On January 14, 1982 I visited The Very Reverend Charles Upchurch Harris, Jr. at his home in Carefree, Arizona relative to my keen interest in the history of the Unchurch family, much of which is centered in Wake Co., NC. Charles encouraged me to write to you saying that you and his father (my third cousin) were friends and that you recall Raleigh when it was a town of only 17,000 people. I have some specific questions for you but for now will welcome anything you can offer about how the Upchurches and their relatives were involved in the life of North Carolina. First let me give you some bits of information.

Your friend Charles Upchurch Harris, Sr. was the son of Florence Caroline (Unchurch) Harris who was the daughter of William Clinton Upchurch. Florence had a sister Rosanna Margaret Upchurch who married William Henry bod, one of the Mayors of Raleigh. Another sister Eleanor Marks Upchurch married her cousin William George Upchurch, a prominent merchant in Raleigh who died of cancer in 1895. My grandfather Barkley Jefferson Unchurch was a farmer in the Ramkatt area of Wake County (near Yates Mill Pond and Inwood Baptist Church). He was a first cousin of William Clinton Upchurch who was a merchant in Raleigh. These Upchurches came from the Apex area. Do you recall any of the individuals mentioned above?

I would welcome any comments or recollections you might have about any of the Upchurches or their relatives. My interest is serious as I publish a quarterly called UPGHURCH BULLETYN which is now in its third year.
