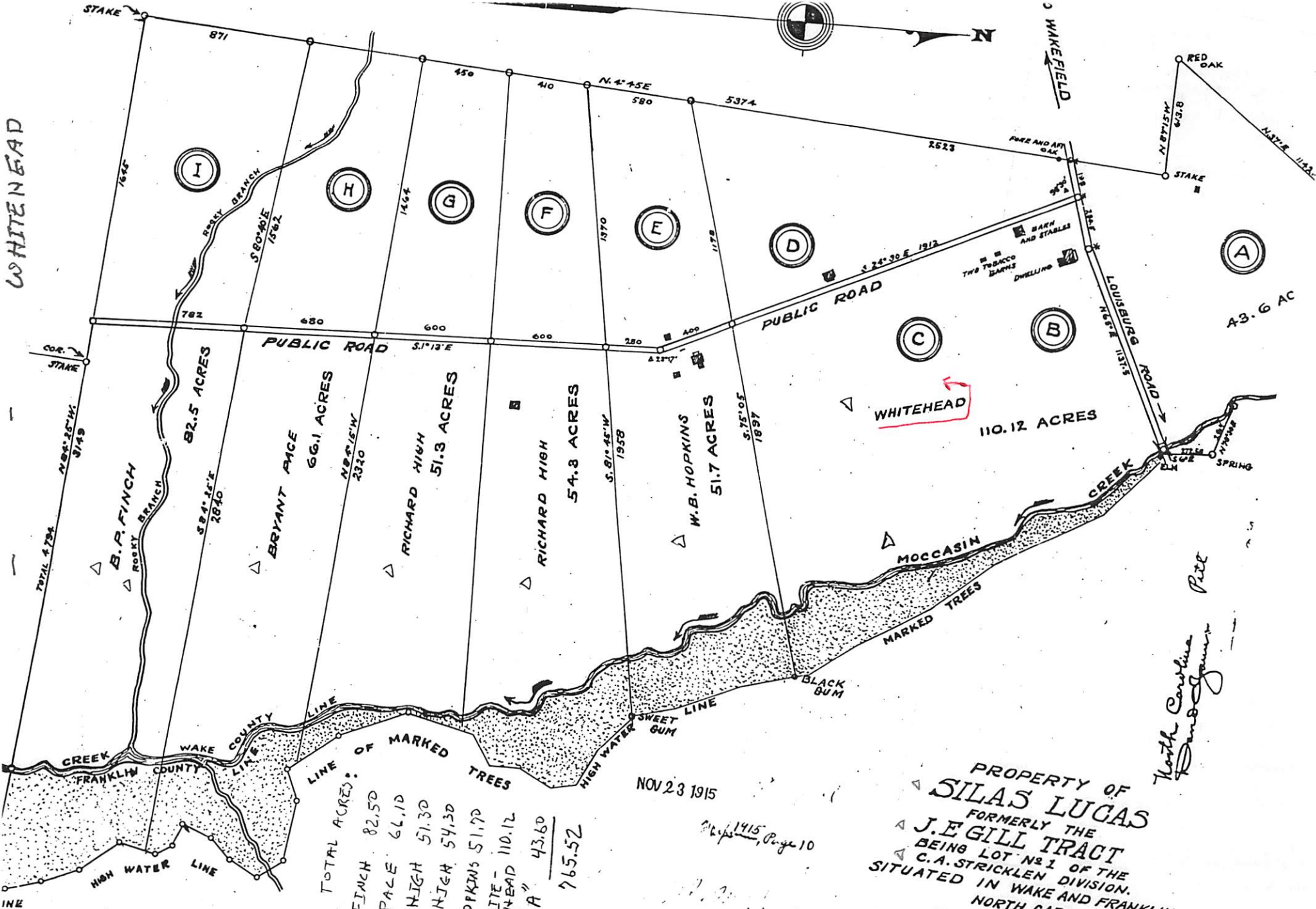

1. GEORGE¹ PEARCE was born in England, and died April 9, 1705 in Isle of Wright Co., VA. He married ANN.

Notes for GEORGE PEARCE:

George, a blacksmith by trade, came from Bristol, England to "Nanzemon Towne" in Lancaster County, Virginia. Here his name appears on a land grant dated June 2, 1664. On August 12, 1675, Robert Lawrence, Jr., deeded to George Pearce, Smith of Nansemone, 300 acres of land by Beaver Dam Swamp in Isle of Wright County, Virginia. In the years following, he acquired several thousand acres of land by patent and deeds of sale.

His will was appraised by Arthur Whitehead, William Johnson, and Henry Pope.

