
The family will receive friends Saturday from 10-11 a.m. in the church parlor of First Baptist Church in Goldsboro.

CATHERINE DOANE WELCH - Age 94, died on January 29, 1999 at a local hospice. She was born March 22, 1904 in Dodd City, Texas (Fannin County) where her father was the mayor and editor of the newspaper. Her mother was Henryetta Friske Welch and her father was John Curry Welch, both are now deceased. Catherine married Hubert Grant Farmer of Bonham, Texas (Fannin County) on September 5, 1923 in Sherman, Texas. He predeceased her on January 4, 1987 in Dallas and is buried in the Farmer Plot in the Acacia Lawn Section of Restland, Dallas. She is survived by two sons and their wives; John Grant and Patricia Barnard Farmer and Dudley Graham and Gail Hammond Farmer; five grandchildren, John William Farmer, Randolph Welch Farmer, Charles Grant Farmer, Kimberley Kasira and Christopher Graham Farmer; five great grandchildren, Laura Leigh Farmer Allen, John Stephen Farmer, Caroline Rebecca Farmer, Thomas Grant Farmer and Catherine Ann Farmer. Catherine attended Bonham Schools until her senior year which was spent in Norman (Oklahoma) High School from which she graduated and immediately returned to Bonham.

Catherine was a direct descendant of Deacon John Doane, the Royal Forester, who came to Plymouth, Massachusetts in 1628 from England. It was the Doane family that started the Episcopal Church in America. She was also a direct descendant of John Welch of Ayr, Scotland, who with his father-in-law, John Knox, was known as the reformer of the Scotland Presbyterians. The Welch's came to Charleston, S. Carolina in 1682. Catherine retired from the nursery of East Dallas Christian Church at age 90, after 33 years of service. She belonged to the Holy Trinity Episcopal Church in Bonham. She was a former member of the S.M.U. Mother's Club and a former member of the Lambda Chi Alpha Fraternity Mother's Club at S.M.U. At her request, there will only be a graveside service at 11:00 AM on Monday, February 1, 1999. The Rev. Edwin Michael will officiate. Interment will be beside her husband, Grant. In lieu of flowers, please send your memorials to the American Cancer Society or to your favorite charity in Catherine's name. The family would like to thank the C.C. Young Home, the doctors and hospice nurse, Eileen Gallagher, RN for the gentle care they gave to our loved one during her last days.

Dr. David Walter Welch was born near Galatia, Ill., in 1848. He is the son of E. G. Welch and Nancy (Upchurch) Welch. The father was of an old Virginia family, but was raised at Murfreesboro, Tenn., and moved to Southern Illinois when quite a young man. Dr. Welch's mother was born at Galatia, which was founded by her father, David Upchurch, lived there all her life and died in the same village at the age of eighty. The father died at the ripe age of eighty-eight in the same village. Dr. Welch, the oldest of twelve children, was reared on the farm near Galatia, attended the village schools in winter and later the Illinois State Normal at Normal. He taught school for fifteen years, three years in Shawneetown, Ill.; two as assistant superintendent of Evansville, Ind., schools; two as superintendent of Rockport schools, which he re-organized and graded, and two as superintendent of schools in Boonville, Ind. He read medicine at home of evenings and afterwards in the office and under the tuition of Dr. George B. Walker, dean of the faculty at Evansville, Ind. He graduated from the Evansville Medical College in 1886, having previously lived in the country northeast of Mt. Vernon, Ind., for four years. He located in Mt. Vernon in 1888, where he has since resided. Some years ago he took a post-graduate course in the Chicago Clinical College, and served four years on the board of pension examiners during the Harrison administration, being associated with the late Drs. Smith and Holton. He was married in 1868 to Miss Jennie R. Wright, of Cloverport, Ky. They have five sons and two daughters, all grown and married. He is in politics a Prohibitionist. There are just two planks in his political platform. He hates whisky and mud. He is the originator of the movement which resulted in building more than 200 miles of rock and gravel roads in Posey county. He met fierce opposition and defied it. Before that the county had not a foot of decent road. They have at this time more than 200 miles and are still building.

David Walter Welch, M. D., of Mt. Vernon, was born in Saline county, Illinois, near Galatia, March 5, 1848, and is a son of Egbert G. and Nancy (Upchurch) Welch. His father was a native of Tennessee, and came of an old Virginia family, and at the age of eighty-eight years he died at Galatia, Ill., where he was a pioneer settler, and his mother was born at Galatia, Ill., and was a daughter of David Upchurch, who came from North Carolina to Illinois, and was the founder of Galatia. Dr. Welch was reared on the farm, attended the country schools, and the Illinois State Normal at Normal, Ill., and then engaged in the profession of school teaching for fifteen years. He was superintendent of schools at Rockport, Ind., for two years, of the schools of Boonville, Ind., for two years, having previously been assistant superintendent of schools at Evansville, Ind. His early teaching was in Illinois. He was at Shawneetown for three years. He read medicine in the office of Dr. George B. Walker, dean of the Evansville Medical College. He then began practice in the country about five miles northeast of Mt. Vernon. He located in Mt. Vernon in 1888. He did post-graduate work at the Chicago Clinical College, and is a member of the Mt. Vernon City, the Posey County, and Indiana State Medical societies, and also of the Ohio Valley Medical Association. Dr. Welch married in 1868 Jennie R. Wright, of Cloverport, Ky. They have five sons and two daughters. The Doctor is a Prohibitionist in politics. He is not only an able and prominent physician, but as a citizen is progressive. To him is largely due the steps that led to the improvement of the public roads in Posey county, in which matter he received strong opposition, but the splendid roads of the county stand as a monument to his spirit of progress and foresight.

