ORGANIZATION: ORGANIZATION

Swift Creek Baptist Church was organized in 1879 in the Burns School House which stood at that time opposite the Henry Atkins home on Penny Road. (This site is across the road from Penny Road Elementary School today.) The old school house was moved several times with its final location being on the south-east corner of the current Church property. It was torn away in 1977 during site preparation for the current education building.

From the minutes of the Raleigh Baptist Association held October 23 to 25, 1879, references to the organization of Swift Creek Baptist Church are found. The Church organization took place after a series of meetings were conducted by Rev. W. R. Gwaltney, pastor of the Tabernacle Baptist Church in Raleigh. He was a member of the Cooperative State Board and held a ten-day revival meeting in the Burns School House eleven miles southwest of Raleigh. The Swift Creek Baptist Church was organized on Friday, November 1, 1879. The Raleigh Baptist Association appropriated \$100 toward organizational and financial needs of the new church. Swift Creek Baptist Church applied for membership in the Raleigh Baptist Association in the fall session of 1880.*

The presbytery that constituted the church was composed of Rev. W. R. Gwaltney, Rev. George J. Dowell, Rev. J. M. Holleman, and Rev. Harvey Hatcher.*

The first church conference was held on October 31, 1879. At a conference in 1880, the constitution of the Pleasant Grove Baptist Church was adopted.* (Copy attached.)

*From "One Hundred Years of Swift Creek Baptist Church, Wake County, Raleigh, North Carolina 1879-1979."

The first deacons of the Church were W. H. Strain and J. C. Burns. The first female deacons, elected in 1986, were Mary Livengood and Betty Finch. Until the 1950's, deacons served for life. Since then, they are elected to three-year terms on the Board of Deacons but of course as ordained deacons, they retain the title of deacon for life. Many have served repeated terms on the active board assisting the pastor in ministering to the spiritual and physical needs of the members. The earliest settlers had no religious opportunities. [△] Catawba Springs is, so far as we know, the oldest church in the vicinity. In 1780, a few miles out from Raleigh, the patriot army was collecting; perhaps the point was Hunter's Lodge, recently the residence of Mr. [△] Benson Hinton. Among the soldiers was a young man from Virginia, [△] the Rev. Jesse Lee, a Methodist minister, who, like a Quaker, objected to fighting. His strenuous objections led him first into trouble, getting in the guard house. [△] Then [△] Lee to preach and his sermon to the soldiers is thought to have been the first Methodist sermon delivered in Wake County. Later that year the famous Bishop Asbury passed through Wake on the way to Orange.

CATAWBA SPRINGS CHURCH:

For nearly seventy years the name was [△] Pleasant Springs; and was located some two miles east of the present church in what, for a long time was a Union Church house. The present site and name were agreed on about 1870. In this connection it may be of interest to note that at the close of the Civil War there were forty-four colored members who were then dismissed.

○ ORGANIZATION: ORGANIZATION

△ Swift Creek Baptist Church was organized in 1879 in the Burns School House which stood at that time opposite the Henry Atkins home on Penny Road. (This site is across the road from Penny Road Elementary School today.) The old school house was moved several times with its final location being on the south-east corner of the current Church property. It was torn away in 1977 during site preparation for the current education building.

From the minutes of the Raleigh Baptist Association held October 23 to 25, 1879, references to the organization of Swift Creek Baptist Church are found. The Church organization took place after a series of meetings were conducted by Rev. W. R. Gwaltney, pastor of the Tabernacle Baptist Church in Raleigh. He was a member of the Cooperative State Board and held a ten-day revival meeting in the Burns School House eleven miles southwest of Raleigh. The Swift Creek Baptist Church was organized on Friday, November 1, 1879. The Raleigh Baptist Association appropriated \$100 toward organizational and financial needs of the new church. Swift Creek Baptist Church applied for membership in the Raleigh Baptist Association in the fall session of 1880.*

△ Swift Creek Baptist Church was organized in 1879 in the Burns School House which
△ stood at that time opposite the Henry Atkins home on Penny Road. (This site is across the
road from Penny Road Elementary School today.) The old school house was moved
several times with its final location being on the south-east corner of the current Church
property. It was torn away in 1977 during site preparation for the current education
building.

From the minutes of the Raleigh Baptist Association held October 23 to 25, 1879,
references to the organization of Swift Creek Baptist Church are found. The Church
△ organization took place after a series of meetings were conducted by Rev. W. R. Gwaltney,
pastor of the Tabernacle Baptist Church in Raleigh. He was a member of the Cooperative
□ State Board and held a ten-day revival meeting in the Burns School House eleven miles
southwest of Raleigh. The Swift Creek Baptist Church was organized on Friday, November
1, 1879. The Raleigh Baptist Association appropriated \$100 toward organizational and
financial needs of the new church. Swift Creek Baptist Church applied for membership in
the Raleigh Baptist Association in the fall session of 1880.*

△△△ Rev. George J. Dowell, Rev. J. M. Holleman, and Rev. Harvey Hatcher.*
