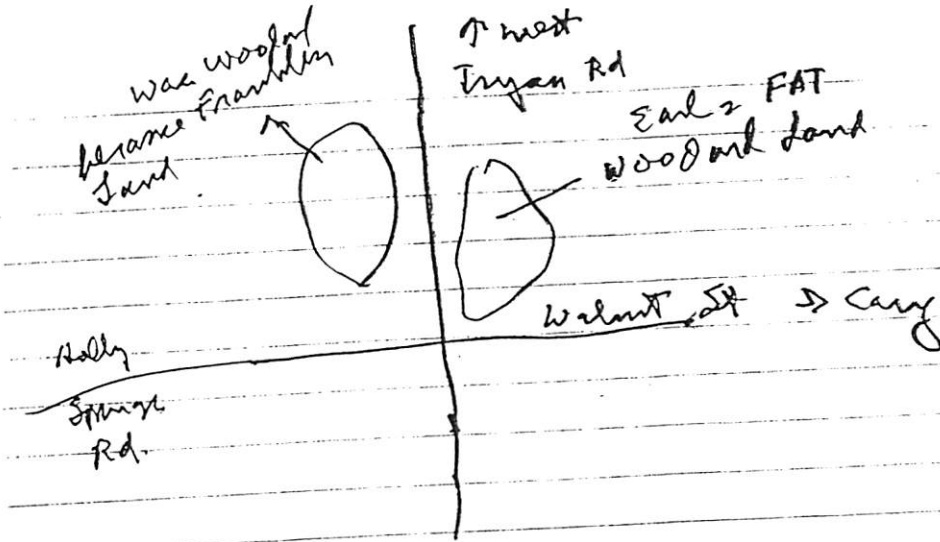

690 BRUCE AND ANNIE SLEDGE WOODARD

Annie Lee Sledge's great-grandparents moved from Warren County to Franklin County about 1846. Her great-grandfather Alfred Sledge, son of Turner and Tabitha Davis Sledge, married Mary Burgess. They settled on the family farm on Cypress Creek where Lake Royal is now located. They still rest there in the Sledge Family Cemetery just East of the dam on Horseman Drive along with Annie's grandparents John and Sally Strickland Sledge. Also in the cemetery are her aunts Eva Mae Sledge, Ida Louvenia Sledge Debnam, who married Baldy Debnam, and an uncle Turner Sledge. Her grandparents were featured in volume I.

Annie Lee Sledge was born on April 7th, 1931 to Paul Alfred and Annie Wood Sledge. Her brothers included Clarence, who married Helen Fulford and worked with the Department of Transportation at Bunn. Cleveland, who married Rachel Whitley and farmed at the home place on Sledge Road in Franklin County, and Paul, Jr., who married Elsie Gardner and farmed on A.F. Moore Road in Franklin County.

Annie Lee graduated from Bunn High School in 1950. She married Bruce Woodard on December 19th, 1951 in Holly Grove Baptist Church. He was the son of Ollie and Mamie Whitley Woodard who lived about 5 miles away in the Gold Valley Community and who farmed in both Nash and Franklin Counties. Bruce graduated from Spring Hope High School in 1949 and went on to receive Bachelors and Masters degrees from N.C. State University. He served two years as a commissioned officer in the U.S. Army during the Korean War. This was

followed by 30 years of distinguished service with the N.C. Agricultural Extension Service in Lenoir, Northampton, Wake, Cumberland, and Johnston Counties. After retiring in 1986 as Johnston County Extension Director he established Woodard Realty. He authored and published a book "Farm Heritage and Humor" recalling his memories of growing up on the farm in Gold Valley and also including stories told by his father-in-law Paul Sledge of his experiences growing up in Franklin County. He also did extensive genealogical research on the Sledge and Woodard families, printing books on both.

Annie Lee worked as a secretary for a couple of years after high school but then became a full-time mama when their first child, Donald Bruce, was born in 1955 in Fayetteville. Teresa Ann was born in 1958 in Rocky Mount, and Gary Paul was born in 1959 in Roanoke

Rapids. Annie's hobbies included sewing, gardening, and more recently growing orchids in her greenhouse. Both she and Bruce have been very active Methodist Church members and in community volunteer service including meals-on-wheels, food closet Salvation Army, Keep Johnston County Beautiful, and 4 H Alumni.

