Hi Phil - thank you so much for your response. I appreciate your interest in genealogy......the older I get, the more inquisitive I become. Thank you also for this clarification. Benjamin Upchurch is actually not one of my direct ancestors unless it goes further back somehow through the intermarrying of the Pearce and Upchurch families. This is why: my grandfather was Thomas Pearce, brother of Nathan Pearce. Their father was James Dallas Pearce, the great grandfather of both Jill and me. My great grandfather, Dallas, married Martha Doyle who had Nathan, Thomas and other siblings. Jill's grandfather was Nathan who married Susan Upchurch. Do you know if the Pearce and Upchurch families go back before Benjamin? In that case, my ancestry may include the Upchurch family.

Using maiden names,

My parents were: Eunice Weathers and Bayard Pearce. Eunice's parents were Ruth Christman and Clyde Weathers. Ruth's parents were Robert D. Christman and Pattie Hinnant. Clyde's parents were John Lee Weathers and Timpie Anne Griffin.

Bayard's parents were Thomas Pearce and Nettie Wright. Thomas' parents were James Dallas Pearce and Martha Doyle. Nettie's parents were Elly Tom Wright and Mary Ellen.

That is as far back as I know, but I am trying to gather additional information. This would so far not indicate an Upchurch ancestor for me (although for Jill), but there could be an Upchurch further back.

Honestly, when you start looking at all of the maiden names (that often get "lost" along the way in family history), we are related to a whole lot of people!

Do you have any information about the Pearce family prior to 1770? I have a history of the lineage back to 1066. I have no way to know how accurate it is, of course. Do you know the general area in England they lived? How are YOU related to the Upchurch family?

I'm so glad we connected! I will look forward to hearing from you!
