Dear Cousin Fran,

My call to you of 21 JAN 91 was prompted by information on Courtney & U whose profile is enclosed. Since descendants of the Moss & Courtney U subclan settled in McLean Co, TX I was taken with the idea that Courtney & U in OCT 1878 might be of this subclan. This prompted my call to you. Since that time I have prepared an organized sheet on the possible children of Courtney U (XID-1109) a copy of which is enclosed. I was surprised to find that we have evidence of 14 children but names for only 7 one of which is your ancestor Cynthia. Some of the unnamed & may have died young remaining facts may be few and hard to acquire. It seems likely that we will find Child C and Child E on some records. I am disappointed that there is not room for Courtney & U in OCT 1878 among the names.

It is my desire to publish this list of possible children in the U & in due course

However, I would very much like to have any more details that anyone might have about this list. It is exciting to have this list out on the table so that we can begin to propose solutions to the puzzles presented. One guesser that part of the answer may lie in the AL records and part in the TX records. The question is - which members of the family moved to TX and where did they move and where did they settle. I wonder if they stopped in MS or LA along the way?

Any light you can shed on any of this will be appreciated.



Dear Fran,

Now we do have your note of March 18, 1980 and do know that you are pleased with Upchurch Bulletin. I have spent many months pondering about format, content, applicability, etc. Now that the publication is launched I need responses from the readers so we can make adjustments.

I am anxious to follow-up your question about the accuracy of the dates and the source of information. My approach in publishing Upchurch Bulletin is to use the best information available whether it has been verified or not. The information then stands until challenged or corrected. I have thousands of people entirely based on reports of individuals in which they frequently take from memory - things such as names of family members,

birth places, burial places, etc. For the most part such information will be useful. On the other hand some of it will be in error. Therefore, it must be considered that not everything in Upchurchs Bulletin is proven. It is only a representation of our best current knowledge. I do maintain extensive cross-referenced files and try to record the source of all my information in the files.

In order for me to begin to answer your question about sources, would you please pick out about a dozen examples which concern you. I will then go through my ~~bio~~ biopiles and indicate to you the sources. Then we can deal with more examples in subsequent exchanges. It may be that you have caught some typing or transcription errors.

Upchurchs Bulletin is proving to be a challenging experience but a very satisfying one. I appreciate your interest and cooperation.

Dear Cousin Fran,

Your nice letter of 11 SEP 1984 arrived yesterday  
and all of the details have been properly extracted  
and recorded. For these, I thank you very much.

I will have some more questions for you  
but first let me address your question about  
proof of Courtney U being a son of Moses U. My  
general approach is to collect information from many  
directions and to accept tentatively any circumstantial  
evidence unless there is a contradiction. In the  
process many "proofs" are collected but most after  
all I can do is provide leads for others to  
search for actual proof. This is probably the  
case for your question.

For your use and files I provide herewith xerox  
copies of the 7 page profile on Moses U (XFD-1) and  
the 2 page profile on Courtney U (XFD-1109), the presumed  
son of XFD-1. Moses U had a son Sam U (XFD-17) who  
named a son Courtney U (XFD-633). Although XFD-633  
is much younger than your XFD-1109 I am sending  
the XFD-633 profile (2 sheets) so that you can avoid

confusion. Please study these profile sheets and let me know if you need more information as to my sources.

Belle West in her Upchurchs Family lists several children of Moses U on page 33 but does not show Courtney U as a documented son. In fact she does not mention him at all in the book. On pg 81 we find a Courtney U but this is the son of Sam U  
↳ (not in index).

Enclosed is my crude chart of Colonial Upchurches through the 6th generation. We know that Moses U (XFD) and his brother Nathan U I (XFD-78) moved from Franklin Co, NC to the border between Chatham Co, NC + Wake Co, NC in the vicinity of Green Level. Another 5th generation Upchurch (John U III - XFD-157) also lived in Chatham Co, NC + died there in 1795 - but John U III lived in the SE corner of Chatham Co.