Their son Don Woodard is a Certified Hand Therapist with Lewis Gale Hospital in Roanoke, Virginia. He married Denise Overstreet, a teachers assistant, and they have four boys-Matthew born in 1984, Aaron in 1986, and twins Stewart and Jonathan in 1990. Teresa Ann married Wilson Carter, an Architectural Draftsman, They reside in Raleigh where she is a nurse at Rex Hospital. They have a son Christopher born in 1985 and a daughter Catherine born in 1992. Paul married Susan Watson, Education Specialist with the Johnston County Soil and Water Conservation District in Smithfield. They reside near Selma. Paul is a Professional Land Surveyor with the N.C. Department of Transportation in Wilson. They have a daughter, Marilee born in 1993, and a son Garrett born in 1999.

Both Annie Lee and Bruce are proud of their rural heritage and have many fond memories of Franklin County and growing up on the farm. Since Bruce attributes much of his success in agriculture to his experiences and accomplishments as a 4 H Club member in Nash County, in 2009 they established the Bruce and Annie Woodard 4 H Scholarship Endowment.

690 BRUCE AND ANNIE SLEDGE WOODARD

Annie Lee Sledge's great-grandparents moved from Warren County to Franklin County about 1846. Her great-grandfather Alfred Sledge, son of Turner and Tabitha Davis Sledge, married Mary Burgess. They settled on the family farm on Cypress Creek where Lake Royal is now located. They still rest there in the Sledge Family Cemetery just East of the dam on Horseman Drive along with Annie's grandparents John and Sally Strickland Sledge. Also in the cemetery are her aunts Eva Mae Sledge, Ida Louvenia Sledge Debnam, who married Baldy Debnam, and an uncle Turner Sledge. Her grandparents were featured in volume I.

Annie Lee Sledge was born on April 7th, 1931 to Paul Alfred and Annie Wood Sledge. Her brothers included Clarence, who married Helen Fulford and worked with the Department of Transportation at Bunn. Cleveland, who married Rachel Whitley and farmed at the home place on Sledge Road in Franklin County, and Paul, Jr., who married Elsie Gardner and farmed on A.F. Moore Road in Franklin County.

Annie Lee graduated from Bunn High School in 1950. She married Bruce Woodard on December 19th, 1951 in Holly Grove Baptist Church. He was the son of Ollie and Mamie Whitley Woodard who lived about 5 miles away in the Gold Valley Community and who farmed in both Nash and Franklin Counties. Bruce graduated from Spring Hope High School in 1949 and went on to receive Bachelor's and Masters degrees from N.C. State University. He served two years as a commissioned officer in the U.S. Army during the Korean War. This was

followed by 30 years of distinguished service with the N.C. Agricultural Extension Service in Lenoir, Northampton, Wake, Cumberland, and Johnston Counties. After retiring in 1986 as Johnston County Extension Director he established Woodard Realty. He authored and published a book "Farm Heritage and Humor" recalling his memories of growing up on the farm in Gold Valley and also including stories told by his father-in-law Paul Sledge of his experiences growing up in Franklin County. He also did extensive genealogical research on the Sledge and Woodard families, printing books on both.

Annie Lee worked as a secretary for a couple of years after high school but then became a full-time mama when their first child, Donald Bruce, was born in 1955 in Fayetteville. Teresa Ann was born in 1958 in Rocky Mount, and Gary Paul was born in 1959 in Roanoke

Rapids. Annie's hobbies included sewing, gardening, and more recently growing orchids in her greenhouse. Both she and Bruce have been very active Methodist Church members and in community volunteer service including meals-on-wheels, food closet Salvation Army, Keep Johnston County Beautiful, and 4 H Alumni.

Their son Don Woodard is a Certified Hand Therapist with Lewis Gale Hospital in Roanoke, Virginia. He married Denise Overstreet, a teachers assistant, and they have four boys-Matthew born in 1984, Aaron in 1986, and twins Stewart and Jonathan in 1990. Teresa Ann married Wilson Carter, an Architectural Draftsman, They reside in Raleigh where she is a nurse at Rex Hospital. They have a son Christopher born in 1985 and a daughter Catherine born in 1992. Paul married Susan Watson, Education Specialist with the Johnston County Soil and Water Conservation District in Smithfield. They reside near Selma. Paul is a Professional Land Surveyor with the N.C. Department of Transportation in Wilson. They have a daughter, Marilee born in 1993, and a son Garrett born in 1999.

