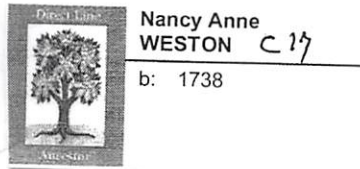
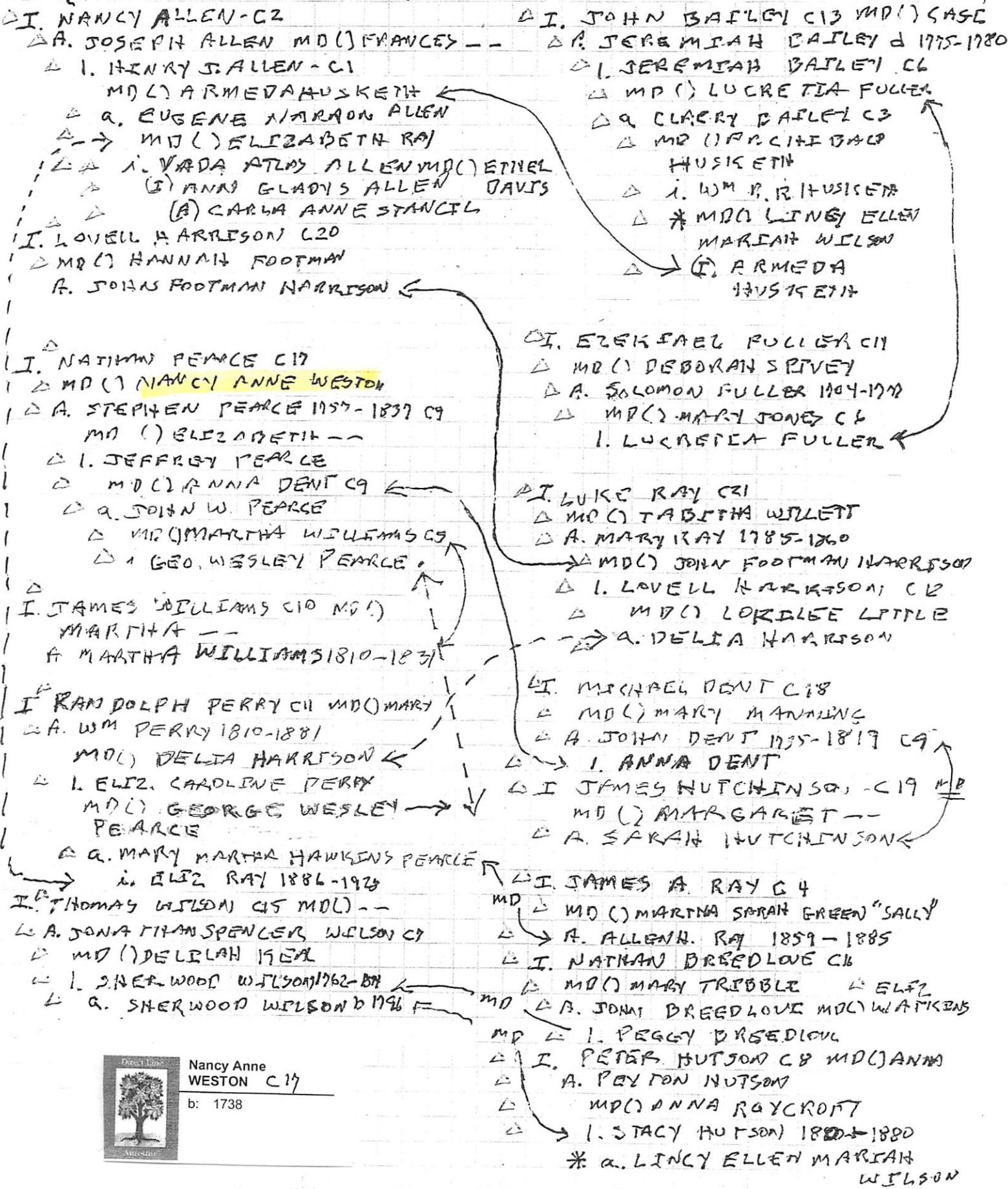

Oda Martin Upchurch Carter, was born 25 September 1879 at home in a house on Otter Creek near Slickford, Kentucky, to Mary Jane Upchurch, dau of Moses and Harriett Grimes Upchurch. After Mary Jane married Edmund Grant Carter in 1883, Oda was four years old, he began using the name of his step-father, Carter. Oda "Odie" married first, Sarah Jane Combest Rice, widow of George M. Rice, M.D. (1868-1905). Oda graduated from Louisville Medical School in 1904.

On return to Wayne Co. he began to practice with Dr. Rice in Powersburg, Ky. Dr. Rice and family moved to Monticello and asked Dr. Carter to come with them to be a partner in practice there. Dr. Rice died in 1905 and Oda married Sarah Jane Combest Rice, September 1907. Sons of George and Sarah Rice were Horace, b. 1869, died 1910; Edward Bayard Rice b. 28 March 1898 d. 19 September 1948. Edward also went to Louisville Medical School and became a Doctor. Both sons are buried in Elk Springs Cem. Monticello, Ky. with their parents.

Dr. Oda Carter built the Hospital in Monticello, a three story white frame building of thirty four rooms, located on Columbia Ave. in Monticello. Living quarters were on the first floor, with office and waiting room. The operating room and patients rooms were on the second floor, the third floor was solely for patients. There was no city water or electricity for the hospital in those days, but there was a big water tank on a tower in back of the house, which provided the water system. There was a bathroom on each floor and a lavatory in each patient's room. Dr. Carter installed a Delco system that provided lighting. After City lighting was installed, in case of power failure, which happened quite often, they switched to Delco.

Oda and Sarah had a daughter, Mary "Lena" Carter, born 8 August 1908, who married Robert Eugene Hughes and they lived in Okeechobee, Florida. They had a son, Robert Kay Hughes, who married Helen ____? they had two children, Holly Kay and Honey Hughes, no other info.

Oda and Sarah were divorced, Lena says her mother operated a hotel and dining room in the former Hospital. (? if Dr. Carter built the hospital, where did he go?) Dr. Oda Carter married his office nurse, Ora Weston they had a daughter, Alice Jane Carter, who married and lived in the East.
