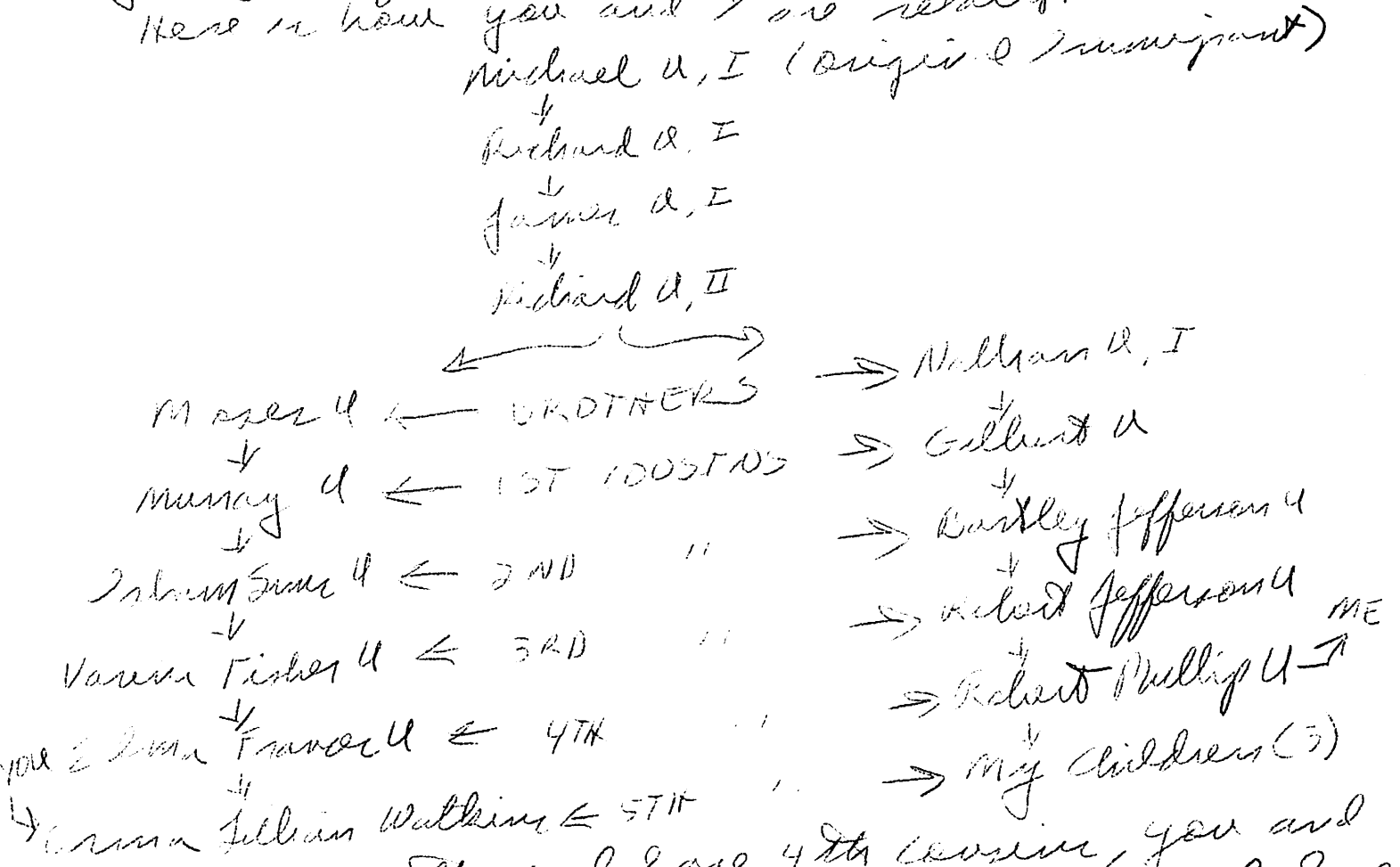

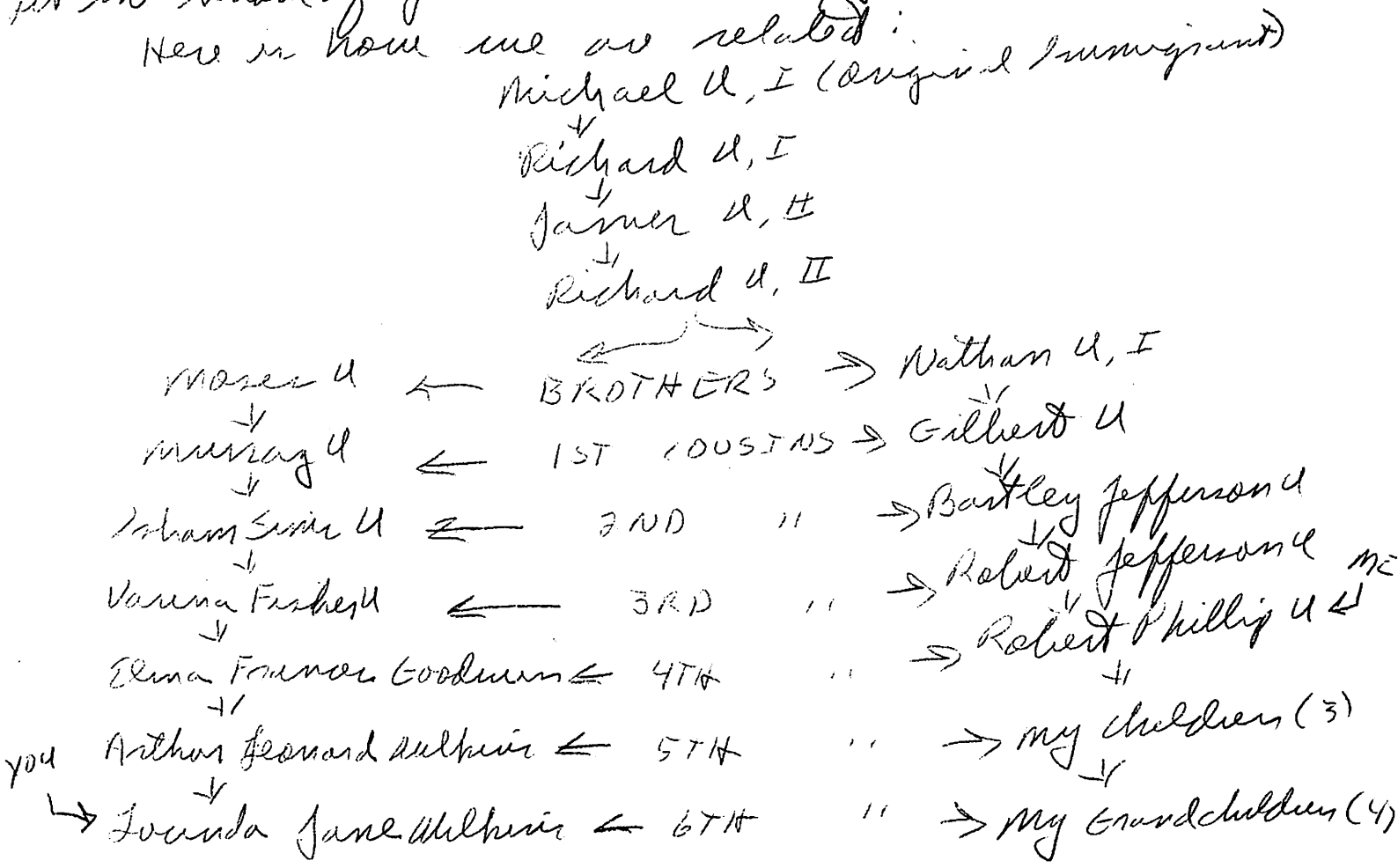

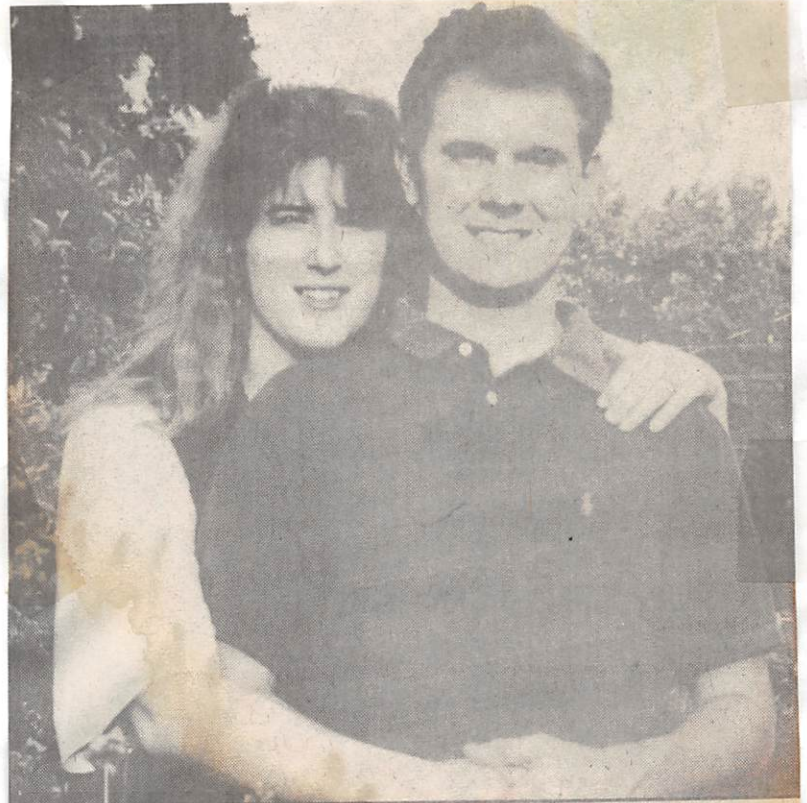

William Henry Wilkins was born on July 23, 1880 in Wake County near Yates Mill. His father John (Jack) Wesley Wilkins farmed and operated the mill at Yates Pond grinding corn for local farmers. Jack came to Wake County from Chatham County. He married Mary Ellen

Murray. Jack Wilkins served in the Civil War with the C.S.A. and was wounded by a minnie ball. They raised a large family: William Henry, Robert, Walter, Wesley, Waylon (Walter, Wesley, and Waylon died the same week of pneumonia), Roxie (who married Joe Nipper), Nora (who married Earl Morgan, Bessie (who married Bill Holmes), and Ida (who married Ed Murray). All except Bessie are buried in Wake County. Jack Wilkins and Mary Ellen are buried in Inwood Baptist Church cemetery.