Both Annie Lee and Bruce are proud of their rural heritage and have many fond memories of Franklin County and growing up on the farm. Since Bruce attributes much of his success in agriculture to his experiences and accomplishments as a 4 H Club member in Nash County, in 2009 they established the Bruce and Annie Woodard 4 H Scholarship Endowment.

(Parents of Wormley Ray)

Nathan Ray (father of Wormley Rose Ray) was born circa 1765. The place of birth is believed to have been in the area of North Carolina that became Wake County. Nathan Ray married Elizabeth Kilgo (mother of Wormley Rose Ray) on January 5, 1790 in Wake County. A copy of their Marriage Bond is included on page 32. The Kilgo family was one of the earliest families to settle in the area that became Wake County. They arrived prior to 1755. It appears that Nathan and Elizabeth had only one child, a son, Wormley Rose Ray, during their 32 years of marriage. The 1790 Federal Census shows Nathan and Elizabeth living in Wake County with no slaves. Nathan was a bondsman for the marriage of Dempsey Woodard and Elizabeth Griggs on September 23, 1787, which indicates he was an adult a few years prior to his 1790 marriage.

Deeds were registered in Wake County on September 3, 1793 and 1794 in which Hammon Mobley conveyed property in Wake County to Nathan Ray. The acreages and locations of the property were not stated in the court minutes. The 1793 Wake County Tax List shows Nathan as the owner of 50 acres. The 1794 Tax List shows his land holdings increased to 107 acres. In 1799, Nathan owned 182 acres located on the north side of the Neuse River. On February 18, 1800, Nathan Ray executed an Indenture to purchase a 75-acre parcel in Wake County from John Ray for 100 pounds "current money" (1.33 pounds/acre). This 75-acre parcel was located on the north side of the Neuse River adjacent to other property already owned by Nathan Ray on the river adjacent to Cedar Point. Nathan completed payments for the land to John Ray and the Deed of Conveyance was registered April 16, 1802. The Tax Lists from 1802 to 1820 show Nathan as the owner of 192½ acres in Wake County on the north side of the Neuse River. Cedar Point has not been located on old maps of Wake County and was probably inundated when the dam was constructed in 1981 creating a lake with inlets along the Neuse River.

Nathan Ray purchased a Negro, Caesar, at the estate sale of Mordecai Mobley on January 25, 1808. On December 27, 1814, Nathan purchased a Negro woman, Jude, a boy, Ned, and a girl, Lucey, for 225 pounds from Benjamin Allen.

Nathan and his son, Wormley Rose Ray, both drowned in the Neuse River on or about the first of January 1822. Only Nathan's body was recovered and both men died without wills. Nathan was about 57 years old at the time of his death. Elizabeth Ray received her one third dower interest in Nathan's 193-acre estate on the Neuse River and the balance of his property was divided between Wormley's minor children, Buckner and Henry Ray.

When Nathan's estate was finally settled on April 10, 1824, the first item listed as an expense was "1 gallon of spirits drank when his corpse was taken from the River" at a cost of \$1.00. Nathan's body was recovered from the Neuse River in January and his weary and distressed family and friends needed the gallon of whiskey to complete this chilling task.

