburg, Maryland, September 17, 1862, and captured and paroled near Keedysville, Maryland, September 20, 1862. On pages 269 & 270 the Author describes the antebellum situation with regards to Raleigh merchants. In 1851 owners were concerned with being open too long - from sunrise until dark 5-7 in summer - a 14 hour day. The 1851 movement came to naught. In 1858 the merchants were concerned about the practice of extending 12 months credit. These interests did not lead to a formal merchants association until years later. Those signing a document in January 1858 as representatives at a Commercial Convention in Richmond are listed below.