Dr. David Walter Welch was born near Galatia, Ill., in 1848. He is the son of E. G. Welch and Nancy (Upchurch) Welch. The father was of an old Virginia family, but was raised at Murfreesboro, Tenn., and moved to Southern Illinois when quite a young man. Dr. Welch's mother was born at Galatia, which was founded by her father, David Upchurch, lived there all her life and died in the same village at the age of eighty. The father died at the ripe age of eighty-eight in the same village. Dr. Welch, the oldest of twelve children, was reared on the farm near Galatia, attended the village schools in winter and later the Illinois State Normal at Normal. He taught school for fifteen years, three years in Shawneetown, Ill.; two as assistant superintendent of Evansville, Ind., schools; two as superintendent of Rockport schools, which he re-organized and graded, and two as superintendent of schools in Boonville, Ind. He read medicine at home of evenings and afterwards in the office and under the tuition of Dr. George B. Walker, dean of the faculty at Evansville, Ind. He graduated from the Evansville Medical College in 1886, having previously lived in the country northeast of Mt. Vernon, Ind., for four years. He located in Mt. Vernon in 1888, where he has since resided. Some years ago he took a post-graduate course in the Chicago Clinical College, and served four years on the board of pension examiners during the Harrison administration, being associated with the late Drs. Smith and Holton. He was married in 1868 to Miss Jennie R. Wright, of Cloverport, Ky. They have five sons and two daughters, all grown and married. He is in politics a Prohibitionist. There are just two planks in his political platform. He hates whisky and mud. He is the originator of the movement which resulted in building more than 200 miles of rock and gravel roads in Posey county. He met fierce opposition and defied it. Before that the county had not a foot of decent road. They have at this time more than 200 miles and are still building.

David Walter Welch, M. D., of Mt. Vernon, was born in Saline county, Illinois, near Galatia, March 5, 1848, and is a son of Egbert G. and Nancy (Upchurch) Welch. His father was a native of Tennessee, and came of an old Virginia family, and at the age of eighty-eight years he died at Galatia, Ill., where he was a pioneer settler, and his mother was born at Galatia, Ill., and was a daughter of David Upchurch, who came from North Carolina to Illinois, and was the founder of Galatia. Dr. Welch was reared on the farm, attended the country schools, and the Illinois State Normal at Normal, Ill., and then engaged in the profession of school teaching for fifteen years. He was superintendent of schools at Rockport, Ind., for two years, of the schools of Boonville, Ind., for two years, having previously been assistant superintendent of schools at Evansville, Ind. His early teaching was in Illinois. He was at Shawneetown for three years. He read medicine in the office of Dr. George B. Walker, dean of the Evansville Medical College. He then began practice in the country about five miles northeast of Mt. Vernon. He located in Mt. Vernon in 1888. He did post-graduate work at the Chicago Clinical College, and is a member of the Mt. Vernon City, the Posey County, and Indiana State Medical societies, and also of the Ohio Valley Medical Association. Dr. Welch married in 1868 Jennie R. Wright, of Cloverport, Ky. They have five sons and two daughters. The Doctor is a Prohibitionist in politics. He is not only an able and prominent physician, but as a citizen is progressive. To him is largely due the steps that led to the improvement of the public roads in Posey county, in which matter he received strong opposition, but the splendid roads of the county stand as a monument to his spirit of progress and foresight.



A basketful of Apex

Lina Dowd has lived near Apex her entire life.

Growing up she was one of eight children in the Welch family in the Olive Chapel area. Later, she married Lynn Dowd and moved to Green Level.

Lynn passed away in 1979.

After brushing the edges of the town for 66 years, Lina finally moved to Apex in 1983.

That was about the time she took up basket weaving.

A woman named Judy Mallow peaked Lina's interest then with a course on how to turn ordinary pine needles into extraordinary baskets.

She has been at it ever since.

"I just enjoyed doing it, it helps me to have something to do," Lina says.

Lina collects the needles that fall to the ground outside of her home, making sure to only pick up the straight ones.

She then takes a pot of boiling water and pours it over them, letting the needles soak for two hours.

"That kind of helps to soften them up so you can work with them better," she says.

Lina follows up by scraping off the dark ends. Then, the pine needles are ready for sewing.

Her only tools are a wide-eyed

sewing needle and an inch-long metal gauge so Lina can tell when to introduce a new pine needle to the basket.

She weaves them together with all the patience and care her old fingers can afford — she has to pause every so often because it pains her back to sit in one place too long.

Depending on the size of the basket, Lina also adds up to 13 black walnuts. They are sliced thin and sewn in, and are the highlight of the unique design.

She uses a nylon upholstery thread to band the needles together — nylon because "It's real strong."

Lina knows thread — with three daughters to raise, she says she was "always making one thing or another."

"I made my children's clothes when they went to school," Lina adds.

She double stitches the thread along the top of the basket, for looks mainly, and reinforcement.

"You have to go from one stitch over to another to make them straight every time," she says.

"When making baskets, you have to keep the white ends from showing," she says.

When all finished, Lina coats the basket with a "pure orange shellac" and lets it dry.

"It takes about a day to make a little one," she says, "and takes about a week to make the ones with 13 nuts in them."

The finished baskets decorate her home. She has made them for family, friends, friends' friends — really just about anyone.

"I made 200 for a couple who were going to some kind of meeting and wanted to give the baskets away," Lina says.

The hand-crafted baskets that Lina Dowd gives away to others could be making her a lot of money, thinks Carole Kish, owner of the "Unique and Wonderful Place" store in downtown Apex.

So, Kish decided to put the baskets in her store, with all the proceeds of the sale going to Lina.