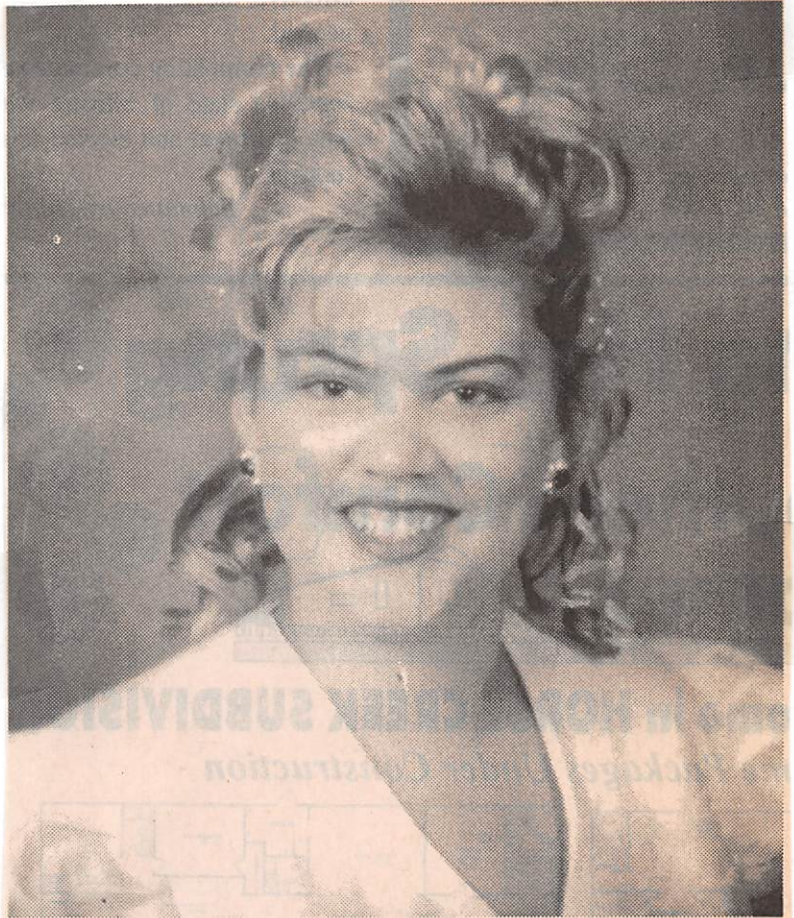

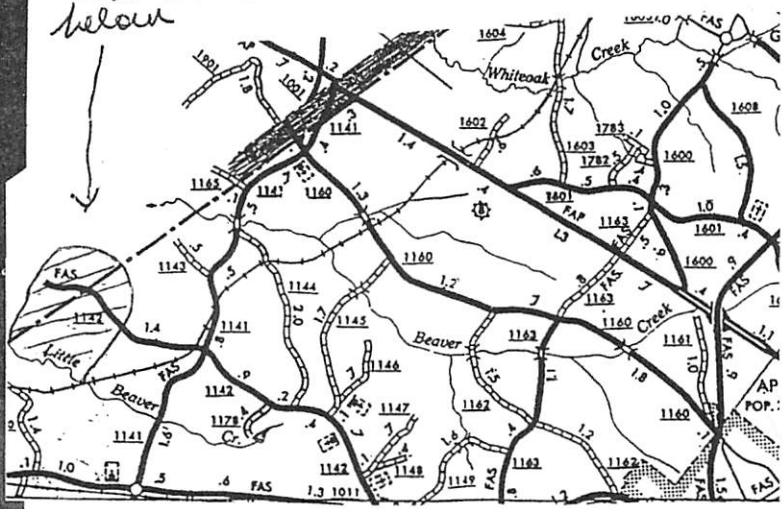
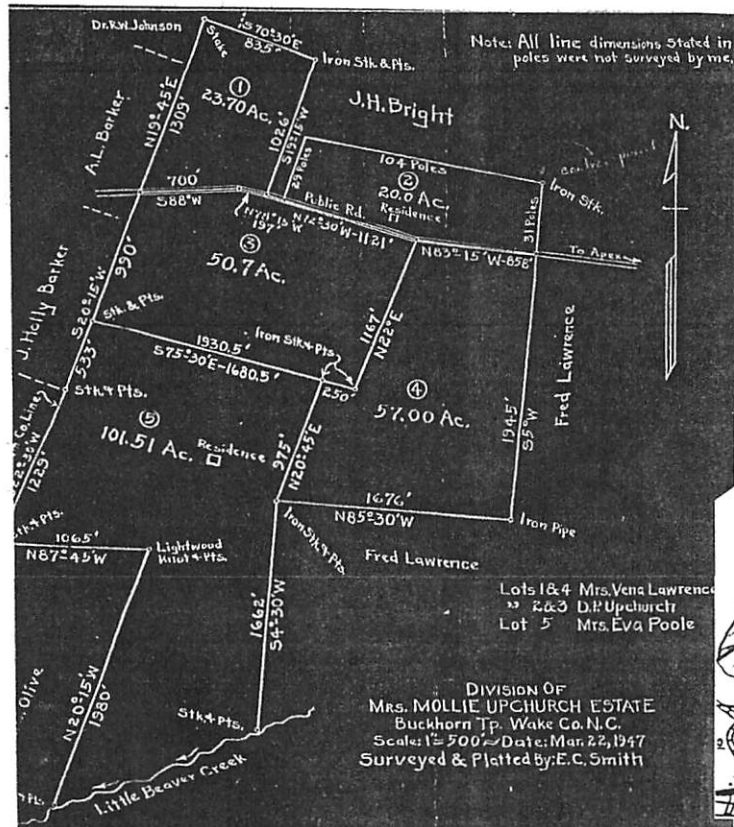

