We enjoyed our four years of ministry at Elkwood in Asheville. *But* we have really enjoyed being back at our home and having more free time for travel, etc. We went to Cary, N.C. in July for my high school's Centennial Celebration. Jack kept telling people that I was going back for my 100th Reunion. Actually I will be going back to Cary next year for my class' 50th Reunion. I am really looking forward to that as I so enjoyed seeing about a dozen of my classmates and other friends at the Centennial Celebration. In September, we traveled to the Poconos in Pennsylvania to visit Jacklyn and children AND TO TAKE Carol's car which Jacklyn had bought when Carol and Lawrence moved to England. not announced retirement to the University
as a lame duck administrator loses
his clout. So activities here at the University
are still going at full speed and there

and there is much to do here in the next 3-4 months. After we move to MO I have dozens of plans for action of one sort or another - such as trips to AC and other places. The activity plan for Fine Acres Farm has to be moved into a higher gear. We are now at 1200 acres and need one or two more purchases to get up to 1500 acres. At that time I will seriously consider buying my own farm equipment and hiring a farm manager. In the meantime I may become a real estate agent in order to learn more about that business to help me in real estate deals of my own.

In your longer range plans think about the prospects of writing in in Missouri. There is a lot to see there also and I am sure you would enjoy the visit.

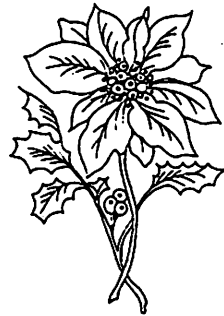

Your letter of 7 FEB 1992 is most welcome. The poem about Aunt Pat is very interesting. It is possible I may do something with it in the U. B. Time will tell.

You must be getting more and more excited as the time for you to depart for England approaches. The preparation you are undertaking will come in handy. Do keep notes and write up a summary/recollection when you return. Then you can make a copy for everyone. I would certainly like to have a copy.

As regards the Uphurch Rock I can only provide anecdotal information. Several years ago when Eleanor Martin Bradley gave me the pictures of Bartley & Aurora Uphurch she also gave me the crude pliers which she said were used to pull teeth in the old days and the rock. She reported that the rock was used as a counter weight on a pair of scales to allow measures of food to be weighed.

The rock would weigh about one pound, is somewhat rounded and originally had some rough edges. However, it has been worn more-or-less smooth by what one presumes to have been much handling. The implication for both the pliers and the rock is that they were used in connection with slaves - to pull teeth and parcel out food supplies - and of course this could be true. Bartley Jefferson U never owned any slaves according to the best information I have. He was too young and also too poor. His father Gilbert U was just plain poor and also never owned slaves as far as I can tell. However, Nathan U, I, the grandfather of Bartley Jefferson U did own slaves and parcelled them out in his will when he died in 1835. Undoubtedly these slaves, or at least some of them, remained with some of the children of Nathan U, I up until the time they were freed in the 1860's. There is still evidence of a negro settlement near Green Level where Nathan U, I lived and this settlement no doubt contained

slaves freed from the Uphunder family. Also, these
 are still black Uphunder in the Apex, NC
 area and almost certainly they trace back
 to the slaves owned by Nathans U, I or
 his brother Moses U or the children of those
 two brothers. Someday, I may get this better
 organized. In the meantime we have the
 "Uphunder Rock"

I would love to have the original
 or a good copy of the Bradley U photo to
 which you refer and would publish
 it in the U B. If this is the picture
 which also has my father in it (and I
 think it is) then I have a copy but it is
 not a very good one. If I can't do
 any better I will publish the one I have.

If we don't touch base until you
 returns - have a great trip.

Dear Cousin Evelyn,

Your letter of 6 SEP 91 arrived on 10 OCT 91 and I have worked on it several times to get everything on to the Master outline. I really appreciate what you and your mother have done. I'll be glad to send the updated outline. On the enclosed two sheets I have summarized all the still missing bits of information on your Grandmother Family. We are now down to those last few bits some of which may never be gained. At any rate I list them for you just in case you or someone else happens to have just the right opportunity.

Might I suggest that you consider getting something down on paper from your mother and sister Penny about what the old days were like. I have several documents like this and they add greatly to our fund of knowledge about our family and background. I would love to have such a document to read and for the permanent Yllwuch files.