There is room in the Moses U home on the 1800 + 1810 census for a Courtney U. Courtney was not yet born in 1800 and had not in 1814 so he did not appear in his father's home for the 1790 or 1820 census. On the 1870 + 1880 census Courtney U is head of his own household in Chatham Co, NC. Note item 6 on XFD-1109 Profile which ties Courtney U to the vicinity where Moses U lived.

See UB Vol 5 (1984) No 1 Pg 19 re records of Mt Pisgah Church - which was 2-3 miles from where Moses U lived. I was disappointed not to find Courtney U (XFD-1110) on the records although his mother + 4 brothers were there.



Please note that I made an error in transcribing and annotating these records. On page 29 Entry 124 should be XFD-633 and not XFD-1109. Likewise on page 31 Courtney U XFD-1109 & Cynthia Richardson should be deleted or item F. and should be shown as ~~item~~ item 8. under E. and recorded as Courtney U XFD-633.

It is possible that Courtney U XFD-1109 could be the son of someone other than Moses U XFD-1. However, I find no evidence that they are not father & son and there are several circumstantial items of evidence that make the relationship plausible. Let me have your reactions.

Now for some questions. First I will list those for Jesse Sindair Caddock Sr & descendants. The record for this group is almost complete and I realize that we may have to settle for the current status but will list the missing items just in case

I will be grateful for any of these questions that you can answer.

With respect to your ancestor Courtney U, I am sure the reason West did not learn more about him is that he lived as an adult in Crabham Co, NC for only about 20 years (ca 1815 - 1835) and that there was a period in which records were not kept or completely as a few years later. In the years ahead I will continue to search a variety of sources of information for central NC for Upchurch records in the 1700's and 1800's or there is where my own line is concentrated and there are a fair number of marriage lists of information on them. It is likely that more information on Courtney will surface in the process.

I'll get this off to you as soon as I can get to a xerox machine.


Dear Mr. Upchurch:

had built a new house. Treasure stories of the days before banks are not unfounded. Frank and Neppie had torn down an old log cabin. As Neppie was removing the chinking between logs, something hit the floor. "Uh-oh, there went my money," joked Neppie. But it was, sure enough, a money bag that lay between logs under the chinking, with gold enough to help buy the new place. Jess sharecropped the old place thru 1912. In 1913 they moved, Jess and Hattie, up Yellow Wolf Creek to the Homer Fletcher place, sharecropped that, stayed till Sept. They lost another child in Feb of that year. Ira Bird still cherishes the old stump puller he and Jess used to clear a piece of land for Ira.

In Sept 1913, Jess moved to North Texas. Ila Mae born on Craddock ranch, 14 miles north of Seymour, Tx. Feb 1914, a month before her grandmother, Neppie, died at Sanco. Clay was born Dec 1915 on Gunnels ranch near Seymour. Aubrey and "Skinny" (Carl Wilson) both born at Markley, Young Co. Tx.

During his years in that area, he operated a taxi in Wichita Falls, cooked for threshing crews, cut wood, posts and railroad ties with Frank Cahagan one winter, broke horses, etc. Had a memorably slow trip from Newcastle to Wichita Falls on the train. Track was in such bad shape, ties were tied with wire to posts and trees on the route to keep track from sliding. Engineer had a trap line across a lakebed, would walk across the lake to run his traps while the train poked around the lake, he caught the engine on the far side.

Jess broke horses for Frank and Bob Norfleet at a time shortly before F. Norfleet made his notable odyssey to capture a gang who had swindled him.

I know from experience - I finally found my ACRIL L. UPCHURCH to be the son of NATHAN UPCHURCH (brother of MOSES UPCHURCH) both Revolutionary Soldiers. A Power of Attorney proved that it was the same Acril of Wake Co., N. C. and Tipton (& LaFayette) Cos, Te....that his wife was Mary Olive. (The Upchurch and Olives intermarried - also Barker). WAS I GLAD...now to go back and put all the pieces together....this brings me to about 1450 in England...if Belle West's book is authentic---which I definitely think so - she has put many years into research.

