### WHITNEY UPCHURCH

#### **Commentary:**

<u>Whitney Upchurch</u> was born about 1792 in Dunn Township in Franklin County, North Carolina. He was the son of Moses Upchurch who lived from 1755 – 1853. After moving with his family to Chatham County, NC around 1803, Whitney married Elizabeth Goodwin there in 1811. He and Elizabeth would raise a family and Whitney would later die there in 1863.

Members of Whitney's family would distinguish themselves in many ways. One son, Bennett A. Upchurch, CSA, would give rise to a very prominent family. Another son, Richard Dillard Upchurch, provided some diversity to family fortunes by moving to California by way of Missouri. And so the story goes....