How wonderful that you will go to England in 1992. I have always enjoyed my visits there. Right now I have a professional from Kew Garden spending 6 weeks with my research program. I am enclosing an enlarged map of the Little Gidding area with four key numbers entered as follows:

- ① Little Gidding itself
- ② LEIGHTON BROMSWOLD
- ③ UPTON.
- ④ GLATTON

Also enclosed is a picture of Little Gidding itself (note that there are only a few buildings). The church is shown at the bottom of the lower picture and the upper photo shows a front view of the church. The large building just to the center of the picture is where you will be served tea if you are there at the proper time. You will need 2-4 hours to visit, see the church, have tea, etc. Service in the church is on an irregular basis. If there is one while you are there be sure to go. Our ancestor Michael 4, 5 and his father worshipped in this very same church in the era 1600-1650. The other buildings are of more recent vintage.

Number ② on the map located Leighton-Bromswood. This includes another old church but more important a restored Gatehouse dating from the 1650 era. This is where the minister for several local churches lives with his wife Sarah. He is Robert Van de Weyer. They accommodate visitors for a donation. You can get room & meals. Things are a little crude but OK. More important the ambulance and the Vander Meyers are great. Stay there if you can. They may have some more modern rooms or outbuildings by now. Robert is the minister for Little Gidding.

Number ③ located Upton where there is a modern motel (not too expensive) with an adjoining modern restaurant for the traveler. This is a good place to overnight if Leighton-Bromswood does not work out.

Number ④ located Glatten where there is a first class pub that serves good food, so there if you get the chance.

I suggest that your priority be in going to the Little Gidding Area as opposed to the town of UPCHURCH in Kent. We really don't know the relations of the Upchurch family to the town of Upchurch. There might

have been such a connection in the 1300-1600 era but no facts have come down to us. The church there dates from about 1100 and is interesting. We do know that our ancestors were at Little Gidding.

If you have a chance to go more I would suggest a trip to the east of Little Gidding to see the cathedral at Ely. This takes you into an area where Uplunds lived in the 1500's. There was an Uplund minister at Ely. Also Cambridge University is in this area and an Uplund was enrolled there as early as 1599. The letters that Michael U, I wrote to his father at Little Gidding are preserved at Cambridge but they will not let you see them - they are in Pepys' Library - which you can see.

There is a religious commune of sorts at Little Gidding. For more address, details, etc. - I suggest you write to:

I recognize some of the details may not be available for one reason or the other. In any case, the outline for Francis Lane Perry is in excellent shape thanks to your input. I'll be glad to send you a copy on our next exchange of letters.

Your letter brought back many memories. I am afraid my upbringing was somewhat "ventured" if I may use that term broadly. In any case it was abbreviated as I had only three short years in high school before leaving home.

at age 16 to enter N.C. State, looking back on
those formative years I am amazed that
such an unstructured upbringing permitted
a reasonable entry into the world of adults.
In any case I had a family in which there
was a great deal of affection and mutual
support within some rather narrowly
defined economic limits (we were poor
but I didn't know it!), I too benefited
from the aura of the Bartley Jefferson
Upchurch name and family.

You could say that my interest in family
history stems from Uncle Betty's. He and I
were companions on many a passover
hunt. In 1955 he purchased a tombstone
for his GF Gilbert U and he, Aunt Maudie,
Sallanice & I took a ride up to Western
Wake Co (Green Level) to see if we could locate
the burial place. We could not and the
stone rests today at Inwood Cemetery. In
the process of that excursion I made notes
from his recollections of the family history
and I still have them. They lay dormant
for 20 years before I actually returned to
the subject of family history, how I wish
I had listened more carefully & started earlier.