The earliest settlers had no religious opportunities. [△] Catawba Springs is, so far as we know, the oldest church in the vicinity. In 1780, a few miles out from Raleigh, the patriot army was collecting; perhaps the point was Hunter's Lodge, recently the residence of Mr. [△] Benson Hinton. Among the soldiers was a young man from Virginia, [△] the Rev. Jesse Lee, a Methodist minister, who, like a Quaker, objected to fighting. His strenuous objections led him first into trouble, getting in the guard house. [△] Then [△] Lee to preach and his sermon to the soldiers is thought to have been the first Methodist sermon delivered in Wake County. Later that year the famous Bishop Asbury passed through Wake on the way to Orange.

CATAWBA SPRINGS CHURCH:

For nearly seventy years the name was [△] Pleasant Springs; and was located some two miles east of the present church in what, for a long time was a Union Church house. The present site and name were agreed on about 1870. In this connection it may be of interest to note that at the close of the Civil War there were forty-four colored members who were then dismissed.

Charter male members in 1802 were [△] Alexander Myatt, [△] Anthony Franks, Sr., [△] John Utley, [△] Lewis Franks, [△] Nimrod Myatt, and [△] Jacob Utley. Let me call attention to two of the Utleys who joined in 1803. Jonathan Utley was a first cousin to Little John. Jonathan Utley died in 1862, having been clerk of the church for more than twenty years. He was succeeded as clerk by his son [△] Alexander Utley, father-in-law of Mr. Tom Council.

