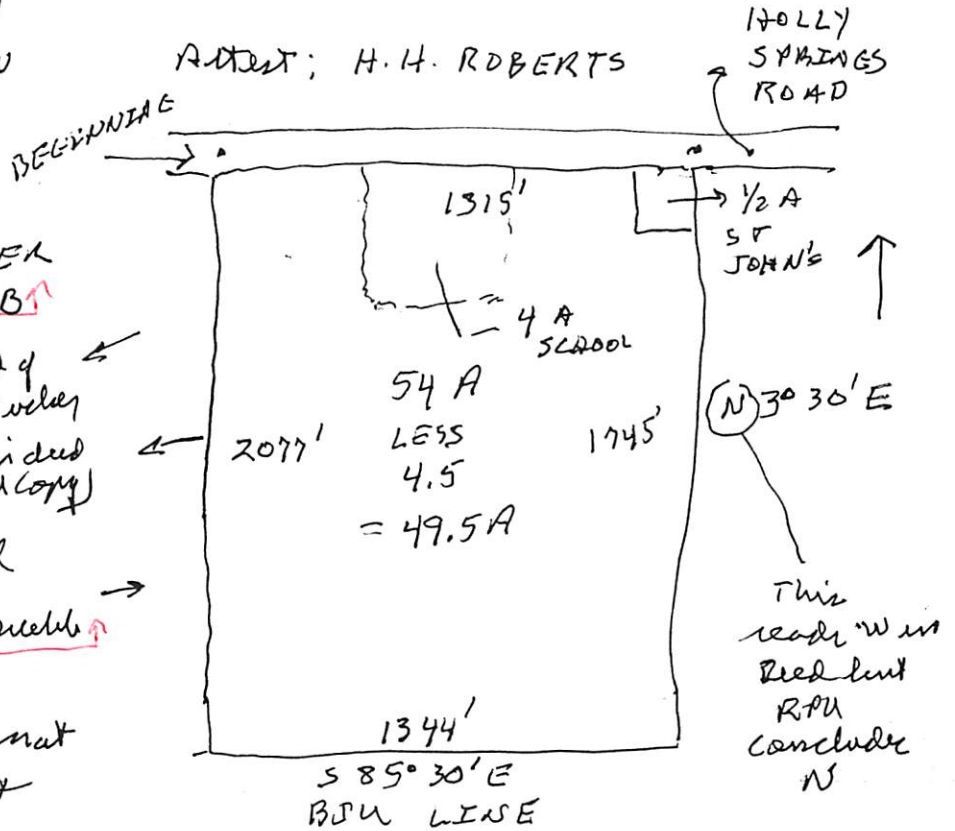

James Ted Best, M.D. of Cary, died suddenly at home Saturday morning, Nov. 8. A memorial service was held Nov. 11 at St. Paul's Episcopal Church in Cary. A private cremation will be at a later date.

Dr. Best was born in Stantonsburg, Wilson County, on March 11, 1933, the son of Rex and Annie Bass Best. FISHER, Charles Frederick

Born in Rowan County where he resided as a farmer and as a president of a North Carolina Railroad. Appointed Colonel to rank from May 16, 1861. Killed at the first battle of Manassas, Virginia, 21 July 1861, "[while] gallantly leading his men."

PENDER, William Dorsey

Previously served as Colonel of the 13th Regiment N.C. Troops (3rd Regiment N.C. Volunteers). Appointed Colonel of this regiment to rank from 17 August 1861. Transferred from this regiment on 11 June 1862, upon appointment to Brigadier General to rank from 3 June 1862.

AVERY, Isaac E.

Previously served as Captain of Company E of this regiment. Appointed Lieutenant Colonel to rank from 1 June 1862, and transferred to the Field and Staff. Promoted to Colonel to rank from 11 June 1862. Wounded at Malvern Hill, Virginia, 1 July 1862. Wounded at Gettysburg, Pennsylvania, 2 July 1863, and died 3 July 1863.

WEBB, Robert F.

Previously served as Captain of Company B of this Regiment. Appointed Major to rank from 11 July 1861, and transferred to the Field and Staff. Promoted to Lieutenant Colonel to rank from 11 July 1862. Wounded at Sharpsburg, Maryland, 17 September 1862. Promoted to Colonel on 3 July 1863. Captured at Rappahannock Station, Virginia, 7 November 1863, and confined at Johnson's Island, Ohio, until released on 25 July 1865, after taking the Oath of Allegiance.

Some details on COMPANY "I"
 OF THE 6TH REGIMENT ARE:

The company, known as "Cedar Forks Rifles," was from Wake and Chatham Counties and enlisted in Wake County on 28 May 1861. It went into the camp of instruction near Company Shops (Burlington), Alamance County, 1 June 1861, and was assigned to this regiment [Sixth Regiment] as Company I. After joining the regiment, the company functioned as a part of the regiment, and its history for the war period is recorded as a part of the regimental history.

LIEUTENANT COLONELS

DORTCH, William Theophilus

Resided in Wayne County. Appointed Lieutenant Colonel to rank from 16 May 1861. Resigned on 11 July 1861, to assume the duties of Speaker of the House of Commons, North Carolina State Legislature.

Promoted to Lieutenant Colonel on 3 July 1863. Wounded at Cedar Creek, Virginia, 19 October 1864. Paroled at Morganton on 16 May 1865, and paroled again at Salisbury [NC] on 17 June 1865.

MAJOR

YORK, Richard Watt

Previously served as Captain of Company I of this regiment. Appointed Major on 3 July 1863, and transferred to the Field and Staff. Wounded at Fisher's Hill, Virginia, 22-23 September 1864, and was reported absent wounded through February, 1865.

The information contained in the following roster of the company was compiled principally from company muster rolls for 20 June 1861, through February 1864, and 15 September through December 1864. No company muster rolls were found for the period prior to 20 June 1861; for March through 14 September 1864; or for the period after December 1864. In addition to the company muster rolls, Roll of Honor records, receipt rolls, hospital records, prisoner of war records, and other primary records, supplemented by state pension applications, United Daughters of the Confederacy records, and postwar rosters and histories, all provided useful information.