I too recall the Sundays on the porch at the Bartley Jefferson home and the furnishings. We should start an inventory. My sister Pat has the old desk, sister Perry has the parlor furniture (I think that came from Uncle William's home), I have the large pictures of Bartley & Aurora. I can't remember the picture of Aurora you describe. We should get copies of these pictures. I plan to do this for the ones I have but at present that is on my mental list of things to do without a "to do date".

one of my goals is to establish an Upland Foundation to carry on the history project for the family and to create one or more physical locations where family heirlooms can be gathered, preserved, and displayed. With any luck I will leave an endowment for this project. Much of this will probably have to wait until I return about four years from now. At present life is rather full with many projects in full swing at work at home and on the farm with the adventures planning strongly about 70 hours per week. someday

I guess I'd have to slow down but my
 mean is I don't want to slow down - just
 shift to these things that are most
 enjoyable such as family history. On
 that mental list is an item to spend
 a fair amount of time traveling around
 the US seeing cousins of all sorts. My
 work in Upshur's family history has
 revealed many interesting people and
 circumstances. Soon or later we'll
 make it to see-off Road. In the
 meantime, we would love to see you
 and Jack here in Tucson. It would

Thank you for your nice letter of 27 NOV 90 and for the order for U.B. 1980, 1981 and 1991. The 80 & 81 issues have been sent. The issues for 1991 will be sent in MAR, JUN, SEP and DEC which is our normal pattern. I have used the data you sent to update my Master outline. The remaining questions for your mother's family are listed on three enclosed sheets. I will be grateful for any of these details you have or can get.

Your conclusions about our line are correct. This is also given in my letter of 8 NOV 1990 to you. We are still working on locating the exact tracts of land owned by Richard U, II when he came to NC about 1750. In due course we should have it. 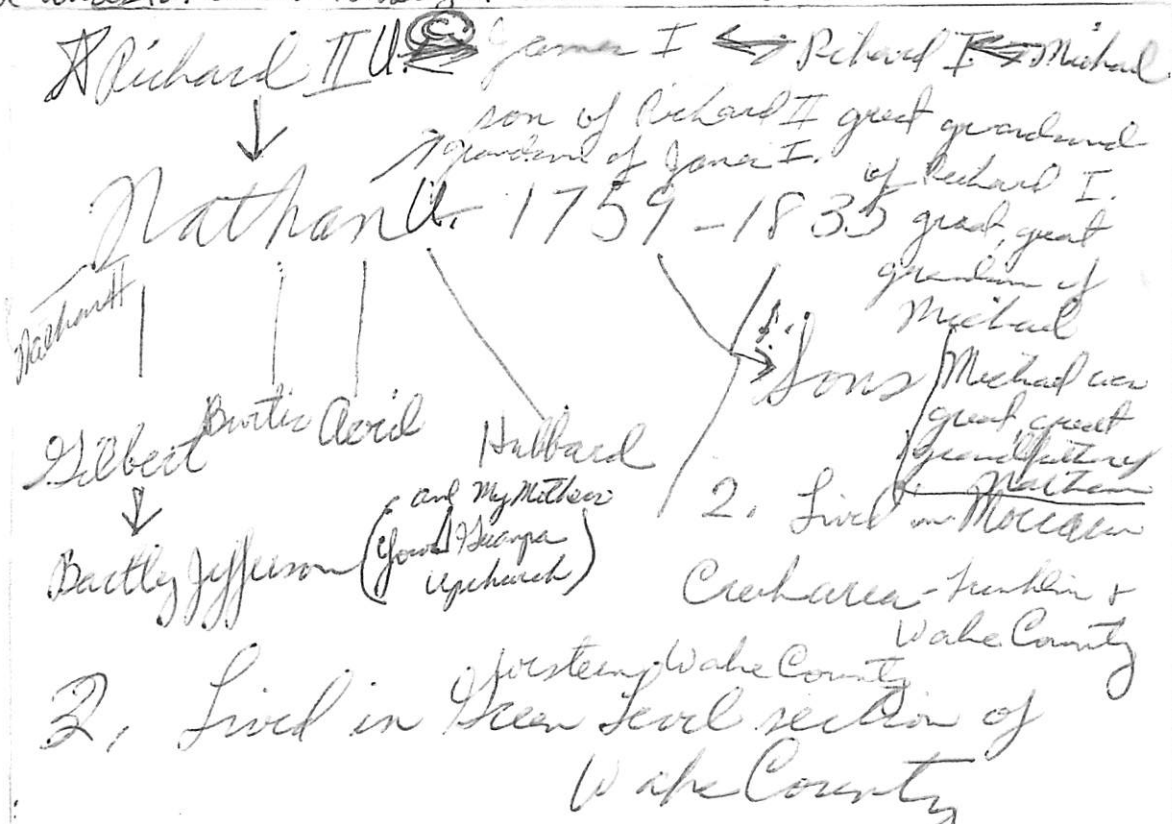

