Thamar B. Bramlet grew up on the family farm in IL. In 1850 he owned 47 acres in the Bramlet settlement. In 1854 he acquired 40 acres in section 35 of Raleigh Township which he sold to Wiley G. Pennell in 1882.

In 1876 Thamar moved his family to Texas Co, MO and in 1888 he homesteaded 159 acres there. He built a log cabin on the tract.

This parcel was later sold to Joseph Bowen who later sold it to the Wofford family. Mr Herschel Wofford sold it in 1912. It is still known as the old Bramlet Place.

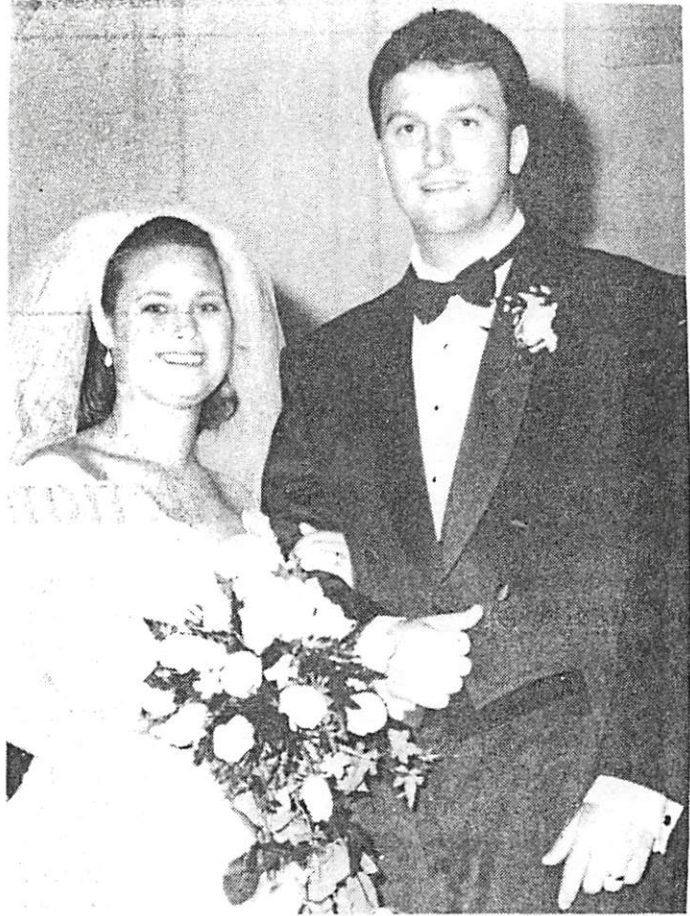
