A. Courtney Upchurch

1. Moses Upchurch born 1822

Moses Upchurch I – He was born 1822 in Chatham, North Carolina, USA.

Residence 1850 in Athens, Dallas, Alabama. He died 1880 in Oktibbeha, Mississippi, USA.

Emily Wilson. She was born 1832 in North Carolina, USA. Residence 1880 in Oktibbeha, Mississippi, United States. She died Aft. 1880 in Oktibbeha, Mississippi, USA.

Moses Upchurch and Emily Wilson. Their marriage on Nov 28, 1850 in Perry, Alabama, USA (from Early American Marriages: Alabama 1800 – 1920/ Selected Counties). They had 10 children.

(1) Emily Wilson born about 1834 in North Carolina or Alabama, married 28 Nov 1850 (Perry Co, AL) Moses Upchurch born circa 1822 (Chatham Co, NC) son of Courtney Upchurch and grandson of Moses Upchurch, Head of Clan. The couple settled in either Dallas or Perry County, Alabama. By August 1856 Moses Upchurch had moved his family to Mississippi. The first record was in Oktibbeha County on 2 Sep 1859 re a land purchase. Moses Upchurch served in the Civil War. On 20 Aug 1870 Moses and family are still in Oktibbeha Co, MS but their 1 year old child, Walter Lane Upchurch, was found in the household of Jacob Junary. Person is known. Perhaps Emily was ill or someone else was having to nurse the child. The last records for Moses and Emily was the 1880 Oktibbeha Co, MS Census. No tombstone, obituary, or probate records have been found for either Moses or Emily in Oktibbeha Co, MS. Family history has it that they are buried in unmarked graves in the Old Colclough Cemetery about 10 miles south of Starkville, MS on property now owned by the MS State University and the US Department of Wildlife.