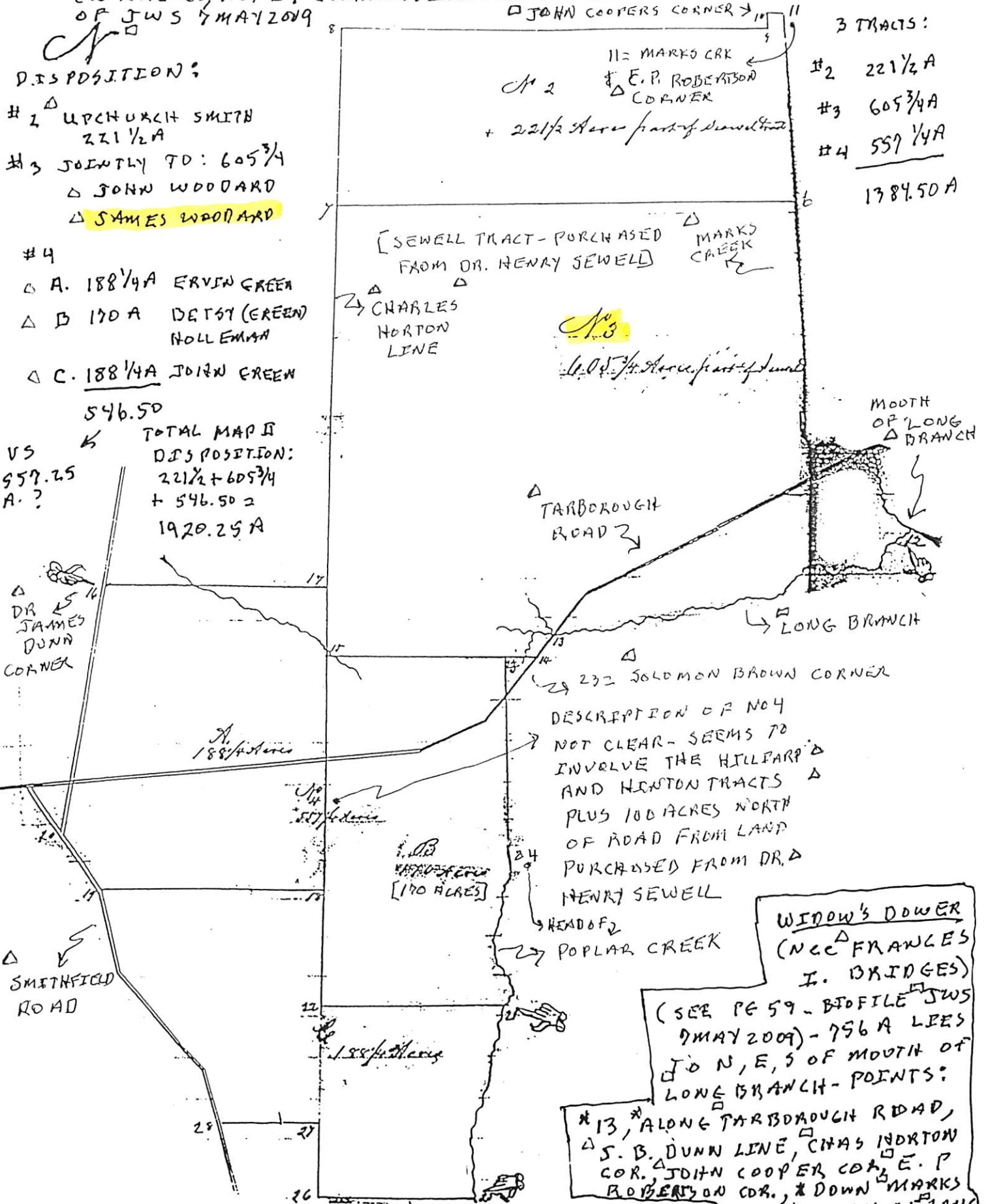

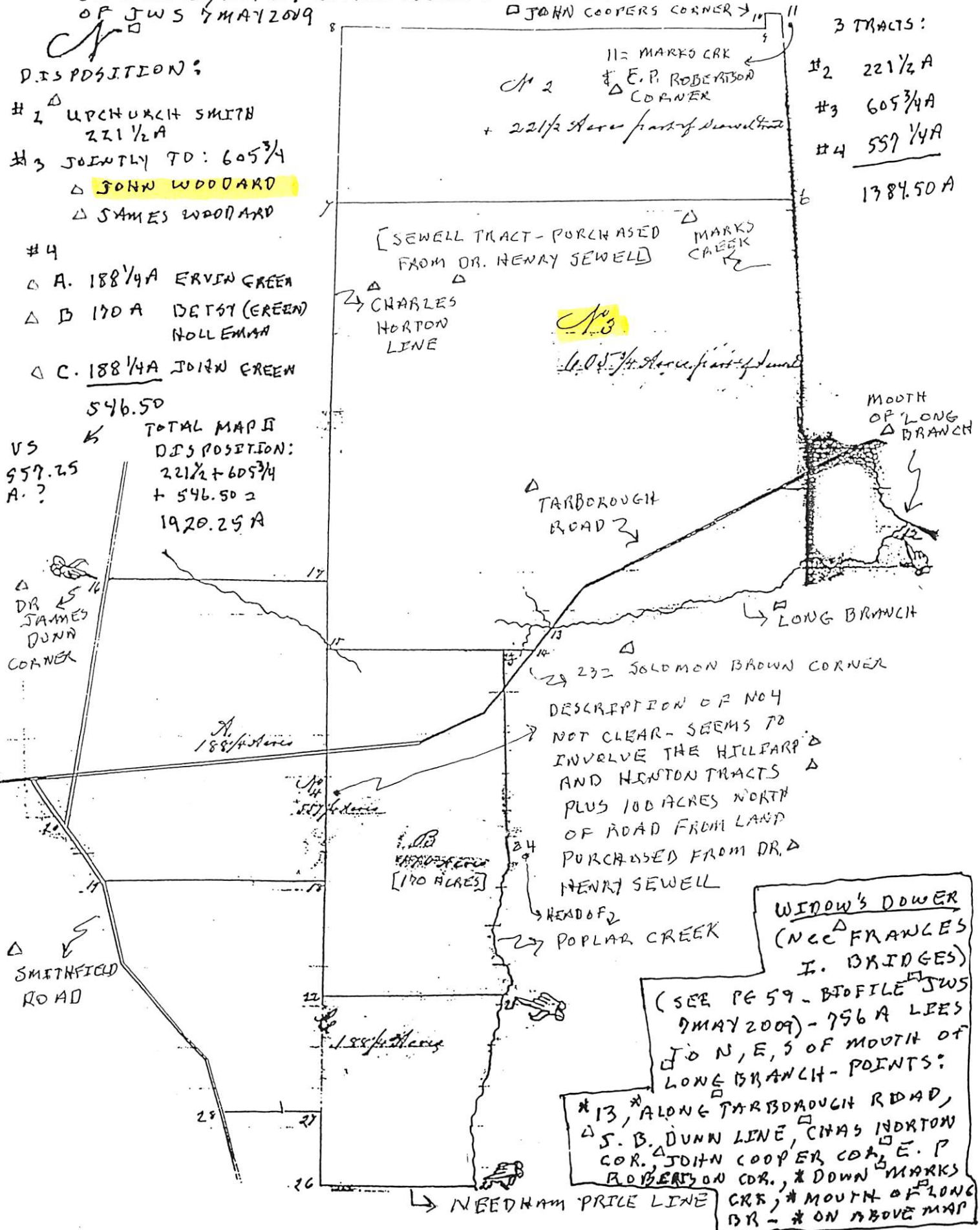

Admitted to hospital at Richmond, Virginia, September 22, 1864, with "chronic diarrhoea." Died in hospital at Richmond on September 24, 1864.

RALEIGH — When Bob Woodard went down to the local DMV office to renew his driver's license in July 2005, the examiner put him through a 40-minute road test to see whether a man who has seen more than a century of life was still able to drive.

At the end, the examiner told Woodard he was a safer driver than most of the people he tests. Woodard's license is up for renewal next year — when he'll be 107.

There are dozens of ways to say Woodard has already seen a lot of life in his 106 years.

He was born July 8, 1903, in Wake County, during Theodore Roosevelt's presidential administration. He once owned a 1924 Ford Model T and has lived in the same wooden house on a corner lot on Western Boulevard for 54 years. He married Mary Ford in 1925; they were married for 53 years until her death in 1978.

Woodard is a dedicated fan of the Atlanta Braves, though the Braves only moved from Milwaukee to Atlanta in 1966, when Woodard was 63.

His daughters Dianne Bostrom, 65, and Joyce Byrd, 75, still refer to him as "Daddy."

Asked whether her father played baseball growing up, Bostrom answered, "I don't know if they even had baseball back then." Baseball does in fact precede Woodard, but he is older than the Chicago Cubs' 101-year streak without a World Series.

Time for many careers

As a young man, Woodard avoided military service because he was too young for World War I and too old for World War II. Instead, he operated his family's farm from the age of 15.

He got out of farming in the late 1920s, when his brother-in-law gave him a controlling interest in a Texaco station on South Saunders Street, a station he owned for 40 years. After that, Woodard got into real estate, a business he

enjoyed very much.

"When a fellow went into real estate years ago, he made money," he said with a laugh. "I don't know how it is now."

Woodard's days are filled with activities he has been doing for decades — reading the paper and checking the stock market — and an activity men young and old have been doing forever: napping.