In 1835 and again in 1841 the United States Government published lists of soldiers of the Revolution who were pensioned for services in that war. At the risk of being tedious, I give the Wake County lists in full. Persons desiring a statement of the war record of any veteran herein named can obtain the same free of charge by addressing a request therefore to the Commissioner of Pensions, at Washington City. Except when other wise designated, persons mentioned were privates in the service of North Carolina. Some of the names are spelled differently on the two lists, and these variations I have indicated below. The list published in 1835 was as follows: Berthett ALLEN, James ADAMS, Philip ADAMS, James AMES, John AMOS, Christopher BABB, James BROWN, Jesse BRYANT (Virginia), William BURTON (or William H. BURTON), Jacob BYRUM, Benjamin CARPENTER, James CHRISTIAN 2nd, William CLIFTON, George COLE, Robert DODD, Reuben EVANS, John GREEN, Jesse HARRIS (or HORRIS), James HUGHES (Virginia), Thomas JINKS (Corporal), Francis JONES, Vincent KING, Joshua LYNCH, David MABRY, Jesse MANUEL, John MARR, Shadrach MEDLIN, Naaman MILLS, James NANCE, senior (Virginia), Jesse OSBORN, Drury PITTIFORD (Virginia), William POLK (Major), Elisha POPE (Virginia), Frederick RIGSBY (or RIGSBEE), Thomas ROSS, John RHODES, Aaron ROBERTS, Robert SNEED (Virginia), Joseph SHAW (Pennsylvania), Isaac SMITH, Samuel STANDEFORD (Virginia), Samuel SCARBOROUGH, senior, (Virginia), Jonathan SMITH, senior (Captain), John SHERRON, John SWENNEY, William TATE, Nathan UPCHURCH, William WILDER, Burrell (or Burwell) WHITEHEAD, John WALKER, John WILLIAMS, and Jesse WALL. In addition to the above, the list of 1841 gives the following names, without indicating rank, or State in which they served: James HARWARD, Thomas HOLLAND, Richard PIPEN, William SLEDD, Rufus WILLIE, and William WOOD. Some of these veterans were dead before lists were published. Joel TERRELL, whose name also appears on the pension roll of 1835, appears to have rendered his military service in the United States Army after the Revolution - possibly in the War of 1812.

Zebulon woman killed

A Zebulon woman, Debra Whitehead Burge, was killed Tuesday morning when a trailer, being pulled by a Wake County Housing Authority truck, came disconnected, crossed the center line and struck her vehicle at the intersection of Whitley Way and Wilson Avenue in Wendell, according to investigating authorities.

The accident occurred at approximately 9:10 a.m.

Mrs. Burge was found dead upon the Wendell Rescue Squad's arrival on the scene. Mrs. Burge's child, who was in a safety seat, survived the accident and was released from Wake Medical Center Tuesday.

Although no charges have been filed, the Wendell Police Department is currently investigating the wreck with assistance from the North Carolina Highway Patrol.

7. JOSEPH HINTON MILLS, son of Nathan Mills and Candis Wilson, was born 22 Aug 1841 in Wake Co., NC, and died 20 Mar 1904. He married 3 Nov 1866 Hawkins Harriett (Broadwell) Upchurch (b ca 1836, d ca 1870), daughter of Jarratt Broadwell and Elizabeth Reeves. They were married in Wake Co., NC - bondsman was Joseph's father, Nathan Mills.

Joseph served in the Confederate Army during the Civil War. For more info see ch. GRANDSONS OF NAAMAN MILLS: SOLDIERS IN THE CIVIL WAR. Joseph and his brother, Green Clemmons Mills served in the 47th Regiment NC Infantry, Co. H, known as the "NC Tigers". After the Civil War, these two MILLS brothers married two BROADWELL sisters. Green married Eveline Broadwell 7 Jan 1866, and Joseph married Harriett 3 Nov 1866. Harriett was the widow of Parker Upchurch, who had served with Joseph and Green during the Civil War.

Joseph and Harriett had at least two children: Candis Lizzie Helen, and Jetta Frances Mills. Harriett is buried at Mills Family Cemetery, Apex, NC - gravesite is marked with a fieldstone.

Joseph married 2ndly 29 May 1870 Mary Frances Whitehead (b 12 Jun 1849, d 10 Jun 1914), daughter of John Ruffin Whitehead and Louisa Yates. They were married by JP T.T. Holland, at J.R. Whitehead's residence in Wake Co., NC. Joseph and Mary are buried at Mills Family Cemetery, Apex, NC. Joseph's gravesite is marked with a government military service marker - an upright white marble headstone with the "Southern Cross of Honor" at the top. The author obtained this headstone, which was installed 20 Sep 1993. Mary's gravesite is marked with an upright monument.