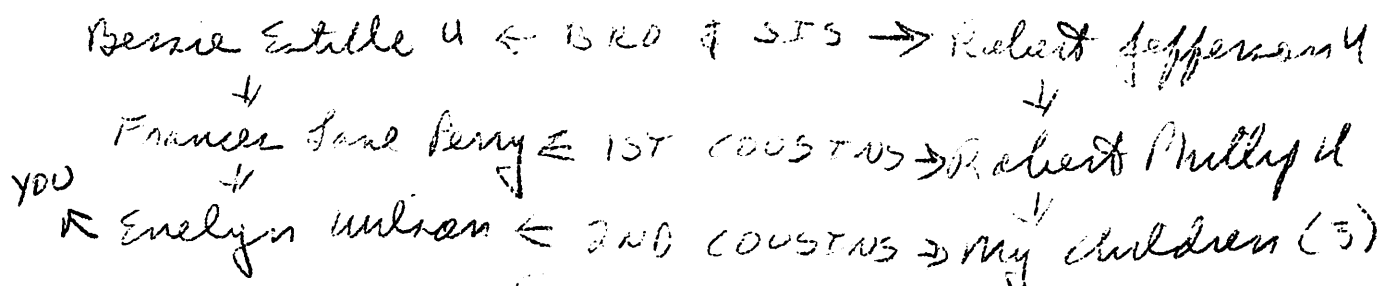
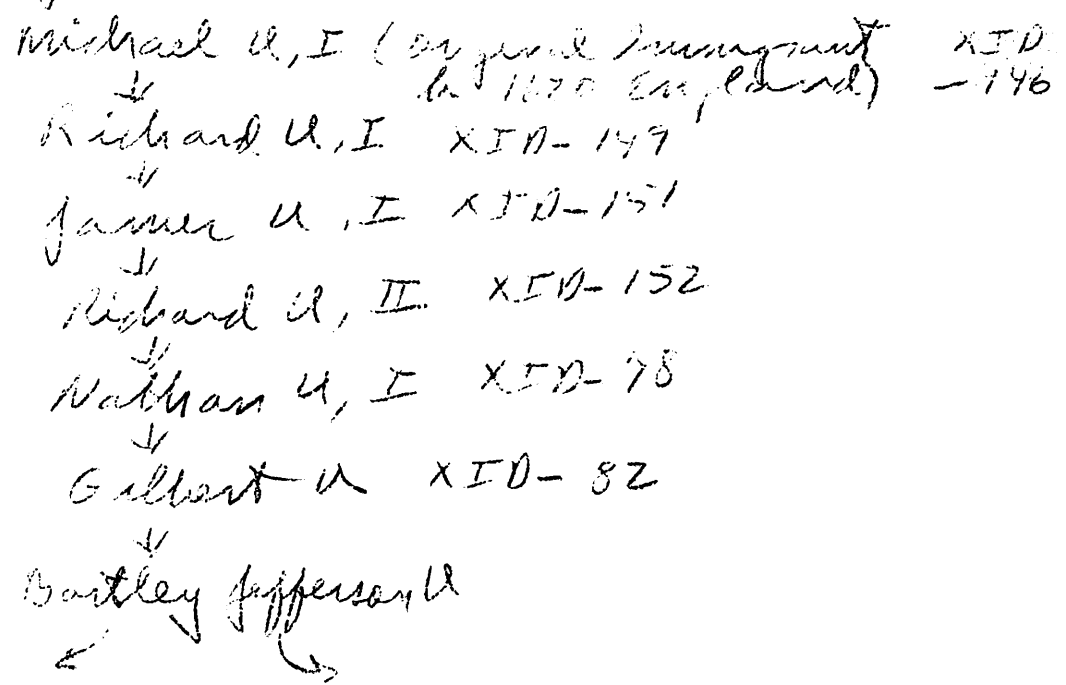
