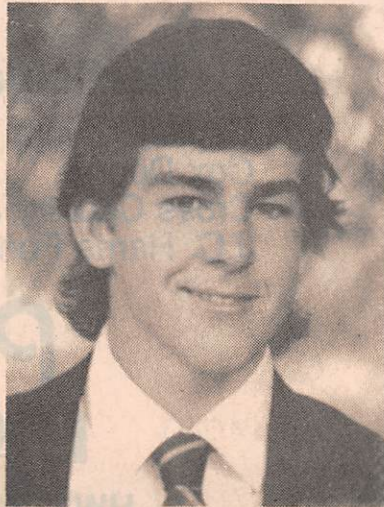

**UPCHURCH, Myrtle v. W. W. UPCHURCH**

The marriage was dissolved the February Term of Superior Court, 1909. [Names in the file are given as Myrtle I. UPCHURCH and William W. UPCHURCH] The PI married the Def 19 June 1901 [no location given]. The PI was a resident of North Carolina more than 5 years before filing the action. The PI alleges the Def abandoned the PI 15 July 1906 and has not given support since. The Def had a relationship with Bessie SMITH and "eloped" at the time of abandonment. The PI further alleges that the Def committed fornication and adultery with diverse women during 1905-1906 in Raleigh and elsewhere. The PI demands judgment divorce from bed and board and custody of the issue of the marriage, the son Hubert Hubbard UPCHURCH, born 5 March 1902, who is now living with the mother. The PI further asks for costs. Summons dated 16 February 1909 calls John D. FORREST and Geo. H. WILLIAMS. Summons dated 28 September 1908 calls W. W. UPCHURCH, not found in Island of Cuba. PI receives custody and costs.