Joseph was a farmer. They resided in Wake Co., NC (White Oak Twp.) on FC/1870-1900. Mary and son, Hermus continued to reside there on FC/1910. In 1870, Joseph owned real estate valued at \$350 and a personal estate valued at \$500. The FC/1870-1880 contained the following info on the Agricultural Schedules regarding Joseph's farm:

1870 - 45 acres of improved land. 40 acres of woodland. 120 acres of other unimproved land. Present cash value of farm - \$1,000. Present value of farming implements and machinery - \$20. Total amount of wages paid during the year, including value of board - \$120. 2 horses. 1 mules and asses. 2 milch cows. 2 other cattle. 14 swine. Value of all livestock - \$390. 44 bu. spring wheat. 125 bu. Indian corn. 20 bu. oats. 10 lbs. tobacco. 30 450-lb. bales of cotton. 12 lbs. wool. 10 bu. peas and beans. 3 bu. Irish potatoes. 66 bu. sweet potatoes. 25 lbs. butter. Value of home manufactures - \$25. Value of animals slaughtered or sold for slaughter - \$200. Estimated value of all farm production, including betterments and additions to stock - \$620.

1880 - 80 acres of tilled land. 40 acres of woodland and forest. 94 acres of other unimproved land. Value of farm, including land, fences and buildings - \$3,000. Value of farming implements and machinery - \$25. Value of livestock - \$210. Cost of building and repairing fences in 1879 - \$60. Amount paid for wages for farm labor in 1879, including value of board - \$80. 28 weeks of colored hired labor in 1879 upon farm. Estimated value of all farm productions sold, consumed, or on hand for 1879 - \$837. 1 horses of all ages on hand 1 Jun 1880.

In 1875, Joseph was a trustee of Good Hope Academy. On 25 Jan 1875, he and Mary deeded a tract of land to the Academy for the building site of a school house.

In Joseph's compiled military service record from the Civil War, he is described as being 6 feet, 2 1/2 inches tall, with a fair complexion, light hair, and hazel eyes.

Joseph died intestate (without a will). He lived to age 62. His son, Ernest was the administrator of his estate. The following info is from Joseph's loose estate records at the NC State Archives.

They were married in Wake Co., NC - bondsman was Willie J. Fuller. Elijah was a farmer. They resided in Wake Co., NC (White Oak Twp.) on FC/1850-1880. In 1860, Elijah owned real estate valued at \$1095 and a personal estate valued at \$915. In 1870, he owned real estate valued at \$800 and a personal estate valued at \$1,000. The FC/1880 contained the following info on the Agricultural Schedule regarding Elijah's farm:

1880 - 60 acres of tilled land. 58 acres of woodland and forest. 190 acres of other unimproved land. Value of farm, including land, fences and buildings - \$1200. Value of farming implements and machinery - \$125. Value of livestock - \$300. Cost of building and repairing fences in 1879 - \$25. Amount paid for wages for farm labor in 1879, including value of board - \$225. 52 weeks of white hired labor in 1879 upon farm. Estimated value of all farm productions sold, consumed, or on hand for 1879 - \$500. 2 mules and asses of all ages on hand 1 Jun 1880.

The following events in Elijah's life can be documented by entries in the Wake Co., NC CPQS minutes. For more info see ch. COURT DATES ETCHED IN TIME. In Aug 1853, Jephtha Mills (b ca 1845) became an apprentice to Elijah (Aug 1853-pg. 524). Elijah had served as overseer of the road in Aug 1854 (Aug 1854-pg. 615). In Nov 1854, Elijah was appointed administrator of his father, Matthew Mills' estate (Nov 1854-pg. 6) and (Nov 1856-pg. 315). In Feb 1855, Elijah retailed liquor (Feb 1855-pg. 41). In May 1863, Elijah was appointed administrator of John Crocker's estate (May 1863-pg. 445). In Feb 1867, Elijah was appointed administrator of his uncle, John Mills' estate (Feb 1867-pg. 247). In Nov 1867, Elijah was appointed administrator of William Ivey's estate (Nov 1867-pg. 416). On 16 Dec 1879, Elijah became the guardian of Crawford Vaughan (M. Wimberly and Hinton Jinks were his sureties).

Elijah left a will. Many pages are in his loose estate records at the NC State Archives. He lived to age 59. Elijah's children:

That he knew the said Mills was a pensioner, and drew his pension frequently at Fayetteville."

There was a brother, of Tilitha and my great great grandfather, named Kincheon Patrick. Kincheon was mentioned in the will and some indentures that were made after the estate was processed in 1841. He sounds to me that he may have lost the rights to the home place in Chatham County. I have never found anything else about him after these legal papers in 1841. Don't know if something happened to him or he moved out of North Carolina or what. You mentioned other surnames that were associated with the Upchurchs and Patricks in Wake County. On the Will and these indentures there was a Kimbro Council, Alvis Yates, Moses Upchurch, Leslie Herdon, A. Lassiter Rogers and Thom Whitehead. Kimbro Council, to me, had an interest in the real estate and was the executor of the estate. Do any of these men ring a bell? My great great grandfather left North Carolina and went first into Tennessee and then to Mississippi before going to Arkansas.
