WILLIAM WALTON STEVENS

William Walton Stevens, son of Mr. and Mrs. John Stevens, was born in Wake County, VC on October 29, 1909. As a boy, Stevens leveloped a love for nature, the outdoors, and great concern over the misuse and waste of our lands and natural resources. Even then he realized that if mankind is to survive, we must ake care of our natural resources. Through education, he was determined to prepare himself for a profession in which he could devote nimself to the conservation of our natural resources. He attended the public schools in Nake County. Upon graduation from high school, he entered N.C. State College (now V.C. State University) in Raleigh where he earned his B.S. and M.S. degrees, specializng in geology, soil science and plant science. He worked his way through college and graduated with honors.

From 1930-1933, he participated as an assistant in carrying out experimental erosion control work and in teaching soils and geololy. In 1933-1934, he served as a technical oreman in an erosion control camp in Stokes County, NC. This was the first erosion control vork conducted by public agencies in the State of North Carolina. In 1934 Stevens became an assistant soils expert in the U.S. Department of Interior Soil Erosion Service. In April 1935, he Soil Erosion Service was transferred to the J.S. Department of Agriculture and became he Soil Conservation Service.

Stevens was truly a pioneer in the effort to conserve our natural resources. He was dediated to this effort even before Dr. Hugh Hamnond Bennett of Wadesboro, NC (founder of he Soil Conservation Service) appeared beore the U.S. Congress in the early thirties (the

"Dust Bowl Days") to plead for legislation to authorize a national erosion program.

Stevens continued to serve in professional positions in the Soil Conservation Service until his retirement in 1969. He served as Regional Soil Scientist for south eastern states 1937 to 1947 except for the time he was in the army and as State Soil Scientist from 1947-1954 and as State Soil Conservationist from 1954-1969. In these positions, he furnished technical leadership and guidance to a large number of soil scientists and soil conservationists throughout North Carolina and nation.

He prepared the first published soil erosion survey report in the United States. He furnished the leadership and procedures for defining and establishing the principles of land capability and land use treatment. He developed the first research needs for conservation in North Carolina. He had the responsibility for developing technical guides used by the Soil Conservation Service for the state of North Carolina. A Universal Soil Loss Prediction Equation was developed and put into use in this state under his supervision.

During World War II, Stevens served as an officer in the U.S. Army. He entered on active duty in 1941 and was released from active duty in 1946 with the rank of full colonel. He remained in the active reserve and is now retired from the military. While in the active reserve, he was responsible for organizing a research and development group for the military in North Carolina. He was the Commanding Officer of this group for several years. He later organized the U.S. Army Reserve School in Raleigh for eastern North Carolina. He was Commandant of this school from its inception.

Following his retirement from the Soil Conservation Service in 1969, Stevens became a watershed coordinator for the State Soil and Water Conservation Committee for the State of North Carolina. In this capacity, his primary duties were to assist soil and water district supervisors, watershed sponsors, and local organizations in the development of watershed plans for total resource development. He later plans for total resource development. He later changed jobs in State government and served as programs and planning coordinator for the North Carolina Department of Natural and Economic Resources, Office of Earth Resources. In this position, his main duties were to work with federal, state and local agencies in developing guidelines for planning total resource development, while giving due consideration to social, economic, physical and political influences.

Stevens is a lifelong Democrat and an active church member. He served as member of the vestry of his church for two three-year terms; as director of the Brotherhood of Saint Andrew of the church; and as president and teacher of the Bible Class.

In 1966. Stevens was elected a fellow in the Soil Conservation Society of America which is the highest award given by the national society. In 1964, he received the Governor's Conservation Award of the Year from the North Carolina Wildlife Federation. He received a meritorious citation from the Soil Conservation Service for 1962 and 1964 for major creative contributions in developing technical programs and for superior service in the performance of duties in the soil and water conservation programs in North Carolina.

Throughout his life. Stevens has been a man of honesty and integrity. He believes in work and in excellence.

"'He was ever searching for more fundamental principles on which to base new concepts, new approaches; new procedures. North Carolina's citizens, those of today and those to come, will forever be indebted to those leaders whose lives have been dedicated to the planning, conservation and development of their state's natural resources, Surely W.W. Stevens has earned a place in the forefront of that very special group"

During his retirement he has continued to be active in civic and church related activities and in professional soil and water conservation organizations. He is married to the former Emily Inscoe of Louisburg, NC and resides at 1629 St. Mary's Street in Raleigh.
