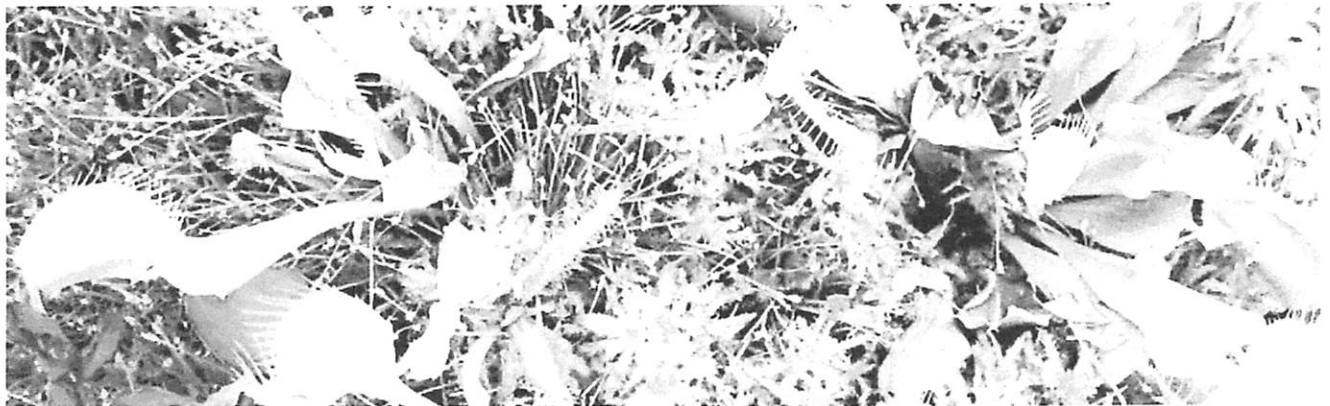

Plant Community Ecology

Research Interests:

My principal research interest is the description, classification, and study of environmental relationships of natural vegetation, with special emphases on conservation ecology and biodiversity. This broad interest has taken many directions, including studies of distributional consequences of plant biochemical differences, plant water relations, and plant mineral nutrition. Much of my work involves use of mathematical/statistical approaches to analysis of community data (numerical classification and gradient analysis). My dissertation research was a comparison of vegetation patterns on limestone and more acidic rocks in the mountains of southeastern Arizona, and I continue to have an interest in contrasts in vegetation found on varied substrates. A large part of my current research effort is focused on characterization of vegetation in the mountain and coastal plain regions of North Carolina. I am a co-founder and principal investigator of the *Carolina Plant Community Ecology Project*, which has as its goal the thorough characterization of the natural vegetation of North and South Carolina using quantitative data on vegetation and environment from a statewide network of permanent plots.

Other research interests include population biology, competitive interactions, and molecular ecology of plants. I have worked frequently in the area of applied research and collaborate frequently with faculty in other departments at NC State University, such as Forestry and Horticulture. Through efforts of the Carolina Vegetation Survey, I have assisted state and federal agencies interested in restoration of degraded ecosystems. Other applied projects have included development of criteria for the use of vegetation in the designation of wetlands, studies of the effects of commercial logging and site preparation practices on regrowth of natural vegetation, and analysis of the impacts of pine straw raking on natural vegetation in longleaf pine forests.

Hi Tom---

I am delighted to find that you and I have a mutual interest in local history pertaining to Swift Creek Township and I have placed you on the list to get future copies. Based on your email and web site it would appear you and I possibly have other mutual interests as well.

Your reference to AZ caught my eye. I was with the University of Arizona 1975-1995 and after retiring from there in 1975 moved to MO where we have children, grandchildren and farm land. While at the University I created the Desert Legume Program in 1988. I also was closely connected with the Boyce Thompson Arboretum and originated the magazine DESERT PLANTS. Both of these entities are ongoing.

You and I have common roots in ecology. As an undergraduate at NCSU I took courses in ecology and systematics under B. W. Wells, a grand Professor. I was also enmeshed in the Forage Crops Program and became grounded in forage crop ecology. When I arrived at the University of California -Davis to do graduate work in 1950 I found no courses in ecology. CA discovered ecology later. I became a high school part-time worker in Agronomy at NCSU in 1942 and dropped out of high school after three years in June 1944 to take a full-time technician position with the forage program. I returned from CA in 1950 to take a weed science position and left in 1965 as a full professor. My linkage continues as in 2007 I established the Upchurch Collection in the D. H. Hill Library. They have agreed to archive all of my professional, business personal, and family history papers. I have established a fund to endow this venture.

Back to the Swift Creek Community, I have a subject on which I would like your opinion. I want to present aspects of the plant world in INSIGHTS including something about the turpentine industry which I believe is based largely on the long leaf pine. It was robust in the Apex-Fuquay area in the late 1800's. That is just west of the Township. My belief is that fingers of the long leaf pine-wire grass climax extended up into the southern part of SCTWP. For example, I would guess that the area of Ten Ten Road which traverses the southern part of SCTWP had a good stand of long leaf pine. By the time I came along I could create no memories of such stands. Old timers I have interviewed barely remember the odd such pine. Any comments you can offer will be appreciated.

As to land records you and I also have interests. The person working with land grants was the late Jim Jones, a dear friend of mine. His work is packed away and it's future uncertain. I have some linkage to the outcome. There are many land subjects to be addressed in INSIGHTS. The site of Enterprise School which preceded Swift Creek Elementary was near you at 5504 Yates Mill Pond Road, recently the home of my dear late friend Josephine Jeffreys. My cousins the Wilson's lived nearby and still do. I have recently discovered that my Great Uncle W. G. Upchurch and his partner in 1882 bought 997 acres just west of Swift Creek Elementary on what is now Campbell Road. These are just two snippets. I have tons more.

Sorry to go on so but our backgrounds have so much in common that I got carried away.

During nearly 20 years at NCSU, I've been fortunate to take my passion for the study of vegetation from the coast to the mountains of the varied and beautiful state that is now my home. While academia provides an enormously stimulating, challenging, and intellectually rewarding work environment, it is all-consuming, at least for mere mortals like myself. I regret the outside interests and friendships that have fallen by the wayside while pursuit of career remained foremost. I'm pleased to list above a few activities that I have at least made a stab at pursuing.

Among personal concerns, I guess I'd put foremost the frustration of taking so long to figure out what it is I want to do and then taking even longer to figure out how to achieve it. My global concerns focus on environmental issues, particularly the irreversible losses of natural habitat and biological diversity that are leading us rapidly, I believe, to a world that is depleted of the very natural things that humans ultimately cherish most highly. Burgeoning human population is the root cause of much environmental and social misery, and a cause we seem ill-equipped to address effectively. On the political front, I feel that we could solve many of our problems if we could figure out how to be (simultaneously) fiscally conservative and socially liberal.



RALEIGH – Virginia Dare White Little, 91, of Morningside in Raleigh, died on May 23, 2005 following a brief illness.