William Henry "Will" Wilkins graduated from Kings Business School. He joined the N.C. National Guard in 1903 for three years. He was a private in Company B 3rd Infantry. He worked various jobs until he bought a farm on a little place called Bunker Hill south of Raleigh. When WWI came he enlisted but did not have to go over seas because he already had a child.

Will married Blanche Pearle Harris on December 7, 1904. Their children: (1) Gladys, born 1912 who married Ira T. Morris. Their children — Judy, Peggy, Barbaree and Susan. (2) Kenneth Paul, born 1917 who was the first son of Wake County to be killed in the service in World War II. He served on a mine sweeper in the Navy and was Fireman First Class. When he was killed on December 12, 1941, on the island of Cavati in the Philippines. He is buried in the American Cemetery in Manila. (3) Harry, born July 3, 1919, married Hazel Page. They have four children: Bill, Howard, Brenda, and Dorothy. (4) Helen, who is Harry's twin sister, married Kenneth Lisenbe. They have four children: George, Mitchell and Michael (twins), and Pamela. (5) Blanche, born in 1922, married Daniel Jones. They had one daughter, Nancy. At his death she married Gibson Yeargin. They have one daughter, Karen Anne. She married Kenneth Wayne Lee and their children are Christopher Wayne and Carrie Anne.

William Henry "Will" Wilkins worked his small farm for several years, then bought a place in Rhamkatt. His farm prospered, till the Depression. The bank took the farm and he moved his family to a rental farm on the Falls of the Neuse Road. He farmed there until around the last of WW2; he then bought a small farm on Edwards Mill Road where he raised chickens until he retired.

Pearl Wilkins died December 21, 1959, and was buried in Restlawn Memorial Garden. Will lived until July 1, 1963. He was buried beside his wife. His children still live in Wake County.
