The history of the Wiley family, as far as I know about it, starts in the eastern part of Tennessee (near Dollywood, where Dolly Parton lives.) Robert Wiley (?--1880's) first married Rosemon Click (1839-1863). They had three children:

1. Christopher Columbus (Lum) Wiley (1858-1947), who married Sallie Sofia Allison (1864-1948). They lived at Florence and had several children. I have not yet contacted any of their descendants for all of their information. I do remember visiting them before they died. One of their sons, Bob Wiley, who would now be around a 100 years old, was very active in veterans organizations. One of his sons, who now would be about 70 years old, is named John Robert. I believe that some of the family still lives around the Florence area.

2. Rufus (Roof) Wiley (1862-1931), who married Fannie Curry (?-?). I am not sure just who many children they had, but one son was named Noble and a daughter was named Nellie.

3. Sarah Caroline Wiley (1863-1944), who married W. Greenlief Upchurch (?-?), your ancestors. I would appreciate any information you could provide me about Sarah's family.

After Rosemon Click died in 1863, Robert Wiley married her younger sister, Amanda Jane Click. Amanda Jane reared her sister's three children. She and Robert had 8 children of their own. After Robert died in the 1880's, she and the 11 children moved from Tennessee to Texas on the train. She bought a farm from the Faubions (see Jennie below), which is now about 1 mile north of Leander on the west side of Highway 183. She was a very tough old pioneer woman and smoked a pipe. She not only reared all 11 of these children but also my father after his mother died in childbirth with his sister.

Amanda Jane and Robert's children were as follows:

1. Mary Elizabeth (Lizzy) Wiley (1865-1941), who married John Rufus Upchurch (1863-1919). I believe that he and Greenlief were brothers. They had 4 daughters--

Ruby (1886-1974), whose husband, John Stockton, ran the drug store in Leander. They had no children.

Bertha (1888-1979), who was never married. Her nickname was Billie, and I was named after her.

Zoe (1890-1974), who married Herbert H. (Hub) Powell (1894-1981), who ran a grocery store in Leander. They had one daughter, Mary Catherine, who lived in Austin and died in the late 1960's or early 1970's. She had one daughter, whose name escapes me now.

Ola (1892-1988), who married Mason Chapman (1889-1976). They had a son, John Mason Chapman (1921-1984), who was married twice but had no children, and a daughter, Mary Franklin, who lives in Austin.

When my grandmother died in childbirth with my aunt Blance, Aunt Lizzie took her in and reared her with her four daughters.

2. Issac (Ike) Wiley (1867-1942), who married Cora Catherine Fox (1871-1949). Uncle Ike was a farmer in Leander. They had a son and two daughters--

Floyd Byron Wiley (1902-1980), who married Marguerite Sauer (1917-). Floyd was interested in doing a family tree and did a lot of work on it. His daughter and her daughter have continued the project. We should get you in contact with them also. Floyd and Marguerite had a daughter and two sons. I do not have good dates, etc. on them at this point.

Frieda Earle Wiley (1904-1988), who never married.

Frances (1906--). I knew her when I was a child, but I am not sure about all of her information.

The Mad Genius Of Granville County

Congressman Robert Potter might have had an illustrious political career had his violent temper not gotten in the way.

The terrible-tempered Robert Potter might have had an illustrious career in North Carolina, Texas or national politics were it not for his lack of self-control. Historians have called him the "mad genius of Granville County" — and for good reason.

He was intelligent, attractive in stature and appearance and quick to make acquaintances. But time determined whether they became friends or foes. There would be no in-between. Potter would be either loved or loathed.

On the one hand, in North Carolina he was a good lawyer, an impressive member of the House of Commons (now called the General Assembly) and of the national Congress. In Texas he was a staunch and energetic leader in its quest for independence from Mexico, one of the signers of its Declaration of Independence and its first Secretary of the Navy.

On the other hand, in his home state he frequently displayed perverseness and vindictiveness, savagely attacked and maimed two persons, served a prison term and was expelled from the House of Commons. In Texas he was finally assassinated by some other tough hombres.

At about age 15, Potter joined and served in the U.S. Navy six years, resigning in 1821 and moving to Halifax County to study law under the outstanding lawyer and political leader Thomas Burgess. After only a few months of intensive study, he passed examination and began practice.

Though supported by the Burgess faction, Potter was twice defeated by Jesse Bynum in 1823 and 1824 for the Legislature. Potter charged fraud, feelings became bitter and Potter challenged

Bynum to a duel. "This is to invite you to the field of combat," Potter wrote. "I cannot say field of honor. Your presence would deprive any spot of that character."