Going out for dinner

Woodard says he wakes at 7 a.m., reads the newspaper, makes his breakfast and takes a short nap. He then watches television, checks out the paper some more, and then another nap.

Then, he "perks up a little bit" because he has a daily dinner date with Nita Barbour, 85, whom Woodard has been seeing for close to two decades. Dinner has to be over by dusk, though. Woodard doesn't drive in the dark.

Woodard has adjusted well to the vast changes in technology he has lived through. He has a telephone and a cell phone, although he does not use a computer.

Bostrom said she and Byrd tried to teach their father how to use a computer once but had some trouble with it themselves, and he lost interest.

"He said, 'Well, if y'all can't do it, forget that,'" Bostrom said.

Feeling the toll of years

The 106-year-old has the problems that often come with getting older — he has a pacemaker, uses a walker, has broken his hip and doesn't hear well — but doesn't suffer from any serious conditions.

He was, however, forced to miss his 106th birthday party last month. The West Raleigh Exchange Club, a service organization Woodard helped found in 1946, held a party to honor him July 21, but Woodard fell in his house that day and hurt his shoulder. He has recovered well.

Woodard has held almost every office in the Exchange Club, but officially retired from it after breaking his hip eight years ago. He no longer throws out the first pitch of the Little League season at Woodard Field, though he's still in tune with what goes on.

"I told them I had to hang it up," he said.

For Woodard though, there's no retirement from life — just moving on to the next birthday, the next dinner at Barbour's, and of course, the next Braves game.

A large crowd was on hand Friday night for a sneak preview celebration at the new \$4 million Eva H. Perry Regional Library in Apex.

The library, which will open officially on Jan. 16, will offer plenty of space for a fast-growing community.

The 23,000 square foot facility will have room for over 100,000 volumes, much more than is available at the existing Apex library at the depot, a 3,500 square foot building.