Will certainly keep my eyes open and my fingers crossed for your Courtney. Courtney is not mentioned in Belle West's book on the Upchurch family.... which seems strange ...of course, she really worked on her direct line with a few other people sending in theirs.

DEAR MRS. LOMAS;

YES, I AM THE ROY WHITE OF THE BURWELL UPCHURCH LINE. I HAVE BEEN SOMEWHAT TRANSIENT THE PAST FEW YEARS AND THE CHANNELVIEW, TEXAS ADDRESS (THAT OF AN AUNT OF MINE) WAS ONE I USED A FEW YEARS AGO. FROM THERE I MOVED TO DALLAS AND THEN, IN LATE 1970, OUT WEST TO UTAH. IN AUGUST I WAS TRANSFERRED DOWN HERE TO THE SALT LAKE CITY AREA AND WE HAVE MOVED INTO AN APARTMENT, HOPEFULLY ON A TEMPORARY BASIS UNTIL INTEREST RATES COME DOWN AND CAN LOOK FOR A HOME TO BUY.

I SENT ADA MORGAN EVERYTHING I COULD FIND IN MY FILES RE YOUR COURTNEY UPCHURCH LINE AND I HAD THE IMPRESSION THAT SHE THEN FORWARDED IT ON TO YOU AFTER COMBINING WITH WHAT SHE HAD TO OFFER. MY CONTRIBUTION WAS NOT THAT MUCH -- ONLY SOME CENSUS RECORDS AS I RECALL.

DURING THE PERIOD I WAS SO INVOLVED IN UPCHURCH RESEARCH I FOUND OUT THAT EVERYONE OF UPCHURCH DESCENT NEEDED "HELP" -- AND PROSPECTS DID NOT LOOK VERY BRIGHT. Upchurch was b. ca. 1759 Va. m. Rachel Bethshares b. ca. 1760 Va. He moved to Iredell Co., N.C. ca. 1788. They had a large family I do not have all of their childrens names. Joseph Upchurch b. 1800 N.C. m. Jane Crouch their first born was named James Calvin b. 1824 ~~xxx~~ you have both of these names in your line so it would seem they might be closley related. I really must apologize for not answering your letter of Jan 1973 any earlier but quite frankly, I have had a very difficult time in finding data on the UPCHURCH line. I have, only recently, been able to confirm my great grandmother's father.

I am enclosing two listings I have on (1) Mary Jane (UPCHURCH) READ - my great grandmother and (2) Lavina C. (UPCHURCH) READ. I believe these two girls were sisters and I further believe they married brothers, Edmund READ (my greatgrandfather) and his brother Joseph. The listings I am enclosing are of these two families descendants.

I am reasonably sure now that I have established, at least Mary Jane UPCHURCH's father. Think he is John UPCHURCH, born 12 Oct 1798 in Tenn., Va., or possibly North Carolina. He is the fourth child of Samuel and Mary Ellen (SIMMONS) UPCHURCH. Now I think it is possible that your UPCHURCH could very well have been a brother to Samuel. I'm basing this assumption on the name of Calvin B. who was born in 1829 in Tenn. or North Carolina. I have found another John Calvin UPCHURCH who was a g g grandson of my Samuel -- feel that Calvin could very well have been a family name. I am giving you the name of a Mrs. William H. MORGAN of 8916 Walnut St., Kansas City, MO 64114, who with other descendants of the UPCHURCH family is trying to compile a family history. I'm sure she would be glad to hear from you as she is very interested in the Tenn. UPCHURCHES.

Below is the family data I have on Samuel and Mary Ellen (SIMMONS) UPCHURCH, furnished you just in case you can tie into any one of these children: Samuel UPCHURCH, b. 11 Sep 1772 and d. 30 June 1841 -- married Marv Ellen (SIMMONS), she b. 13 Oct 1772 and d. 18 Dec 1841. 