When Bynum refused to duel, Potter challenged some of his friends. They, too, declined. The town became so divided that the 1825 election was not held

because of fears it might incite a riot.

But Potter won in 1826. Though only in his mid-20s, his abilities as a sound-minded thinker and an eloquent speaker impressed his colleagues in the House. But not enough voters at home. His enemies worked even harder and defeated him again in 1827.

Potter became so resentful and irreconcilable that he returned to Granville County. There he composed an 11-page poem about the Halifax community and aired his malice and wrath against almost all of its leading families.

Granville residents, however, recognized his abilities and elected him to the Legislature; then in 1828 he successfully ran for U.S. Congress and served two terms with good marks. A strong supporter of President Andrew Jackson, he evidenced his natural talent as a sharp and alert leader and a convincing speaker and debater.



Robert Potter's abilities as a good lawyer, sound thinker and eloquent spokesman helped get him elected to the North Carolina House of Commons and the U.S. House, but his quick temper kept him from having any kind of lasting and meaningful political career.

But in 1831 Potter's lack of self-restraint unquestionably surfaced. He committed an outrageous crime that changed the course of his life.

The most-repeated version of his lawlessness is that he believed his wife back in North Carolina was having an affair with two men, one the Rev. Louis Taylor, about 50, her second cousin. The other was Louis Wiley, 17, related to her by marriage.

Unaware of Potter's hatred, the Rev. Taylor, on a Sunday afternoon, August 28, 1831, stopped by the Potter residence. At home from Washington at the time, Potter mercilessly attacked the minister, beat him into unconsciousness and, with a knife, sterilized him. Next, he sought and found Wiley and vented the same savage anger upon him.

The crime added a new word to Tar Heel colloquialism — "Potterizing."

For this brutal crime, Potter was sentenced to two years in prison and fined \$1,000. Because it was considered unsafe to keep him in Oxford, he was placed in the Hillsborough jail. There, he wrote an 80-page booklet defending himself and his actions. It was widely circulated.

After serving an additional year because of inability to pay the fine, he ran again for the state legislature in 1834, was elected and finally allowed to take his seat after a heated debate on the floor of the House.

It was at this session of the assembly, too, that the crime Potter committed was made a felony instead of a misdemeanor, and carried the death sentence.

Potter still hadn't learned to master his emotions. On Christmas night of 1834, he lost a lot of money in a poker game with other House members, got in a fight, drew his gun, took all the money in the game and left. For that, the House expelled him on January 2, 1835.

Politically, as well as socially, he had become unacceptable. And for a change, he took a realistic look at himself and his future in North Carolina and decided, while yet a young man, to get a new start

in life far away, where he was unknown — in Nacogdoches, Texas.

In Nacogdoches, within 15 months of leaving home, he was so well regarded and respected and such a moving booster, and leader for Texas' freedom from Mexico,

that he was elected to the convention to consider sovereignty. He became one of the signers of the Texas Declaration of Independence on March 2, 1836. Two weeks later, he was named secretary of Navy of the Republic of Texas. That rewarding appointment came within 15 years after he had resigned from the U.S. Navy and begun public life.

Potter then remarried and built a home at what later was called Potter's Point on Lake Cado in Marion County, and subsequently was elected to the senate of the Fifth Congress of Texas in 1840.

In this interim, however, his temper and bent for violence did not cool. He engaged in numerous verbal and physical clashes with politicians and neighbors, one of whom was William Pinkney Rose, who lived eight miles away.

Rose was accused of murder, and a reward was offered. So Potter rounded up a group of men to capture him, but somebody squealed. Rose and friends decided to get Potter first. They surrounded his home and called him to come out, but he showed extreme confidence in himself against heavy odds. He dashed from the house, jumped a fence and headed for the woods. Six shots were fired but missed. So he jumped into the lake and remained under water as long as he could. When he surfaced to breathe, one of Rose's friends put a bullet through his head.

In 1876, the County of Potter was created to honor the "distinguished Texan in the days of the Republic," and on October 9, 1928, his body was moved from the home cemetery to the State Cemetery at Austin, a burial place set aside for heroes and distinguished Texans. An appropriate memorial was erected.

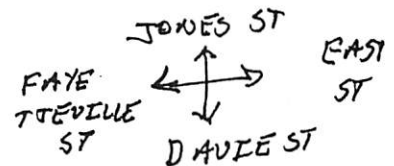

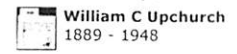
