8. Ottaway T.⁷ NEWBOLD (William⁶, William⁵, Levi/Levy⁴, John³, Thomas², Thomas¹) was born Oct 1856 in Johnson County Illinois^{8,9}, and died 1914 in Wolf Lake Illinois¹⁰. He married (1) Sarah S. Breeden 17 Sep 1874 in Union County Illinois¹¹. He married (2) **Amanda Katherine Wise** 12 Dec 1884 in Johnson County Illinois¹². She was born Jan 1862 in Illinois^{13,14}, and died 1953 in Johnson County Illinois.

Notes for Ottaway T. NEWBOLD:

There is a Census record in Union County IL in 1880 for an "Elisha NEWBOLES", age 36, born in Illinois, who lists his father as born in NC and mother in IL. Listed with him is his wife Emma, age 27, and a son Oliver, age 2. Also listed with him is "Ottawa" NEWBOLES, age given as 24, and listed as his brother. This fits very well to be Ottaway NEWBOLD, who is listed born in 1856 on the 1900 Census for Johnson County Illinois. Union county Illinois is the county just west of Johnson County, where William NEWBOLD and his family resided. Elisha NEWBOLES is likely then an older brother of Ottaway, and thus an elder son to William NEWBOLD.

On the 1900 Census, Ottaway is living just two households away from his Uncle, James Oliver NEWBOLD. Another brother to James Oliver NEWBOLD and Ottaway's father William was Ottaway NEWBOLD, for whom this Ottaway was obviously named. His Uncle Ottaway died in 1853.

According to the 1900 Census, Ottaway is a farmer who owns his land.

On the 1910 Census in Burnside Township in Johnson County Illinois, "Otto T. NEWBOLES" is living with his wife "Manda" and 8 of their 10 children. All of their children are indicated alive by the Census. Ottaway is listed as a farmer living in a "frame house". [The two children not living with them are oldest son "Gus", and daughter "Lisha".]

Notes for Amanda Katherine Wise:

On the 1920 Federal Census in Williamson County Illinois, "Manda" NEWBOLD, widow, is found living with 5 of her children: 22 year old twins "Dewey" and "Hugh", Charles, age 19; Earl, age 16; and daughter Velva, age 13. The sons all appear to be listed for occupation as "coal miners".

On the 1930 Federal Census in Williamson County, Amanda NEWBOLD once again is listed, this time with her son Earl, her daughter Velva, and her son Guy, although Guy is also listed in his own household in Johnson County Illinois with his wife Myrtle. There is also listed a female "Lillian" NEWBOLD, listed as a daughter in law, and who is age 22. As her son Earl is listed as "married", it could be posited that this is his wife.

It should be noted that her parents are listed as born in North Carolina and Tennessee, respectively.

Notes for Dewey Adam NEWBOLD:

On his 1918 WW I draft registration card, Dewey Adam NEWBOLD is shown to be working for the CW&F Coal Company. A description of him said he was of medium build and height, with brown eyes and dark hair.

Brad Crawford, a researcher of Ottaway NEWBOLD and descendants, made an interesting comment:

"As a sideline point of interest, some of Ottaway's sons were very active in the Ku Klux Klan. And one of them (either Hewey or Dewey) was killed in a gunfight in Williamson, Illinois. The story is written about in a book called "In Bloody Williamson - KKK & bootlegging, 1920s" by Geo. Galligan."

There is a 1918 WW I draft registration card for one Hewey McKinley NEWBOLD filled out in September 1918. His birthdate is May 19, 1898. He is a twin to Dewey Adam NEWBOLD. Like his twin, he is a miner for the CW&F Coal Company. The card went on to describe him as of "medium" height and build, with blue eyes and dark hair.

On the 1930 Federal Census a 23 year old Velva Evan is listed as the wife of one William Evans, a coal miner who lives in Williamson County Illinois. The age of this Velva is correct to be Velva NEWBOLD, as is her location in Williamson County, where NEWBOLDS lived about on the border between Williamson and Johnson County Illinois. It is possible that this entry is for this person due to the associated circumstances.

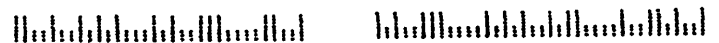

The Challenge of Genealogy

by MARIE WISE

"Genealogical research has been described as a cross between a good detective novel and a jigsaw puzzle" - so begins the introduction to two excellent companion books that prepare a genealogist for British ancestor hunting.

Beginning Your Family in Great Britain by George Pelling succeeds in its purpose of providing the beginner with basic information needed for carrying research back to the 16th century.

Begin with yourself, he says, and everything your relatives know; start immediately to fill in a Pedigree Chart. Be sure to collect or copy everything you can of: family bibles, letters, diaries, memorial cards, birth, marriage and death certificates, professional certificates, birthday books, newspaper clippings, obituary notices, samplers, medals, photographs, etc.

Consult the excellent guides and indexes available to check whether your family pedigree is already in print; continue reading his book to learn where you (or someone) might learn more about your ancestors; and then, publish in some form what you find, lest it be lost to your descendants.

UPCHURCH FAMILY

The UPCHURCH family name can be found in English records from c1100; by the 1500's there were many of this name in East Anglia about 100 miles NE of London.

Michael Upchurch I migrated to Virginia in 1649 and from him descend most of the Upchurches in America who are now spread across the nation, particularly the southeastern states including Louisiana.

In 1980 the *Upchurch Bulletin* began publication with Robert Phillip Upchurch, a 9th generation desc. of Michael I, as editor. The American Upchurch family has been divided into 23 clans, each headed by a 5th generation glossary of terms that the British genealogical researcher needs to know.

Originally published by the Federation of Family History Societies in 1985 and now in its 3rd edition, this guide includes definitions, explanations, bibliographies, sources, addresses, etc. on the many particular topics and unfamiliar British words (or application thereof) that can confuse even experienced American researchers.

Examples: Apprenticeship Records, Assession Rolls, Banns,

British Records Assn., Ecclesiastical Census, Chancery Proceedscd. of Michael I. These Clan Heads lived at about the time of the Revolution, in which some of them fought.

This *Bulletin*, four annual issues of 8½ x 11 in., 40 pages each, gives info on the 23 Upchurch clans, reporting in each issue on 300 additional family members newly identified and coded, plus wills, deeds, censuses, missing links, etc.

We believe that James joined his sons in New Zealand about 1886, according to his death cert he had been in NZ for 26yrs when he died in 1912. I couldn't find him in the shipping list at the National Archives as his fare must have been paid privately, which is supported by family oral history on Joseph's side. I am not sure what year James was born, he was baptised with his sister Lucy, 21 Sept 1828 at Huntingdon. Working from the ages given in the census James' est., DOB. is 1825 (1851 census). From his death cert. est., DOB is 1823 (which I think is too early) there is a five year gap between the baptisms of Thomas in 1823 and James in 1828. I wonder if the parents waited hoping to baptise James at St Neots as they did with his younger sister Betsy in 1830. (I have included a family chart of Betsy Upchurch and her husband William Yeardye researched by S. Wise)