I must confess to you that there is such a proliferation of UPCHURCHS that it is going to be very difficult in sorting out the various lines but I feel that the earliest UPCHURCHS all came to the area of Virginia and North Carolina at about the same time and that there is a common progenitor for all of us descendants and of the very early UPCHURCHS. The question is who was the first UPCHURCH -- was it Hiram, Samuel, Jonathan, James or who? At the moment I am concerned with finding out who my Samuel's father was and who were his brothers (one of whom I suspect is your ancestor).

I will keep your letter on file and will certainly advise you if I find out any other information that would appear to be of your line. Once again I'm sorry that I have not written to you sooner but I simply just didn't have any data. I hope that the attached listings and the above information will be of interest to you. If you need any further clarification as to what I have presented, please write and I will endeavor to clear up any point. I strongly urge you to write to Mrs. Morgan and of course, I would be very interested in hearing from you as to your progress or if you have any additional data that I might use.

Just a short letter to thank you for the information you sent, both your Scarborough line and the other. I copied all of the Scarborough line, will use the wives of William Scarborough but only the children by Cynthia. In connection with the fourth child of William and Cynthia: Mattie who m first a Mr. White, I sent a copy of your letter to Roy White, P.O. Box 481, Ogden, Utah. He has many Census records of the counties you are interested in and just might know the White that Martha Scarborough married. He is tracing his line to Burwell the grandson of James Upchurch who died in 1784.

I appreciate very much the form you sent for info on Texas veterans. I sent it out as soon as received and already have a reply. It is rather puzzling. The SanAntonio Genealogical Society had said Henderson Upchurch, a Confederate veteran, was b 1812 d 1892 buried in Williamson County. They sent me the widow's application for a pension, his name was stated as O.H.P. Upchurch who died 2-8-1921 which would make him 109 years old if he was Henderson. Also, he died at Wharton County, ElCampo, Texas. Of course, he could have been buried at Williamson which is a naboring county. They also sent me (by request) his service in the Texas Rangers as Henderson and his service to the Late Republic of Texas for which he was due a sum for serving in the Basques Campaign in 1842, also as Henderson. I have the 1880 Census of Williamson County and Henderson stated his age which would make him born in 1812, his wife Mary E stated her age which agrees (name and age) with the pension application. She states O.H.P. died Feb 1921. She cannot answer any question concerning his service in the Confederate Army but refers to " See Falls County or Grimes" and refers to File # 5526. They were m 10-16-1881 in Montgomery County. I have sent for the marriage reco. and for his death certificate in 1921. It almost looks like she may have married twice and failed to report the death of her first husband. I also sent again for the Veteran's application on File 5526 and told them I had the widow's application. The part I want very much to prove is that Henderson is the ancestor of the Upchurch of Italy, Texas whose father John A Upchurch is of the same age and name as one of Henderson's sons on the 1880 Census.

Re. I have the letter from Mrs. Huffman of Elvins, Mo. and am searching. The Wilkes County will, I have two more versions of it. I think the will has been lost since Olds and Grimes included it in their Wills of Va. I am not sure which I have but it does agree with the 1790 Census with Sarah as household head.

I have received the deed where Samuel sold to John in Chatham Co 1801. We must search for a tie between Moses and Courtney in Chatham.

There were several new items in your Upchurch Notes. Do please send whatever you run across. With time, we shall solve this riddle.

I was glad to get your letter about the Upchurches; however, I'm afraid my information is as sketchy as yours.

