Dear Eddie,

Thanks for your fine letter of 27 APR 1985. I have made a separate biofile sheet for every person in it as I did with your earlier items on the Strickland Scene. So far I have not yet connected the Upchurches and the Stricklands but I am convinced as you are that they did intermarry. They lived side by side and had so many interactions according to the records beginning about 1760 that it is impossible to think that they did not intermarry. I still have quite a few children & grand children of Richard U II (who came to the area ca 1755) to link to someone and the Stricklands remain a strong lead. Over the next couple of years I will give more and more attention to the area. Let's stay in touch and try to help each other.

My wife's brother is sending me more details on Sally Strickland, their grandmother who lived also in the area.

you asked about the location of the land which Sampson Strickland bought in Johnston Co, NC on Pamella's Creek on 9 JAN 1761. In order to

help in our correspondence on this and other matters I am sending you a copy of Issue 1 of Vol 2 of the Upchurch Bulletin. Note especially pages 7, 9, 10 and 11. I had originally thought that the 1787 adjustment in the Wake/Franklin boundaries involved shifting the line from the east prong of Moccasin creek to the west prong. Later I learned that the shift involved moving the boundary from a straight line boundary (shown in red on pg 11) eastward to the western prong of Moccasin creek and continuing down Moccasin creek after the two prongs join (new line & present day line shown on page 11 by o-o-o-o-o).

~~western~~ In the beginning Johnston Co (formed sometime between 1740 & 1760) occupied that part of the map below the red line. When Wake Co, NC was formed on 12 MAR 1771 that part below the red line became Wake Co. Then in 1787 the shift was made. My guess is that the purchase by Sampson Stockland on 9 JAN 1761 was in the area being "traded about". If so it would have been in Johnston Co between 12 MAR 1771 and 9 JAN 1761, then in Wake Co between 12 MAR 1771 and 1787 and since 1787 in Franklin Co, NC. However, in those days it took quite a while for

records to be posted³

The map you sent me shows the Nelson
Barr-Strangle and a point at which the limited
access highway crosses Moccasin Creek (at Gunn
Lake). The confluence of the east & west prongs
of Moccasin Creek is just about 3 miles north
of this point. See point (15) and point (16) on
my map on page 11 UB

We are still struggling to locate some of
the properties owned by Upchurch in the
Moccasin Creek area in the era 1750+. In
the process we have collected a number
of deeds, wills, etc. much more remains
to be done.

I'll hope to hear from you in due
course and will welcome any suggestions
or to how we can help each other

Dear Mr Womack,

This is in response to your article in Vol 5 No 1 of Stuckland Scene, of which I am a subscriber. Your article interests me from several standpoints. I am a serious researcher on the entire Upchurch family as you will see from the enclosed flyer on the Upchurch Bulletin. The Stucklands you have listed lived in the very same community in Franklin Co, NC where my ancestor Richard U II arrived about 1755. We call it the Moccasin Creek Area and it is on the western side of the southernmost tip of Franklin Co, NC. Originally this area was in Johnston Co, NC then in Wake Co, NC and finally in Franklin Co, NC. The Stucklands and the Upchurches lived side by side and intermarried each other, deede and wills. I am sure they intermarried in the period 1770-1820 but we need proof and details.

Richard U II had 8 sons and 2 daughters. One of the sons, Nathan U I (1759-1835), was my GGGF. For some of the sons I have a detailed knowledge of offspring. For other sons I do not. I have a collection

of Upchurch children born in the area in the period 1770-1820 for which a father has not yet been identified. These children are grouped into families. I continue to add to this bank of information from wills, deeds, census records, cemetery records, bible records, etc. soon I hope to draw some additional conclusions.

Benjamin U (almost certainly the same as the one you list) was one of the 10 children of Richard U II. He is one child for which I do not yet have a listing of offspring. yet we know he was married and stayed in the area. I would welcome any further details you might have on Benjamin U.

My ancestor Nathan U I left the Meccasin creek area about 1802 and moved to the westernmost part of the adjoining Wake Co. where my GF my father and I were born. However, my ties with the Meccasin creek area were reinforced when I happened to marry a girl who was born about 3 miles east of the Meccasin Creek Area. ~~She~~ She was nee Eva Sallaine Sledge and coincidentally her GM was Sallie Stuckland (b. 17 FEB 1870 d. 17 APR 1950) who mtd John Turner Sledge. True Sallie Stuckland is no doubt related to those you have listed. Neither my unfer father nor I have pursued her Stuckland line although I do keep adding odd bits of

information to the files. For example, I have made a profile on each of the persons listed in your article

Could you send me your full name and a sketch of your connections back to the Stucklands you listed. This should help in any future correspondence we may have.

I'll be glad to send you xerox copies of any details that I have that could be of interest to you. I assume you would be most interested in your direct ancestors. Let me know what would be useful to you. My profiles and other reference sources are quite extensive.

Can you tell me ~~for~~ the basis for the speculation that Mary Ann Stuckland (daughter of Sampson Stuckland) may have married Benjamin Upchurch. Any other details you have on Upchurch would be welcome also.

I do hope to hear from you and to explore how we might be of assistance to each other.