The new library includes a glass-enclosed quiet reading room overlooking a natural wooded landscape, overhead skylights, treehouse theme construction in the children's programming room, and a parking lot with 150 spaces and a drive-up island for book returns.

A mural in the children's area, now being completed, will cover over 1,400 square feet depicting characters in children's literature.

The library is named for the late Eva M. Perry, a longtime resident of the area who donated \$3 million to the project from the proceeds of

the sale of her land.

Her donation has made possible the development of a building that will be distinctive both from an architectural and structural standpoint, library officials say.

The architect of the building was Louis W. Cherry. Deborah Haefele is working on the mural.

A portrait of Mrs. Perry, which was unveiled Friday night with her family present, will have a place of honor in the library and was

painted by Charles Kapsner.

In attendance at the event as well as the above were officials from the towns of Apex and Cary, Congressman David Price and library staff and supporters.

The library has been in the planning stages for a decade.

Terri Luke will be regional supervisor at the library, assisted by Mary McNabb, adult services manager and Teresa Young, youth services manager.

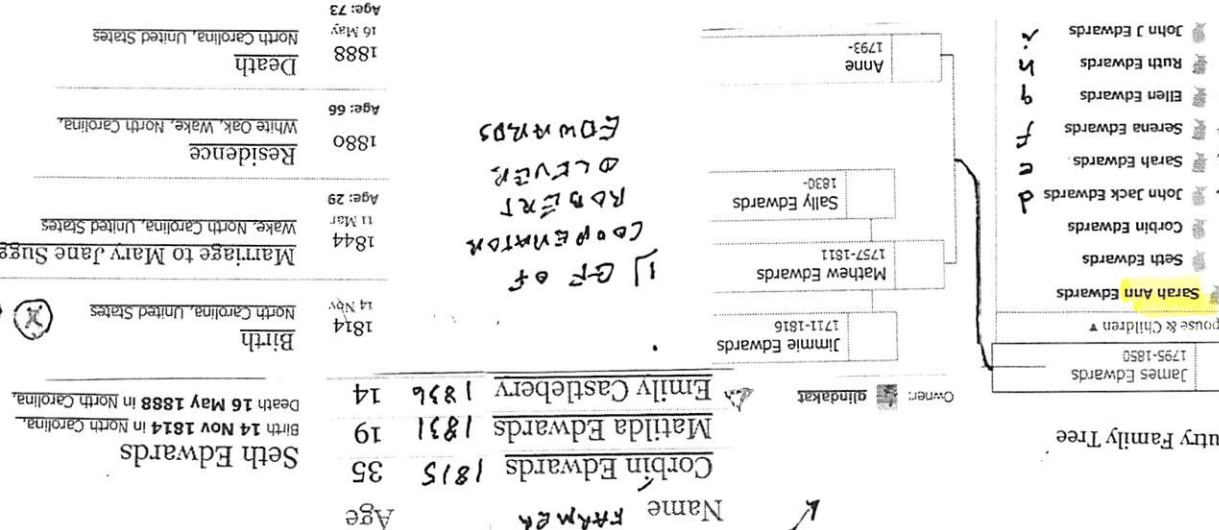

The earliest settlers had no religious opportunities. [△] Catawba Springs is, so far as we know, the oldest church in the vicinity. In 1780, a few miles out from Raleigh, the patriot army was collecting; perhaps the point was Hunter's Lodge, recently the residence of Mr. [△] Hanson Hinton. Among the soldiers was a young man from Virginia, [△] the Rev. Jesse Lee, a Methodist minister, who, like a Quaker, objected to fighting. His strenuous objections led him first into trouble, getting in the guard house. [△] Then [△] Lee to preach and his sermon to the soldiers is thought to have been the first Methodist sermon delivered in Wake County. Later that year the famous Bishop Asbury passed through Wake on the way to Orange.

CATAWBA SPRINGS CHURCH:

For nearly seventy years the name was [△] Pleasant Springs; and was located some two miles east of the present church in what, for a long time was a Union Church house. The present site and name were agreed on about 1870. In this connection it may be of interest to note that at the close of the Civil War there were forty-four colored members who were then dismissed.

Charter male members in 1802 were [△] Alexander Myatt, [△] Anthony Franks, Sr., [△] John Utley, [△] Lewis Franks, [△] Himrod Myatt, and [△] Jacob Utley.