Family tradition says that my great-great grandfather Upchurch, name unknown, was the only survivor of a shipwreck off the coast of North Carolina c. 1800, having tied himself to the mast of the ship and floated ashore. He is supposed to have married a McSwain. His son Jones Green Upchurch, was a itinerate school teacher who eloped with Betsy Cooper, daughter of a well-to-do North Carolinian who disowned her when she married him c. 1835. The couple came west to the Nashville, Tennessee, area, where Henry A. was born in 1839; Margaret A. in 1842; and James Allen in 1844. Then they migrated to Daisy, Missouri (Cape Girardeau County), where Amanda F. was born in 1848; Robert Ervin or Irving on September 15, 1851; and Viola about 1853. Henry died after service in the Civil War, Confederate army; Margaret married Bill Flanigan and lived near Campbell, Mo. (Dunklin County); James Allen got into trouble for making whiskey after the law made a license ~~was~~ necessary, escaped from the arresting officers and went to Texas, from where he later sent for his wife and son, losing all contact with the family; Amanda married John Yates and lived in Wayne County, Mo.; Viola married Andy Robbins and lived in Bollinger County, Mo.; and Robert Ervin married Hannah Aldrich, living in Bollinger County, Missouri, he being my grandfather.

Jones Green Upchurch was born in North Carolina October 22, 1816 and died at Daisy, Missouri April 20, 1856 of "lung disease".

Dear Mrs. Lomas:

On April 26, 1975 you responded to my inquiry about Upchurch genealogy and I provide herewith a copy of your letter. Since that time I have moved to Arizona where I am now Head of the Plant Sciences Department in the University of Arizona. In the intervening two years plus, I have devoted a considerable amount of time on Upchurch genealogy. This has included three trips to North Carolina and personal visits with Mrs. West and Mrs. Morgan, the authors of the two books about Upchurches. Great masses of information have been organized into alphabetized biographical and family relationship card files. I am just now getting back to restudying previous correspondence and would like to pick up where we stopped in our earlier exchange. A sketch of my ancestral line is provided herewith.

Mrs. West does not list Courtney as a son of Moses in her book but then she is quite sketchy on sons of Moses other than Murry. She does mention one Courtney on page 81 although this name does not appear in the index. This Courtney is a son of Sims U. and a grandson of Moses U. and a nephew of your Courtney. I am sending you a copy of pages 80 and 81 from West's book so you will have this one Courtney reference. My records show 1 Courtney in NC in the 1830 census (Pittsboro Division Chatham Co NC) and 0 in the 1840 census. In the 1829 NC census/Tax Lists (by Potter 1974) there is no Courtney listed for NC but there is a Coatney (which is probably a misspelling of Courtney for Chatham Co., NC (page 30 in census records). I have not found anything on Lias U.

I am trying to make my Upchurch files as complete as possible. Of course, the Nathan Clan is of special interest to me since he is my direct ancestor and so little has been written about him. It is my hope to start an Upchurch Quarterly Bulletin in due course with strong emphasis on the various Upchurch Progenitors who existed about 1790.

I would appreciate any information you can send on any of the Upchurches. You can send me anything you have and I will reproduce the material and return the originals to you or you can reproduce and I will reimburse you for reproduction charges.

If you have any questions about Upchurch lines I will be happy to search my files and to keep puzzling questions on hand for resolution as more information becomes available. I look forward to hearing from you again.

Courtney Upchurch<sup>Δ</sup> (b. ca 1794 and died before 1850) was my 3rd great grandfather. He married on 21 April 1814 in Chatham County, NC Cynthia Richardson<sup>Δ</sup>. Their children were<sup>Δ</sup> Moses, <sup>Δ</sup>Burnett, <sup>Δ</sup>Calvin B., <sup>Δ</sup>Sion, <sup>Δ</sup>Delinea, <sup>Δ</sup>Cynthia and <sup>Δ</sup>James Co. Between 1834 and 1836 they moved to Alabama settling in Dallas County.

In all probability Courtney was the son of Moses Upchurch and his wife Mary Sims. Moses is listed in Franklin Co. NC in 1870 and in Chatham Co. NC in 1815 and 1820 and his will is there for 1855.

Some notes in my files on the names of Moses, Nathan and Gilbert:

Moses was a witness to a deed for Bute County (in Warren County Deed books) where Richard U. sold land.
